PARKING DIRECTIONS: \$10 Cash. Parking is available in the parking structure near the track stadium on Bonita Drive.

COURSE DESCRIPTION: The course is mostly dirt with a large section of cement and will include several hills depending on the race distance.

PREREQUISITES: No preliminary races are needed to qualify for this meet.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- A) Individuals: Current USATF membership is required to compete. Proof of Birth is required and must be submitted prior to registration and participation via the National office. Please have your athlete age verified well in advance of the registration deadline as the office gets extremely busy with last minute requests.
- B) Teams: Only current registered USATF member clubs in good standing may enter a team. All athletes representing the club must be affiliated with that club as part of their USATF membership. To enter a team, a club must complete the team entry/declaration process during online registration. Only athletes listed on the team declaration roster will be eligible to represent the club at the Association, Regional or National championships.

REGISTRATION ENTRY FEES & DEADLINES:

- Entry Fee: \$10 per athlete. There is no team fee.
- Register online at https://www.athletic.net/CrossCountry/meet/248711/register
 - o OPENS on October 20, 2024
 - CLOSES on November 6, 2024 at 11:59pm. Late entries will NOT be allowed. Athletes
 not registered by this time will not compete in the meet. Please do not wait until the last
 minute as there can be several time consuming and technically challenging steps.
 - Fees must be paid online by the close of registration.
- Club Administrators and Unattached Athletes should register online as stated above. Accuracy of
 data entered is the responsibility of each club and/or athlete. Please validate data within Athetic.net
 for accuracy prior to submitting entry.

DIVISION TEAM ENTRIES and SCORING:

- A team consists of 5 to 8 runners in a division. The top 5 finishers of that team will score.
- When entering your team into the athletic.net, you must declare which athletes are on your scoring team (A, B, C, etc.).
- Clubs may submit changes to their scoring teams no later than 7:30 a.m. on the morning of the meet.

IN THE EVENT of a TIE BETWEEN TWO OR MORE TEAMS: Ties between two or more teams shall be resolved in favor of the team whose last scoring member finishes nearer to first place

ADVANCEMENTS TO REGIONALS:

- Top **30** individuals and top **5** teams in each age group will advance to the Region 15 Championships.
- Age groups 15-16 and 17-18 will be combined in team scoring only; the top 5 teams will advance.
- The Region 15 Championships will be held on **Sunday November 17**, **2024** at Central Park in Santa Clarita. Information regarding the Region 15 championships can be found on https://www.athletic.net/CrossCountry/meet/248712/info

HIGH SCHOOL WAIVERS:

- Athletes that run in CIF SS Prelims on 11/15 11/16 may request a waiver to advance directly to the Region 15 Championships on 11/17. Request for this waiver must be emailed to Ryan Yohn at youthxc@scausatf.org by Monday, November 4, 2024
- For those high school athletes qualifying to CIF SS Finals (11/23), we are confirming if they can be waived through to nationals. At the moment of this flyer, we don't have clarity on this matter. See calendar below -

IMPORTANT MESSAGE for PARENTS and COACHES:

- After the course walk, spectators (including parents and coaches) will respect the portions of the course coned off for ONLY the COMPETITORS.
- You cannot pace athletes or spray water on them during the race.
- Any interference with the start line and finish line officials will result in an ejection from the meet
- If you have a grievance, please give it in writing to the results table and they will forward it on to the proper meet management personnel.

COMPETITION BIB NUMBERS: All competitors must wear their assigned bib numbers during competition, chest-high on the front of their jerseys. Bib numbers will be distributed to athletes at the registration table on the day of the meet. *Please do not pin the bottom of the bibs so they can be easily torn off in the chute.*

EVENT RESULTS: During competition, event results will be posted at the results table within 15 minutes of the race. In addition, event results will be posted at the **www.scausatf.org** website within 3 days of the meet.

AWARDS: USATF Junior Olympic ribbons and medals will be awarded to the top 15 individuals in each age division. Team championship awards will be given to the top 3 teams in each division. The 15/18 division will NOT be given team awards.

CHAMPIONSHIP GEAR: T-Shirts and Sweatshirts will be sold at the meet.
