## Kathy Pro X Pet Feeder

Automatic Cat Feeder with Camera FC-S02

### Three Connection Steps for the APP

- Ensure that the Kathy Pro X Pet Feeder is within 10 meters of the router, and that the Wi-Fi and Bluetooth functions on the smart device are enabled.
- Ensure that the power cable of the Kathy Pro X Pet Feeder is connected to a power source, and that 4 AA batteries are properly installed.
- Before setting up the network, press and hold the reset button on the side of the Kathy Pro X Pet Feeder for 10 seconds to reset the device. Once the indicator light flashes slowly in blue, the APP connection can be made. (If the connection fails, please repeat this step.)

### 1. Bluetooth Quick Connection



1. On the home page, click "Add Device" and the app will automatically search for nearby



2. Select the device to add and click "Add"



3. Select the Wi-Fi network to connect to, enter the correct password, and



4. After clicking "Finish," the app will automatically return to the home page and enter the feeder's control panel.

1. On the home page, click " Add Device" select "Small Appliances" on the left, and



2. Select the network setup method as "Wi-Fi", and then follow the onscreen instructions.



3. Select the Wi-Fi network to connect to, enter the correct password, and wait for the device to connect.



4. After clicking "Finish", the app will automatically return to the home page and enter the feeder's control panel.




### Feeder Disassembly and Cleaning

- 7. The shape and density of pet food particles may cause slight variations in the storage container's capacity.
- 8. In battery-powered mode, the standby time can last up to 12 days. Please insert batteries before going on a business trip.
- 9. The weight of each portion dispensed may vary depending on the density of the food. 10. Do not forcefully insert the tray into the device, as it could damage the components.
- Please follow the video instructions for proper installation. 11. To remove the tray, insert your hand into the hole, rotate it counterclockwise, and pull upwards. After removing the tray, you can wipe the inside with a wet wipe. Do not wash it
- 12. After power loss, the device's clock may become inaccurate, causing feeding schedules to fail. Please reconfigure the network and synchronize the device's tim
