SOCO/SAFE

SOCOSOLV SDS 70/30 is a virucidal surface cleaner and sanitizer containing 73.2% ethanol, in line with current Biocide regulations. It evaporates quickly, making it suitable for all types of work surfaces.

This ready-to-use solution, available as a liquid or in pre-saturated wipes, is sprayed or wiped onto surfaces. It does not require rinsing⁽¹⁾ or drying.

SOCOSAT SDS 70/30 are wipes (different fabrics & different sizes) which are pre-saturated with the **SOCOSOLV SDS 70/30 surface cleaner & sanitizer**.

- Virucidal according to EN 14476+A2
- Bactericidal, fungicidal and yeasticidal
- Works immediately and comprehensively, with no need to rinse⁽¹⁾
- Leaves no residue on the surface
- Suitable for all types of surfaces such as metals, plastics, painted surfaces, rubber and electronic components (biocidal PT2).
- Some articles can be used on surfaces in direct contact with food or animal feed (biocidal PT4)⁽¹⁾.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Precautions before disinfection:

- Wearing gloves is recommended for long and repeated use when the product is for PT2 & PT4 use.
- Switch off electrical equipment beforehand.

- Do not use on damp or wet surfaces.
- Use only on alcohol-resistant surfaces.

Good disinfection practices using 70/30 Ethanol-based rapid disinfectant solutions:

The surfaces to be disinfected must be completely free of organic impurities and must not be visibly contaminated. **Visible impurities must be removed beforehand.**

Once the surface is completely free of impurities, use **SOCOSOLV SDS 70/30** at room temperature, without mixing or dilution, for disinfection:

- **wipe with SOCOSAT SDS 70/30⁽⁴⁾ pre-saturated ready-to-use wipes:** clean the surface and let the alcohol disinfect during 5 minutes. Do not dry or rinse⁽¹⁾ the surface.
- **wipe with a cloth:** clean the surface with a single-use cloth, previously soaked with **SOCOSOLV SDS 70/30** liquid solution. Allow the alcohol to disinfect during 5 minutes and do not dry or rinse⁽¹⁾ the surface.
- **spray the SOCOSOLV SDS 70/30** liquid solution with a spray bottle, using the squirt setting (not a mist setting, which can increase the risk of inhalation): aim and spray onto the surface and clean the surface with a single-use cloth. Let the alcohol disinfect during 5 minutes and do not dry or rinse⁽¹⁾ the surface.

It is important that you disinfect regularly (every 6 hours and between each change of shift or workstation) all frequently-touched non-porous surfaces such as door handles, work tables, desks, counters, as well as all shared objects such as computer keyboards, mice, and telephones, etc...
