It is our privilege to invite you and your athletes to the 20th annual Monterey Bay Invitational, a Central Coast Section sanctioned meet. The 3.0 mile Championship course encompasses grass, wide dirt trails, long winding paths and challenging hills. The course has gained the reputation as one of the best places to race and is the alternating site of the CCS Championships. The 1.6 mile middle school loop utilizes the first segment of the high school course with a gradual uphill first mile and a fast downhill finish. The park itself is an amazing place to have an invitational with an abundance of picnic and BBQ areas and large grass play areas nestled among hundreds of giant oak trees.
