Age

8 & under (born 2015 +)
9 - 10 (born 2013-2014)
11 - 12 (born 2012-2011)
13 - 14 (born 2009-2010)
15 - 16 (born 2007-2008)
17 - 18 (born 2005-2006)
* athletes born in 2004 are also eligible if they do not turn 19 on or before 7/24/2023

ENTRY PROCESS:

Individual Entries: **\$9.00** per event
Relay Entries: **\$36.00** per relay team
Decathlon/Heptathlon: **\$22** per event
Triathlon/Pentathlon: **\$17** per event

<https://www.athletic.net/team/67709/track-and-field-outdoor/2023> by Monday, July 3 at 7:00pm. **Late entries will not be allowed.** Online registration opens **6/27/2023**. **Pre-authorization of a credit card will be required for team entries and unattached entries will require immediate payment.** Accuracy of data entered is the responsibility of each club and/or athlete. **Please verify team and athlete data within Athletic.net for accuracy prior to submitting entries.**

WAIVER: All athletes who participate in the USATF Junior Olympic Program must complete the Junior Olympic Participant Waiver and Release form. This form is already integrated in the online entry system and can be completed electronically.

ADVANCEMENTS:

The top 8 athletes from running and field events will advance to Nationals. The top 5 multi-event athletes in each age group and any athlete that meets the National standards may advance to the National Championships. (Those standards may be found in the passport for the national meet)

IMPLEMENT WEIGH-IN: Athletes must check in their implements under the east grand stand prior to their day's event.

EVENT CHECK-IN: There will be separate check-in areas for Running and Field events. Track athletes must check in at the clerking tent at first call and field athletes check in at their respective events at first call.

COMPETITION BIB NUMBERS: All competitors must wear their assigned bib numbers during the competition and on the front on their jerseys only. If an athlete loses the bib number, a replacement can be purchased for a fee of \$10. Bib numbers will be distributed to Coaches/athletes at **Packet pick up area/table**.

EVENT RESULTS: Live results will be posted at live.pntfo.com

AWARDS: USATF Junior Olympic medals will be awarded to the top 5 individuals and the top 5 relay teams in each event of each age division.

PROTESTS: There will be a \$50 fee for all protests. Protests must be submitted to the Protest Referee (will be at the awards tent) at once and not later than 30 minutes after a result has been posted. The protest fee will be refunded if the protest is upheld.

General Entry Fee - \$5.00/Day

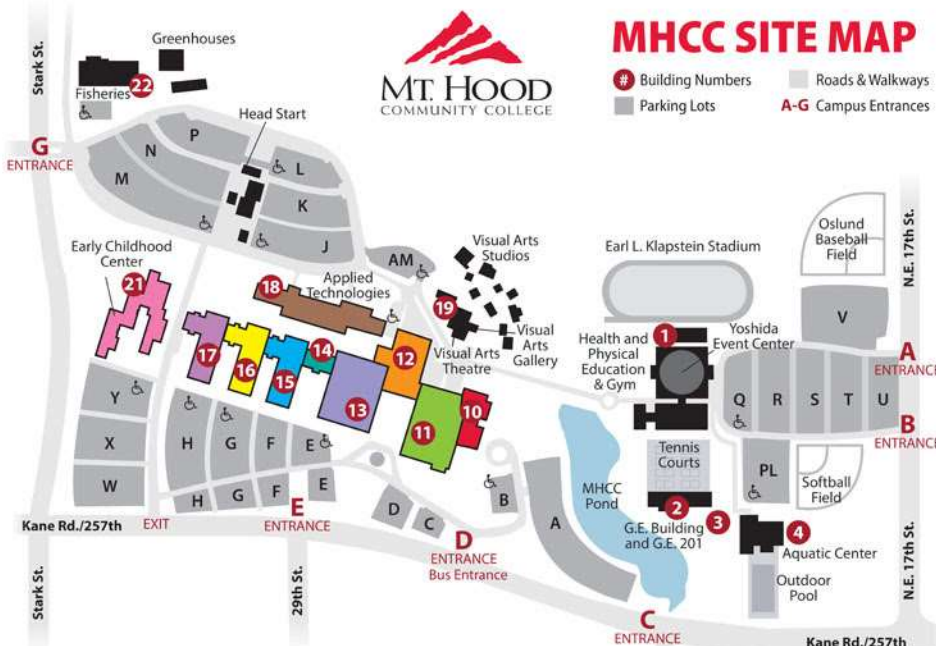
Seniors - \$3.00/Day
