

Rockwood Manual Flush Bolts (#550, #555, #557)

Frequently Asked Questions

Question: Can a 555 Flush Bolt be used in a wood door?

Answer: The 555 is not UL rated to be used in a wood door.

Question: Is the 555/557 sold as a set?

Answer: No, the product is sold as each, but packaged as a set if ordered.

Question: Are bolt heads adjustable?

Answer: Yes, the 550 & 555 are adjustable up to 1 1/2". Bolt guide must be removed to adjust.

Question: Will manual flush bolts work with a 570 dust proof strike?

Answer: Yes.

Question: Does Rockwood offer longer locking bullets?

Answer: Yes. Special order #555BXL (please specify size).

Question: Can replacement parts be ordered?

Answer: Yes, replacement fasteners, extension rods (555RODONLY), strikes (555S) and strike guides (555G) can be ordered.

Question: What is the bolt throw?

Answer: 3/4" for both 555 & 557.

Question: What is the bolt length?

Answer: Standard is 1 1/2".

Question: What is the rating and purpose for the Bottom Fire Bolt?

Answer: When the door is subject to 230° F, the plug and black plastic cover will melt, allowing the bolt to project, locking the leaves together.

Question: On a 555 UL sticker, there is a #13S2. What does this # stand for?

Answer: This is the control number assigned by UL specific to Rockwood Manufacturing Products.

Question: What Auto or Semi-Auto flush bolt can be used to replace the Rockwood 555?

Answer: 2842/2845 templates have a very minimal difference for the door prep, however slight field modification may be required. Templates are available on the Rockwood Manufacturing website.

Question: Does Rockwood Manufacturing supply lead lining for 550, 555 & 557?

Answer: The actual flush bolt cannot have lead lining applied to the flush bolt. Please consult door manufacturer.

Question: How much shorter is the Actual Rod length than the length which is ordered?

Answer: Actual rod length is 2" shorter than ordered length. Example: 555-24 is actually 22".

Question: Can 557 Flush Bolt Rods be extended?

Answer: No, extension rods are not available to change the overall size of the deadbolt or product.
