ENTRIES FOR THE MEET

On Athletic.net you will be asked to enter (only) 7 runners into the Varsity Race and enter (only) 10 in the Reserve Race. You may make changes on the day of the meet at the Finish line with the timer.

ENTRY DEADLINE: 5:00 PM Thursday, October, 2nd 2024

LATE ENTRIES Any entries received after 5:00pm will be assessed a \$50.00 late fee. The check must be made out to Milford High School and presented the day of the meet.

OPEN RACE There are two open races that precede the Varsity Championship Races. One for the boys and one for the girls. There will be no official timing with these races. We have created on Athletic.net it will be a separate race so that people may enter their times into the system if they like. **No** adults or middle school athletes.

Coaches will be responsible for getting their own finish times. There will be no results or postings from the OPEN RACES.

TIMING: Timing and Results will be taken care of by Rotpac Racing. Jason Bigelow of ROTPAC will be doing the Electronic Timing for the Varsity and J V Races only. We are hoping to have 1 Mile splits available in those 4 races.

PARKING FOR THE EVENT: The Kensington Metro Park Authorities have asked us to use Maple Beach (to the south of Possum Hollow) as the primary parking location. Teams will still be allowed "up the hill" but parking will be limited. At 7:40 am (1 hour before the first race) all traffic aside from Handi capped parking will be diverted from Possum Hollow.

TEAM TENTS: New this year, teams may only set up tents or stage your team on the course side of the main road. The parcel to the south of the Bathrooms and the field North of the back parking lot are good spaces. The Metro Park Authorities are asking for teams to not set up opposite the road, reducing people crossing the road. Teams may use any of the available shelter areas.

THE COURSE: The Kensington Metro Park Cross Country Course is doubled lined the entire route. The Runners need to run between the line, not on it. Spectators need to position themselves behind the line. The course will have running clocks at the Mile and 2-Mile.

BOX ASSIGNMENTS: For the Oakland County Championships we will use two starting lines. Approximately 20 x 5' boxes south and 25 x 5' boxes north of the Large Oak Tree. Box Assignments will be posted after entries are due.

AWARDS: Trophies to the top D1 team and the top lower division team, Medals to the top 30 Individuals.

DRESSING FACILITIES: There are none There are multiple available Restroom facilities plus portable restrooms.

PARK ADMISSION: School buses and vans will be admitted to the park free. All other vehicles are required to purchase a daily pass for \$10.00. PLEASE NOTE: Vans or cars with less than a full team will be required to purchase a daily pass for \$10.00
