Online Entry at Athletic.net

Entry fee is \$25.00 for each **ATHLETE**. No entry fees will be transferred or refunded. Athlete entries can not be processed without a valid 2026 AAU Membership. All AAU Memberships must be purchased in advance (pending status is not acceptable) You can obtain AAU Memberships by visiting www.aausports.org. **All entry fees must be paid online, no exceptions will be granted.**

This meet is open to any athlete that falls within the age divisions listed below. Athletes aged 13 and older may enter in up to a maximum of 4 events including relays. Athletes ages 12 and younger may enter in 3 events including relays. If an athlete is entered into too many events, meet management reserves the right to reject the athlete from one or more events without notification.

All teams and unattached athletes must utilize the Athletic.net online entry process via www.Athletic.net and locate the AAU North Carolina District Qualifier Meet under Events. Athlete entries can not be entered without a valid 2026 AAU Membership. Teams have until 11:59pm, Monday, June 1, 2026 to complete their athlete registrations. ***Please note that you must pay for your entries with a credit card online, or your entries will not be accepted.***

Age divisions are determined by year of birth. Listed below are the events that will take place in each age division. *Athletes who are still eighteen (18) years of age through the final day of AAU Junior Olympic Games August 2, 2026 shall be eligible to compete in the 17-18 year olds division*

Check-In Requirements

A packet will be provided for each team consisting of competition numbers, team roster, and events entered. A team representative will be responsible for picking up the packets. Packets can be picked up at the track facility. Be sure to have birth certificates available in the event Proof of Age is needed

Awards

AAU Championship Medals are awarded to the top three (3) finishers in each event and division. Awards will not be mailed to the athlete's home. It is the responsibility of athlete, coach or parent to pick up awards before leaving the meet.

Facility

The track is an 8-lane all-weather surface. Only ¼" or smaller pyramid spikes are allowed. Fully Automatic Timing & results will be done using Finishlynx Cameras interfaced with Hy-Tek Meet Manager. No smoking, radios, glass containers, or alcoholic beverages are allowed in the facility.

Refreshments

A Full Service Concession Stand will be provided as well as food trucks.

Equipment

Starting blocks and throwing implements will be provided by the meet management. Those that desire to utilize personal implements must obtain clearance from the meet official prior to use. If personal implements are used, they will not be released until the end of the competition for that age group.

Immediately after registering online, teams will receive a receipt from the website, which will produce a list of all athletes registered for the meet. This receipt should be used as your transcript of your meet entries. If your athletes do not appear on the confirmation sheet, they are not registered for the meet. Please take care of these issues prior to entry closure.

SAT/ACT WAIVERS: Any athlete scheduled to take a college entrance exam (SAT/ACT) the weekend of AAU North Carolina District Qualifier will be waived into the Regional Qualifier by the Regional Qualifier Program Coordinator upon receipt of the proper documentation. Documentation and the request in writing must be received no sooner than **April 22, 2026** and no later than **June 1, 2026**. Requests submitted after June 4, 2024 will **NOT** be reviewed.
