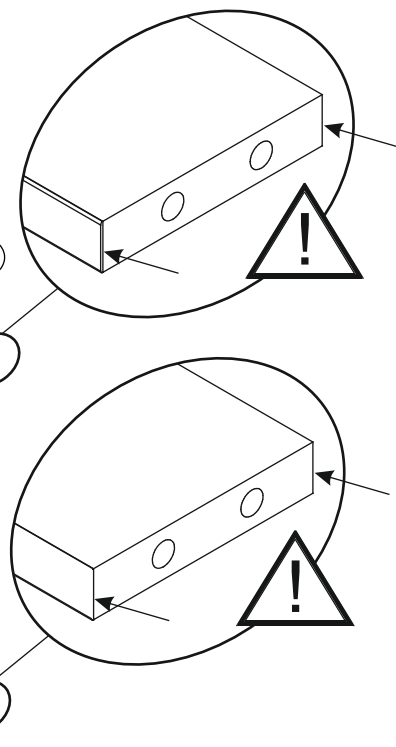
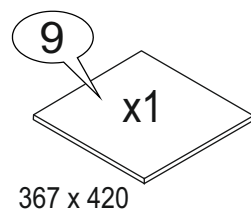
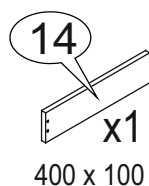
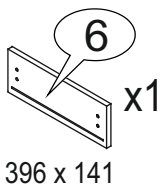
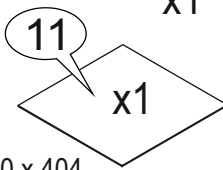
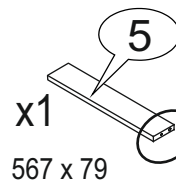
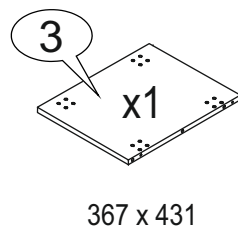
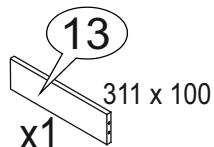
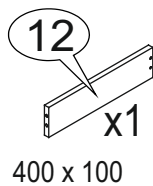
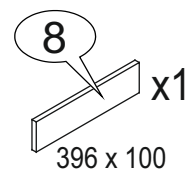
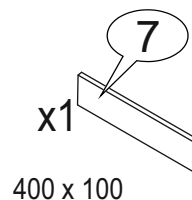
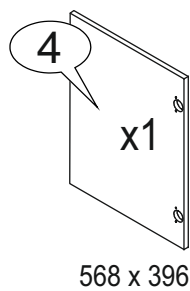
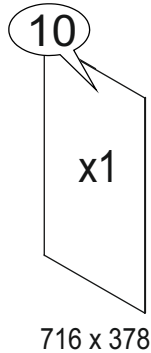
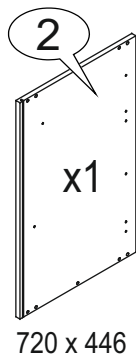
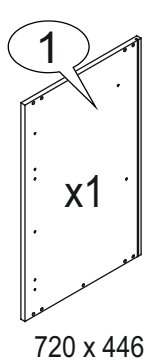
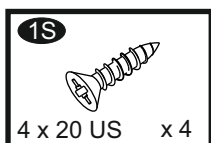
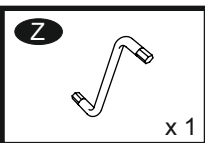
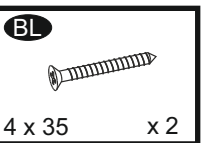
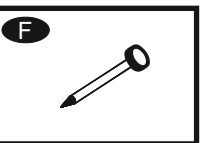
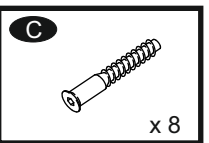
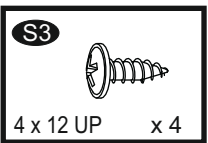
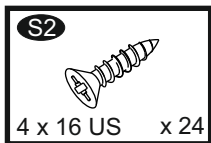
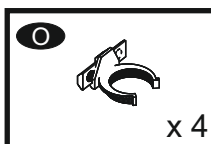
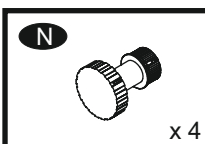
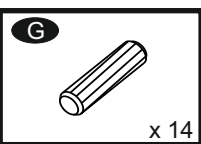
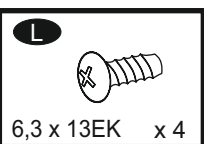
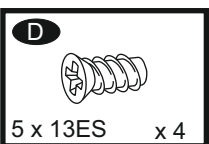
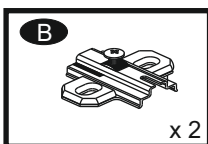
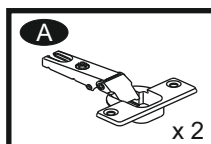
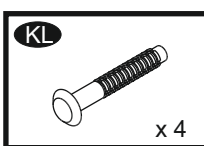
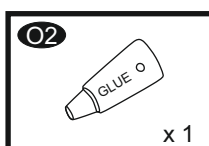
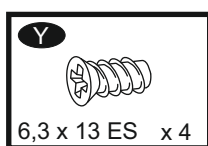
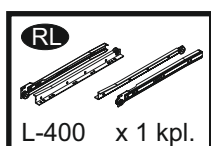
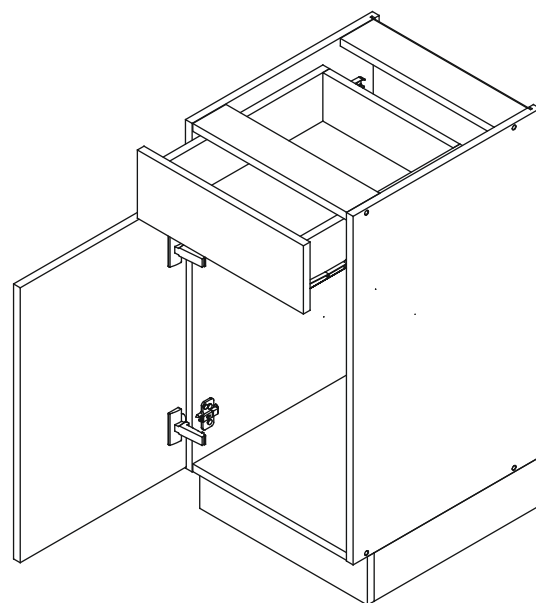
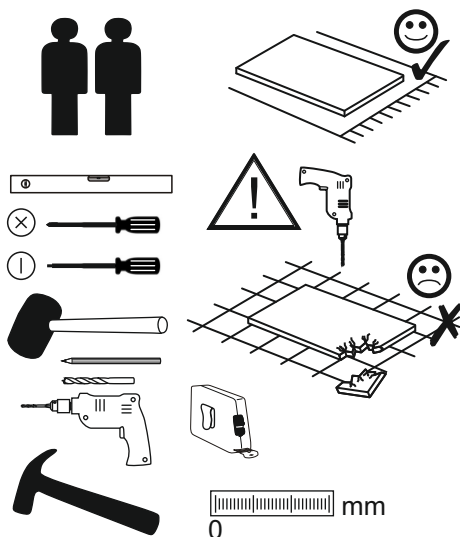




This exploded view diagram illustrates the assembly of a cabinet. The components are labeled as follows:
