



11th Annual AAU West Coast National Primary Championships Track & Field

The AAU West Coast National Primary Championships has been designed to promote the grass root programs. It gives the opportunity to athletes in the Primary Division to compete with kids their own age. The meet will run in conjunction with the AAU West Coast Track & Field National Championships. Athletes in the Primary Division may compete in both meets, but only the West Coast National Primary Championships will have the single year age groups.

Online Entry

Registration will only be accepted online at www.athletic.net Only Visa, Master Card, Discover and American Express will be accepted. No refunds for entry fees will be granted after entry is submitted.

All athletes and coaches must have a 2025 AAU membership before registering online. For membership information or to purchase membership, go to www.aausports.org.

Once online meet entry has been accepted, no changes can be made. Upon completion of the online process, including the payment of entry fee, athlete entries are locked and a confirmation email is sent showing all athletes and events entered. Athletes can be added until the online meet entry is closed, but the entry and roster record of locked athletes cannot be changed.

Entry Deadline

Online entry must be submitted no later than Tuesday, June 24, 2025 11:59 PM Pacific Standard Time. It is the responsibility of the coach, designated administrator, athlete or parent to make sure all athletes are registered online.

Awards

All events are finals. The top eight (8) place finishers in each age group/division/event will be presented with a medal. Medals can be picked up at the awards tent approximately 20 minutes after the conclusion of the event.

Important Information

This is **NOT a qualifying meet to the AAU National Junior Olympic Games**. This is opportunity for the 8 and under age group to compete against other kids their same age.

Example: A 5 year old does not have to compete against an 8 year olds, only 5 year olds.

Athletes in this age group may compete in **BOTH** the AAU West Coast National Primary Championships Meet and the AAU West Coast Track & Field National Championships.
