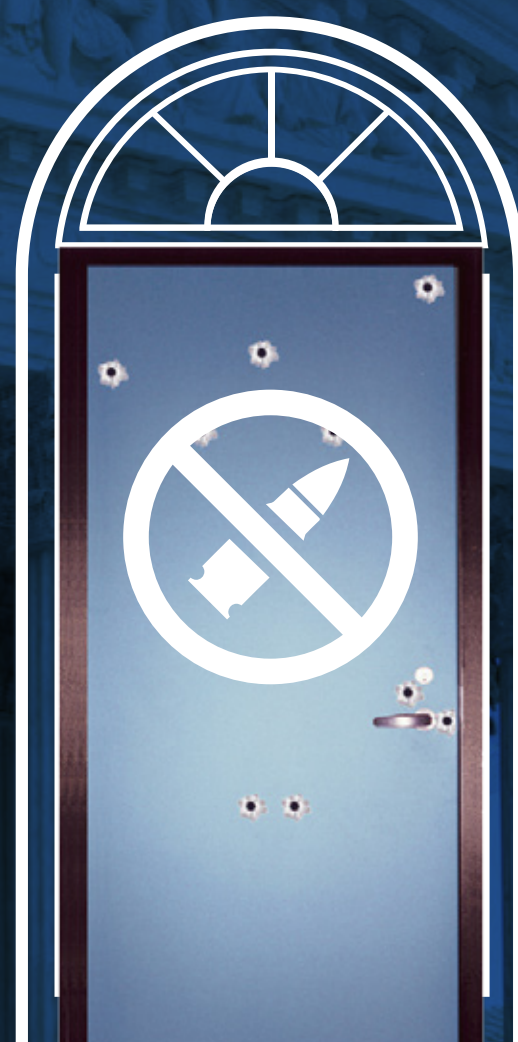

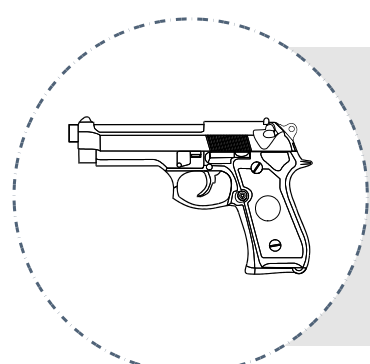

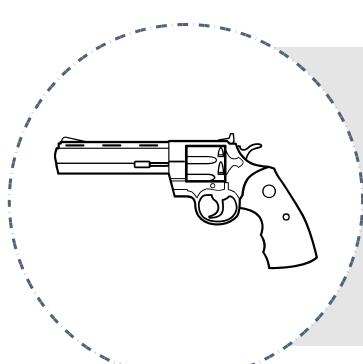
Protection against assault and vandalism at vulnerable door openings - isolated utility buildings, cashier islands, currency exchanges, or box offices.

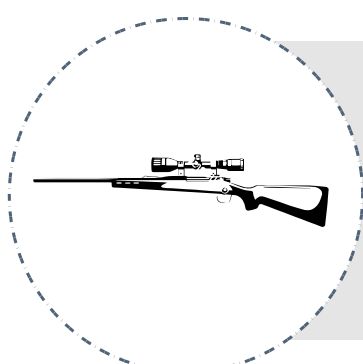

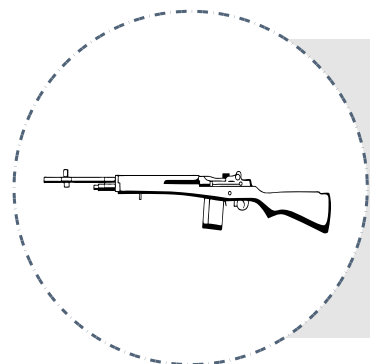

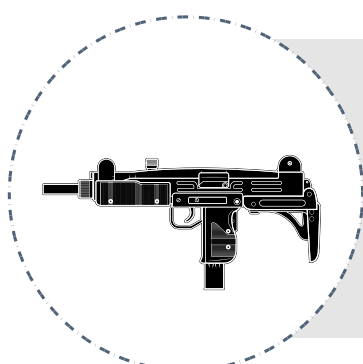

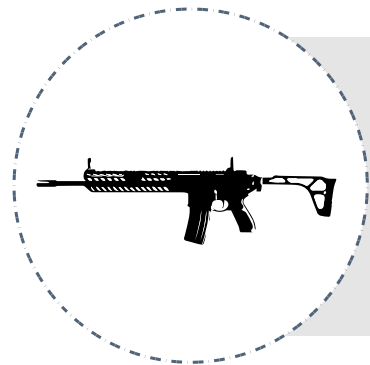

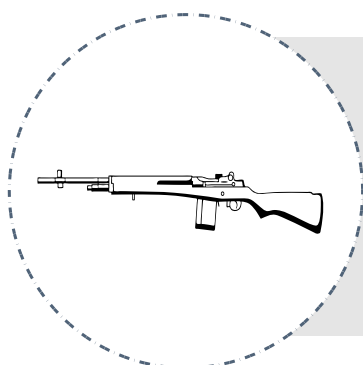

- Welded seamless door edge, continuously welded frames
- Standard gauge (A60 galvanized steel)

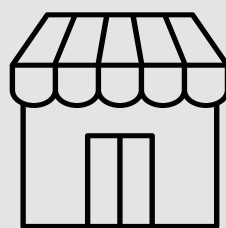


- Optional bullet resistant speaker port and deal tray
- Speaker port is level 3 bullet resistant stainless steel
- Glass is factory prepped to receive the speaker port
- Speaker port is installed flush with the glass surface
- Stainless steel deal tray is bullet resistant up to level 8

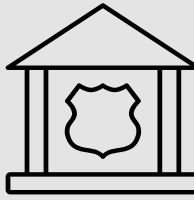
