Age Divisions

8 & under (born 2016 +)
9 - 10 (born 2014-2015)
11 - 12 (born 2012-2013)
13 - 14 (born 2010-2011)
15 - 16 (born 2008-2009)
17 - 18 (born 2006-2007)
* athletes born in 2005 are also eligible if they do not turn 19 on or before 7/28/2024

ENTRY PROCESS:

Individual Entries: \$13 per event

Relay Entries: \$52 per relay team

Decathlon/Heptathlon: \$26 per event

Triathlon/Pentathlon: \$21 per event

Club Administrators and Unattached Athletes should register online. Online registration opens **June 25, 2024**.

Pre-authorization of a credit card will be required for team entries and unattached entries will require immediate payment.

AWARDS: Medals will be awarded to the top five (5) individuals and top five (5) relays

ADVANCEMENTS: **Top 5 from each event for each age group/gender automatically advance to the National Junior Olympics**

The combined events: The top two (2) finishers plus any other athletes that meet the published qualifying standards.

The National Junior Olympic Championships will be held from Monday, July 22nd to Sunday, July 28th

IMPLEMENT WEIGH-IN: A centralized implement weigh-in station will be established and communicated during the meet.

EVENT CHECK-IN: There will be separate check-in areas for Running and Field events. Athletes must check in at these designated areas 45 minutes prior to the event's scheduled starting time. All athletes will be required to remain in the designated warm-up areas after checking in.

COMPETITION BIB NUMBERS: All competitors must wear their assigned bib numbers during competition and on the front of their jerseys only. If an athlete loses the bib number, a replacement can be purchased for a fee of \$10. Bib numbers will be provided in the team packets.

EVENT RESULTS: During competition, event results will be posted online via Live Meet Results.

PROTESTS: There will be a \$50 fee for all protests. Protests must be submitted to the Protest Referee at once and not later than 30 minutes after a result has been announced. The protest fee will be refunded if the protest is upheld.

RULES – CONDUCT & FACILITY:

- Tents will only be allowed in the top rows of home bleachers and anywhere on the visitor bleachers. Check for signs before putting up Tents.
- No littering. The cost of using facilities is increasing because of cleanup. Please pick up, even if you are not the one who put it down! Please put trash in receptacles. Please clean up after yourself!
- Please Do NOT bring loud radios or music, pets, or unnecessary distractions to the meet.
- NO cooking or barbecuing.
- NO PETS allowed at the venues
- No selling of merchandise without permission from the meet director.
- Please volunteer your help wherever needed!!!!
- Unacceptable behavior by coaches, athletes or spectators of any kind will result in removal from the Meets

REUNIFICATION ZONE: A coach or parent with the designated wristband will need to pick up the 7-8 and 9-10 athletes from the designated area on the field. That wristband is not your entry into the stadium. You will still have to pay the daily fee or weekend pass.

GATE ADMISSION FEES: Day pass - \$15; Weekend pass - \$35; Two day pass - \$25. Coaches on the USATF Coaches Registry on the USATF Youth Background cleared list can enter free of charge. Children 5 and under are free.
