TEAMS INVITED: Cheboygan, Charlevoix, East Jordan, Grayling, Inland Lakes, Kalkaska, St. Michael's of Petoskey, Rudyard, Sault Ste. Marie.

The fee for the meet is \$175.00 per school. Schools with less than 12 athletes (boys and girls combined) can contact us for a different rate.

RULES: This meet will follow the National Federation and MHSAA guidelines

SUBSTITUTIONS AND SCRATCHES: Due in the press box no later than **3:15** on the day of the meet. No additions will be accepted. Substitutes can be made with the existing times, heights and distances remaining. Entrants on relay teams may be changed. Please use the attached Scratch Form for changes. This form must be turned in before the Coach's Meeting.

SHOES: Running flats or **spikes of 1/8" or less** will be allowed. Shoes/spikes will be subject to inspection. (Spikes cannot be extending more than 1/8" from bottom of shoe.) Shot Put and Discus pads are concrete. NO SPIKES.

MARKING ON SURFACES: <u>NO TAPE</u> will be allowed on any of the latex acrylic surfaces, this includes the track itself (relays), the high jump pad, the pole vault and long jump runways. CHALK will be provided at the Coach's Meeting.

DRESSING FACILITIES: No locker room facilities are located at the track complex. Please dress at home.

RESTROOMS: Restroom facilities are located next to the white Rotary building.

CONCESSIONS: TBD **ADMISSION:** NO CHARGE FOR ADMISSION THIS YEAR!

REGISTRATION: Athletic.net. Entries are DUE by Monday, May 3rd @ 4:00pm. The day of the meet, we will re-open entries for drop/add only and it will close by 3:00pm on day of meet (5/4). There will be no drop & add entries at the meet.

COACH'S MEETING: One coach representing each team must attend the coaches' meeting at 3:30 in the press box. Preliminary running events will be discussed at this time as will the starting heights for pole vault and high jump.

FIELD EVENT ORDER:

ODD YEARS:

BOYS—Discus, Pole Vault and Long Jump first. Followed by Shot Put and High Jump. GIRLS—Shot Put and High Jump first. Followed by Long Jump, Pole Vault and Shot Put.

EVEN YEARS:

BOYS—Shot Put and High Jump first. Followed by Long Jump, Pole Vault and Shot Put. GIRLS-- Discus, Pole Vault and Long Jump first. Followed by Shot Put and High Jump.

PLEASE TRY TO HAVE YOUR ATHLETES COMPLETE AS MANY, IF NOT ALL ATTEMPTS IN THEIR PARTICULAR FIELD EVENTS PRIOR TO THE COMMENCEMENT OF THE RUNNING EVENTS. As always, it makes for a better meet for all concerned; if we can get the bulk of the field events done before the running events begin. If an athlete has to leave a field event to go to a running event, he/she must inform the field event judge that they are leaving and return in a timely fashion.

LONG JUMP: The long jump will be conducted open pit. Contestants will be given 3 attempts.

POLE VAULT: Coaches must sign in their athletes to verify their weight and pole capacity. This should be done on the event sheet clipboard during the Substitution and Scratch period up in the press box prior to competition.

THROWING EVENTS: Shot Put and Discus throwers will be placed in flights. Each athlete will be given 4

SHOT PUT RELAY: Each relay team will be comprised of 4 throwers from your team. This will count as one of the four events allotted each athlete. (4x100 using a shot put in lieu of a baton). The Shot Put Relay will be run as the event prior to the 1600M Relay.

INFIELD: Coaches may be on the infield to coach their athletes during the meet. Please stay clear of the timers, the timer's sight of distance along the track straightaway, and the finish line so as to not impede with the administration of the meet. We also ask that coaches do not have their teams gathering on the infield at anytime, especially in front of the press box between the start of the sprints and the timers. Please have your athletes leave the infield upon completion of their events.

The MHSAA allows the use of electronic communications devices in designated unrestricted areas. The designated unrestricted areas will be the bleachers and the sidewalk around the outside of the track.

EVENT RESULTS: Event results will be announced as they become available and will be posted at the back of the pressbox.

SCORING: 10-8-6-4-2-1

AWARDS: Medals will go to the first three (3) place winners in all events.

Trophies will be given to the 1st place boys and 1st place girls teams at the conclusion of the meet.

In the event of ties, additional medals will be awarded.
