- Revenue remained almost the same compared to the previous quarter of this year and decreased by 20% compared to the same quarter previous year due to lower sales realisation and weak demand in the export market amid geopolitical tensions.
- Lower profitability is attributed to reduced sales and exchange gain, which was higher in the previous year compared to the current year.

- Increase in non-current assets mainly due to completion of key projects and increase in valuation of long-term investments
- Reduction in working capital mainly due to reduction in inventory
- Increase in liquid fund balance by ~₹ 100 cr despite CapEx spending with better working capital management

- Lower price realisation and subdued demand in Latin American market resulted in weak performance in the Life Science Chemicals segments.
- Lower price realisation along with poor demand in the European market resulted in lower sales and profitability in Performance and Other Chemicals segment, however it was partly offset by improved volume in the domestic market.





Conservation



Ujjwal Atul: solid waste management project: an initiative for a circular economy

- initiated low-cost waste management projects in 29 villages
- signed Memorandums of Understanding with 39 gram panchayats and Swachh Bharat Mission, Valsad to implement low-cost model of sustainable waste management in these villages

- screened 5,082 women and adolescent girls for anaemia in eight villages. Distributed IFA tablets to 4,758 women and adolescent girls.
- trained more than 290 ASHA, anganwadi workers, adhyapikas and nursing students on the importance of the first 1,000 days of life of a child

Improvement of infrastructure in schools

- installed 10 computers in a computer lab benefiting 112 students
- renovated Surwada primary school benefitting 65 students

- conducted good touch and bad touch training in 14 schools for 982 children
- visited 100 homes and conducted meetings with mothers to support them in raising their children well
- conducted group activities for 80 children to develop life skills
