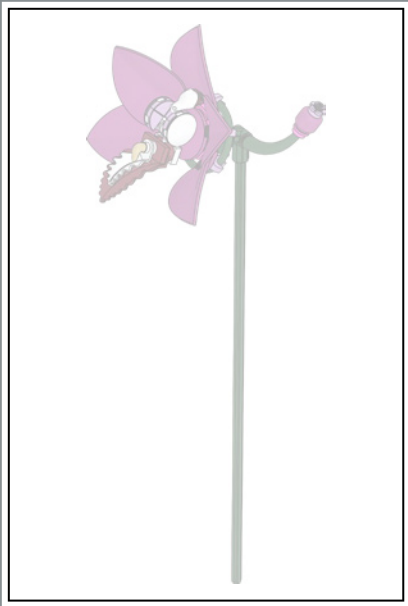
BOAT ORCHID

Cymbidium orchids are documented in records from the time of Confucius, around 500 BCE, making them the oldest known cultivated orchid species.

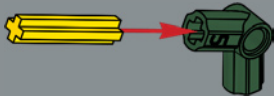
