Spectator Parking: Spectator parking is located in a remote lot across Hwy O from the course/park – see attached map. There is no parking along the access road leading to the remote parking lot.

To ensure smooth and easy access to and from the course, please follow the directions of the parking attendants. In an effort to facilitate traffic flow spectators are strongly encouraged to ride one of the available shuttle buses for the 5-minute shuttle ride. Parking and the shuttle ride are free. In addition, Ozaukee County has designated no parking along Hwy O. We anticipate this to be strictly enforced. **Spectators should arrive well in advance of scheduled race times.**
