

Amendment to Individual Medical HMO Evidence of Coverage

Section II – Definitions

- **Hearing Aid:** Any wearable instrument or device designed or offered for the purpose of aiding or compensating for impaired human hearing, including all attachments, accessories, and parts thereof, except batteries and cords, that is dispensed by a licensed audiologist, a licensed hearing aid dealer or fitter, or an Otolaryngologist.
- **Otolaryngologist:** A licensed physician who practices otolaryngology.
- **Related Services:** Services necessary to assess, select, and appropriately adjust or fit a hearing aid to ensure optimal performance

Section V – Covered Health Care Services

Hearing Aid

- We provide wearable Hearing Aid and related services to individuals up to age 22.
- One Hearing Aid per hearing-impaired ear, with no Cost Share up to \$2,500 every 48 months for a Covered Person verified as being deaf or hearing impaired by a licensed audiologist, Otolaryngologist or other licensed physician.
- All Related Services prescribed by an Otolaryngologist or recommended by a licensed audiologist and dispensed by a licensed audiologist, a licensed hearing aid dealer or fitter, or an Otolaryngologist will be covered with no Cost Share.
- A Covered Person may choose a higher priced Hearing Aid and may pay the difference in cost above the \$2,500 required coverage without any financial or contractual penalty to the Covered Person or to the Provider of the Hearing Aid.
- We will only provide coverage for Hearing Aids that are considered medically necessary to meet the needs of the Covered Person, according to professional standards established by the state speech and hearing professionals board.
- Antidote is not required to pay a claim for the cost of a Hearing Aid as if, less than 48 months prior to the date of the claim, the Covered Person received the coverage from any health benefit plan.

Amendment to Section VI – Exclusions and Limitations

Remove hearing aids from the following language:

Covered Service expenses will not include, and no benefits will be provided or paid for any charges that are incurred.

- For eyeglasses, contact lenses, eye refraction, visual therapy, or for any examination or fitting related to these devices, except as provided in this contract.
- For hearing aid or assistive listening device batteries, including rechargeable batteries, any size and hearing aid or assistive listening device cords.
