About this event

We are excited to present an event unlike your typical high school track meet. This meet will blend competitive spirit with entertainment and fun to the final weeks of your season. Geared toward the majority of athletes that make up our teams, this meet is for the kids who work extremely hard, but might not have qualified for the state finals. This allows any athlete to have one last chance to PR in an event when they are likely at their best.

To allow for both a fun and efficient meet there are some tweaks we have decided to make.

- **No relays** while it is possible to have a relay PR, we decided the focus of this meet is on individual events. We don't want coaches to have to worry about filling relay spots that might tire an athlete out for the event they are trying to reach a PR in.
- Lower event entry limits We did not want to limit athletes like a typical invitational, so in order to keep competitor numbers under control we are instead going to limit the number of events any one athlete can compete in to 3 total events. This allows athletes to be fresh for each event they compete in for a great chance at a PR. Entering athletes into LESS than 3 events is encouraged!

3:00 PM	Early Bird Throwing flights - We will accept the first 12 Boys discus throwers and 12 girls shot putters in this optional flight. This will reduce numbers and increase efficiency in later flights.
3:30 PM	Boys' Pole Vault Begins (Girls' vault begins 30 min after Boys conclude.) Girls' Shot Put - 4 attempts – NO FINALS (Boys to follow) Boys' Discus – 4 attempts – NO FINALS (Girls to follow) Boys and Girls' Long Jump 4 attempts – NO FINALS (3:30 pm-5:30 pm) Girls' High Jump (Boys' begin 30 min after Girls conclude)

Running events begin following schedule below.

Pole Vault

Starting Heights - Girls: 6'2" Boys: 8'2" - bar will be raised 6 inches each raise. We will use these unconventional heights to give athletes a chance to go a couple inches higher than their previous best without as big of a jump!The following raise chart will be followed:

Starting Heights - Girls: 4'1" Boys: 5'1" - bar will be raised 2 inches each raise. We will use these unconventional heights to give athletes a chance to go 1 inch further than their previous best without as big of a jump! The following raise chart will be followed:

OPEN 400 relay (description below)

Special event descriptions:

OPEN 2000m Steeplechase: ANYONE can try this event (Coach, HS athletes, Parents, etc.) This will not be a certified steeplechase. We will use hurdles in place of steeple barriers and there will not be a true water jump. But if you ever wanted your high school athletes to get a taste of one of the most exciting events in track and field, this is your opportunity! Race will use 30" hurdles (lowest setting). They will be placed 4 lanes wide at each of the 5 jump locations. We will determine whether to run 2 heats (boys and girls) or combined based on the number of participants.

Elimination Mile: Each team may enter one athlete to battle it out in this event of both speed and strategy! Depending on the number of competitors, runners will be eliminated each lap in order to end up with 3 athletes to compete for victory on the final lap. All spectators and athletes will be encouraged to come down onto the track homestretch area to cheer on the competitors!

OPEN 400 relay: Construct your dream team made up of coaches, sprinters, jumpers, or throwers. Put them in any order you would like. Here are 2 more twists: 1. Each of the 4 runners can run ANY distance they want, as long as the whole relay covers 400 meters. 2. You can use anything you choose for your baton as long as it does not interfere with other teams (leaves your lane), or is a danger to the competitors.

<u>Team Entry Fee:</u> \$100 per team. Boys' and Girls' teams are considered separate teams for this meet. (\$200 per school if B/G are attending)
