

WHEN the BOUGH BREAKS

Every year, more than 135 babies and toddlers enter Santa Barbara County's foster care system due to abuse, neglect and abandonment. Because of an overburdened foster care system, some are moved from one home to another before they take their first step, and many suffer physically and emotionally. Without individual and consistent attention, they incur social and emotional problems that may impact them, and our community, throughout their lives. But with your help, a local child's life can be changed forever.

FOSTERING a *FUTURE* for LOCAL BABIES and TODDLERS

Angels Foster Care is a non-profit organization that recruits, trains and certifies foster families for children from birth through age five. Babies placed with our foster families are stabilized in one home for a period of days or months while a judge determines what will become the permanent plan for the child. Angels' primary goal is to prevent attachment problems in the children we serve by ensuring our children learn important bonding behaviors from their foster parents.



HOW DOES FOSTER CARE WORK?

Santa Barbara County's Child Welfare Services calls Angels Foster Care when they have a baby or toddler who was removed from an unsafe home and needs a family to love and care for them. Because we know our families very well, we are able to match each child with a waiting Angels foster family. While the family takes care of the child, Angels social workers provide support and education to the foster family, oversee all visitation and legal aspects of each child's case, and work with all parties involved including biological relatives, foster families, child welfare workers, attorneys and CASA representatives.

LOVING and QUALIFIED CAREGIVERS are NEEDED

Healthy development during infancy and early childhood depends on the continuous presence of a responsive, nurturing caregiver. If your family loves children, enjoys parenting and has appropriate space for a child, we need you! Short-term, long-term and foster-to-adopt placements are available. WHAT is ANGELS LOOKING for in a **FOSTER FAMILY?**

- A family with the ability to parent full-time.
- Commitment to caring for an Angels child until he or she is out of the foster care system.
- Willingness to accept only one foster child or sibling group.
- Families able to provide emergency/shelter care (typically 1 month in duration), foster care (typically 1-12 months in duration) or foster-to-adopt care (typically 12-24 months in duration through completion of the adoption).

DID **YOU** KNOW?

- Yes, date nights are possible and encouraged! Foster families may use a trusted babysitter 18 years or older (no fingerprinting necessary).
- Angels foster families may travel with their foster child.
- Foster families remain completely confidential. Visitation between foster children and their families is facilitated by county staff or Angels Foster Care.
- Foster children are adopted through closed adoptions.
- A judge determines a permanent plan for each foster child within 12-18 months. If the child is available for adoption, and your family is interested, Angels will support you through the process. There is no charge to adopt through the Angels program.
- •More than 50% of Angels placements result in adoption by the foster family.
- •There are only minimal fees associated with becoming a certified foster parent.

FOSTER PARENT CERTIFICATION INCLUDES:

- A family assessment
- Successful completion of a MMPI-2 psychological screening for both parents
- Fingerprint and child abuse index clearance
- Physical exam and T.B. test
- Current auto insurance and driver's license
- CPR and First Aid training
- Three letters of reference from non-family members
- Completion of a parent-training program, which is scheduled into several sessions totaling 24 hours
- A detailed home study
