What is it???

A comprehensive and growing archive of SAEM teachings. At the moment it is focused on the Professional Track materials that Practitioners have covered – Edge, Hygiene, Med Bag, Pract 1 – 4, & EPA.

This archive will grow to include more Practitioner level classes, documents, images, training videos/audios, and e-manuals. The most current versions of all materials will be added and available.

A way for Practitioners to benefit from the years spent creating, organizing and storing all this material, and to support the ongoing work of assembling this archive – a clear demonstration of the depth of the SAEM legacy, and a way for it to survive the lives of our founder and all us. A huge step in establishing the depth and credibility of SAEM.

Content/Benefits

Practitioners have access to the current version of any Professional Track class they have completed. For example, a Level II Practitioner will have access to the current Pract I/II materials, but not to the Pract IV materials until they complete that course.

While the class archives on the Tribe site are excellent for managing the release of weekly information during an ongoing class series, it has its limitations. When searching for materials years after a class has completed, it's unreasonable to think we'll all remember which module to search for a particular subject. In the Legacy Library, you can search all of your classes for specific subjects, independent of class or module. This applies to the class videos, documents, images, or training materials.

Some Continuing Ed courses will be included on the site, regardless of whether you have completed it. Example – the "New Energies Download" classes in 2022 and 2023 are on the site for all to view/review. We want all practitioners to be working with these new energies, and understand the updated approach of characterizing different types of energies based on their use.

At least one Continuing Ed class will be offered as a benefit of membership each year. In 2026 we have three three-hour "New Energies" classes scheduled. The registration fee for that class alone (if not enrolled in the Legacy Library) comes close to covering the cost of your entire membership.

We will be phasing out the ongoing use of the Tribe site as the Legacy Library continues to evolve.
