Meet Information

- 1. Order of track events: HS B, HS G, 8th grade B, 8th grade G, 7th grade B, 7th grade G.
 - a. For events only offered to HS, order will be HS B, HS G
 - b. Depending on number of entries, 7th and 8th grade gender groups may be combined in the 1600.
 - c. Depending on number of entries, boys and girls may be combined in the 3200.
- 2. Teams should arrive dressed in uniforms, as showers and locker rooms will not be available.
- 3. Entry fee: \$150 per gender, per school (both genders would be \$300).
- 4. Running and jumping surfaces are synthetic: 1/4" pyramid spikes only are allowed.
- 5. Team camps should be located in the bleachers or in the spaces behind the bleachers.
- 6. Entries for all events are UNLIMITED. Please enter event assignments by 6:00PM on April 22nd.
- 7. High school divisions for field events (throws, jumps, and vaults) will finish before middle school divisions begin.
 - a. High school field event competitors will receive three attempts; athletes meeting minimum standards will receive three additional attempts. Jumps are going to be cafeteria style and must be completed within the specified time (listen for announcements for final attempt opportunities).
 - b. Middle school field event competitors will receive three attempts no finals.
- 8. HS Pole Vault: Girls start height will be 6'0" then move to 7' and then 6" thereafter, until a champion has been determined. Boys start height will be 8'0" then move to 9 and then 6" thereafter until a champion has been determined. Coaches: make sure your vaulters bring their helmets and correct pole for their weight.
- 9. High jump: start height will be determined by high jump coaches. The bar will then be raised 2" every completed height until a champion has been determined.
- 10. Each school must furnish their own batons, exchange zone markers, shots, discs etc.
- 11. Starting blocks will be furnished.
- 12. All athletes in running events should report to the northeast corner of the track on first call for their event. 300H will marshal in the southwest corner. Accommodations may be made to run 100, 100H/110H and 200 on the south side of the track.
- 13. Buses should drop athletes off in the student parking lot along 17th Avenue North.
- 14. In case of inclement weather, each school will be notified regarding postponement or rescheduling. Entry fees will be returned in case postponement results in a team's cancellation.
- 15. Meet conduct and eligibility will follow the rules of NDHSAA.
- 16. Trainers will be on site or call. Please bring your own supplies.
- 17. Admission to this event is: \$6.00 for adults and \$4.00 for students.
- 18. Concessions will be available for purchase on-site.

If any entry changes are needed after the deadline, please email Keith Lehman (lehmank@fargo.k12.nd.us) as soon as possible in advance of the meet. Changes will be made if possible, but please try to minimize last-minute changes.
