1 General information

The pages that follow contain all of the information (subject to technical change) needed for installation of the silencer exhaust tip on a standard exhaust system. The instructions provided describe how to fit a silencer exhaust tip. The process for installing a second exhaust tip is the same.

Installation of the silencer exhaust tip can be performed by a qualified workshop. No special tools, test equipment or vehicle-specific literature will be needed to perform the installation. Incorrect installation can result in personal injury or damage to the vehicle, other vehicles or the silencer exhaust tip.

2 Retrofitting a silencer exhaust tip

2.1 Cleaning the silencer exhaust



WARNING!

The attachment area on the silencer exhaust tip must be free from rust and grease!

- Remove any traces of rust from the silencer exhaust.

2.2 Positioning the exhaust tip





WARNING!

The exhaust tip must only be fitted once during installation!

- Position the exhaust tip -1- on the silencer exhaust pipe -2- until resting against the spacer springs.

- Turn the exhaust tip -1- slightly so that the tip bevel -3- is parallel to the pipe bevel -2-.




2.3 Pushing on the exhaust tip

- Push the exhaust tip -1- into place.

Note

The exhaust must be positively engaged with the flange on the exhaust tip.




2.4 Checking the alignment of the silencer exhausts

Vehicles with twin exhaust pipes:

- Check that the silencer exhaust pipes are aligned so that they are equidistant from the bumper sections.
- Distance -a- = distance -b-.

Caution!

If the pipe is not equidistant, ask a qualified workshop to check and realign the exhaust system where necessary!



Vehicles with single exhaust:

- Check that the (silencer) exhaust pipe is aligned so that it is equidistant from the bumper section.
- Distance -a- = distance -b-.

If the pipe is not equidistant, ask a qualified workshop to check and realign the exhaust system where necessary!
