Vertical Conduit Congestion Removal

What?

Vertical Chakra Conduit Congestion is a blockage occurring in the vertical conduits that run through each of the currents of all of the chakras. The function conduit is at the front in the intentionality of the function current and the others two are at the rear in the receptivity; the wisdom conduit in the wisdom node of receptivity and the purpose conduit right next to it in the purpose node.

Why?

Vertical Chakra Conduit Congestion comes up for release for many of the same reasons Soul Path Congestion does. It is another way the personality continues to evolve and in this unique way, deconstruct as it is growing toward a more authentic expression. We learn as much about the client from what is out of connection and communication within the Chakra system as we do the portions where information is moving with no obstruction. What distinguishes the Conduit Congestion is that the communications between chakras is at the root of the issue and not the flow of energy to create the fuel of the chakra.

How?

- Understand the congestion by understanding the location of the Vertical Chakra Conduit Congestion. Draw relevance to the client's life using what you already know about the involved chakras and the currents.
- Vertical Chakra Conduit Congestion is about bringing awareness of the location of blockage to consciousness and learning about how that blockage has impacted the client's persona. They usually frustrate easy internal connections and as a result cause damping down of vibrancy and freedom of expression.
- Defining it, owning it and releasing it are required.

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1. At the edge, with permission, start the diagnostic data collection. Determine that the individual has a Vertical Chakra Conduit Congestion by dowsing: yes/no, taking the pulse and conducting a brief (5-10 minutes) interview.
2. Locate the Vertical Chakra Conduit Congestion in the structure by dowsing and sensing. Determine which chakra is affected and which chakra conduit is congested.
3. Gently palpate the Congestion to learn size, texture, exact location and density. Diagram the congestion describing it for your records.
4. Understand the congestion by understanding the location of the Vertical Chakra Conduit Congestion. Explain this to the client. A VCCC is about awareness of the blockage and discovering how that blockage has impacted the client's experience. *Analyzing this information briefly to define the VCCC is all that is required to be ready for release.*
5. Dowse to see if the congestion is ready for release. Yes: proceed to step 6. No: go back to step 4 and go into the understanding of the congestion again. You will have either missed something or new information will be available that is necessary for release.
6. Open the top aperture of the affected VCC by flipping of the top of the little stove pipe hat located on top of the Aspect associated with the VCC. For purpose current – open both Emotional Aspect and Psychological Aspect hats.
7. Release is all that is required for Vertical Chakra Conduit Congestion. Bring in *ULL* into the Vertical Chakra Conduit that is congested and direct it into the point of congestion. Continue doing this until the blockage releases and the currents are all flowing freely again.
8. Close hat lid and go to next current if affected.
9. Bring in *Harmonizing the BES*
10. Bring in *I,B,W,S,I,B*
