PACKER RELAYS TRACK & FIELD MEET FRIDAY, MAY 5, 2023 - WEST FARGO HIGH SCHOOL

Meet Information:

- 1. All teams should dress at home; dressing and shower facilities will not be available.
- 2. <u>Entries</u>: Each team is allowed <u>5</u> athletes per event and <u>1 relay team</u>.
- 3. 1/4" pyramid spikes will be allowed on all jumping and running surfaces. No other spikes will be allowed on the running/jumping surfaces.
- 4. The Shot Put and Discus rings are on concrete slabs and the Javelin event is located on a grass field.
- 5. The Long and Triple Jumps events will have (3) attempts, with the top 9 advancing to finals.
- 6. The Shot Put, Discus & Javelin will have (3) attempts, with the top 9 advancing to finals.
- 7. The Pole Vault starting height for Boys and Girls will be determined at the coaches meeting.
- 8. The High Jump-starting height for Boys and Girls will be determined at the coaches meeting.
- 9. Each school must furnish all personal items, equipment, towels, etc. Starting blocks will be furnished and placed in the lanes for use.
- 10. No tape is allowed on the track. Teams are responsible for their own markers for relay zones.
- 11. Teams may set up camps only under the stadium, in the stands. **No team camps or throwing** implements allowed on the infield.
- 12. Have buses unload your teams on the north side of the hockey arena.
- 13. Meet conduct and eligibility will follow the rules of the N.D.H.S.A.A.
- 14. **Entry Fee:** There will be a \$150.00 entry fee for each team entered. Boys and Girls from the same school are separate teams.

Admission for spectators will be \$6.00 for adults and \$4.00 for students
