POLE VAULT:	This event will be run in rotations of "five-alive". When the number of competitors reach one more than places to be awarded (9), then raises will be 3".
	Boys : 9:30 a.m Starting height is 8'3". First raise will be 8' 9" with 6" raises thereafter.

	<u>Girls</u>: Starting height is 7'6". First raise will be 8'0" with 6" raises thereafter.

DISCUS:	This event will run in flights. Each flight will have three trials (2-1) in the prelims. Top 9 advance to finals in inverse order taking an additional 3 trials (1-1-1).

HIGH JUMP:	Only competitors will be allowed in the High Jump area. Coaches can coach their athletes outside of the flagged area.
