OUR PURPOSE

Animal welfare is our purpose and our passion.

We are a 100% volunteer-powered, donor-funded, foster-based, 501(c)(3) charitable organization with a commitment to:

-  **Rescue** abandoned, homeless, or owner-surrendered cats and dogs.
-  **Foster** animals and **adopt** them into safe and loving homes.
-  **Fund** routine vetting and urgent medical expenses for the animals in our care.
-  **Educate** the public about responsible pet ownership, including the importance of spay/neuter.
-  **Help** people keep and care for their pets through outreach services such as microchips, vaccines, and supplies.
