- Long jump, high jump and pole vault approaches are all-weather.

- Up to 3 entries will be allowed from each team for the 800, 1600 and 3200, as well as the shot put and discus. ALL other races, and field events, will be limited to 2 entries per team. \*\*\*No more than TWO athletes from the same team can score in any single event.
- Coaches meeting (4pm) will be a SCRATCH MEETING ONLY. We will not be adding kids on meet day.

- Throwers 4x1 is an exhibition and will not be scored. Only those athletes who have throwing marks on athletic.net may run. (CHECK WITH COACH SHORT).
- Top 6 relay finishers in each event will score (10, 8, 6, 4, 2, 1)
- Top 5 finishers in all other events will score (10, 8, 6, 4, 2)
- The winning team will receive a championship plaque.
- 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> places in each event will receive medals. 4<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup>- ribbons. Pizza 4x1 winner: a pizza
- Each event champion will receive a free t-shirt commemorating his performance.
- Full concession stand.
- Runners will be staged in the middle of the football field, if conditions allow.
- Awards may be picked up in the press box at the end of the meet. They will not be mailed.
