






A most remarkable detective


A man of mind and matter

- At only twenty years old, Doyle sold his first story, *The Mystery of Sasassa Valley*, in 1879.
- Doyle was knighted in 1902 but declined to use 'Sir' in his public life.
- As a member of the Crimes Club organisation, Doyle helped solve real-life crimes.

Arthur Conan Doyle (1859-1930)

Arthur Conan Doyle lived a life as adventurous as his exceptional detective's cases. Born and educated in Edinburgh, Scotland, Doyle became a renowned physician and correspondent and a staunch advocate for science, justice and good sportsmanship. His love of exploring took him around the world, from the Arctic and Africa to America and New Zealand. His stories and daring real-life exploits have captivated generations of readers. Widely acclaimed for pioneering detective fiction, Doyle's impact on literature, the British justice system and popular culture endures today.

The cosy, at times chaotic, gas-lit apartment is where Sherlock Holmes and Dr Watson crack London's toughest mysteries.
