

## Ableton Live Download Session for Orba

### Requirements:

- Ableton Live 10 or newer (Intro/Standard/Suite)
- Orba App (0.14.7 or newer)

### How To 🤖:


1. Open the Ableton Live session and connect Orba to your computer.
2. Open Live's Preferences menu, select the *Link / MIDI* tab and check that the *Track* and *Remote* columns are active for the corresponding Orba channels.
3. In the Orba app, make sure that *Channel-per-part* is selected under *MIDI Mode*.
4. You may wish to disable Orba's internal synth while using Ableton Live. Toggle *Orba Sounds On/Off* if so.




## Playing / Looping 🎧:

Orba will be ready to play once all settings have been adjusted. Switching modes on Orba will cycle through the corresponding tracks / software instruments in the Ableton Live session.


Make sure that all tracks remain armed, otherwise they won't respond to input from Orba. A track is armed when the *Arm Recording* icon is red.



To loop using Ableton Live's looper select one of the scenes in the Master channel on the right side of the session. Selecting a *1 Bar* scene will set the recording length to a single bar. A *2 Bar* scene will be 2 bars, etc.



When you've selected a loop length and are ready to record click the *Session Record Button* in the top-middle of the session. Live will start recording on all 4 tracks and continue looping until you press Stop.



You can also use Orba's built-in looper to trigger sounds in Ableton Live.
