Course Description: A detailed map of the course will be sent out later. We had some work done this summer and had to reroute a small portion of the trail. We will be starting on the practice field and finishing the race inside the stadium.

- Minimum five runners per team in a Varsity race (for team points)
- Uniform-School jersey
- Track and course will be available for warm-up
- Awards to follow race
- Please park in the front parking lot at PHS, No bus access directly behind school.
- All lower parking areas are reserved for Handicap parking

Turf/Stadium: We are blessed to have the Michael Janecek trails and Machetanz Stadium. We want to keep our facility in top condition and ask that you adhere to the following rules.

- 1. Bicycles, rollerblades, skateboards and other recreational equipment are forbidden inside Machetanz Stadium.
- 2. The artificial turf and track must be kept free of glass and any sharp objects.
- 3. Food and drink, especially sunflower seed and Gatorade are not allowed on the track or turf. Water is the only consumable allowed on the turf.
- 4. No Pets other than service animals.
- 5. No wheeled vehicles on track other than approved school vehicles.
- 6. Metal cleats or cleats exceeding ¼ inch in length should not be used on the track
- Our track has a perimeter fence around it and all spectators and athletes are expected to stay behind the fence or in the bleachers.
