The Qualifying for the 2023 Mid Michigan MEGASTAR Meet will be based on Qualifying Standards the same as in 2019 \& 2022.
There will be different standards for each division and they are based on our results for the last several years. All marks must come from official meets on athletic.net and if meet was hand timed correct conversion should be used. Athletic. net often handles this conversion correctly on it's own. Please make sure the meets you are attending upload results to athletic.net and mark them official.

Participations for athletes is FREE with no athlete or team entry fee. Spectators $\$ 5$ admission charge.
Teams will be placed Divisions based on enrollment. Schools feeding to D1 \& D2 Large School, Schools feeding to D3 \& D4 Small School. Team Scoring to 8 places (10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1)

Teams need to add the meet to their athletic.net schedule by Monday May 22 ${ }^{\text {nd }}, 2023$ and then athletes who have met the Qualifying Standards and will compete must be Registered on athletic.net by Friday May $26^{\text {th }}$ at 11:59 PM. Entry will not be open until May $1^{\text {st }}, 2023$.

The $800 \mathrm{~m}, 1600 \mathrm{~m}, 3200 \mathrm{~m} \& 3200 \mathrm{~m}$ Relay will aim to each have 1 heat with both divisions. All other individual running events will have around 4 heats based on time mixing the divisions.

1. Meet Champion T-Shirts to overall Event Champion, 1 per event, combined Divisions.
2. Medals to the top 6 in each Individual event in each Division
3. Medals to the top 3 teams in each Relay event in each Division

Medals are awarded on the infield in front of the bleachers, in the order event results become available. Please ensure your athletes are aware of the importance of staying on schedule for medal presentations. They, and you, need to listen for presentations to be announced. If an athlete does not show up for the presentation, their medal may be requested from the presenter by you or the athlete after presentation. If your athlete will not be attending the presentation, the coach may get the medal from the presenter before presentation. A Medal Presentation schedule will be sent out prior to the meet so that you will have an idea on when to expect Presentations for certain events.
