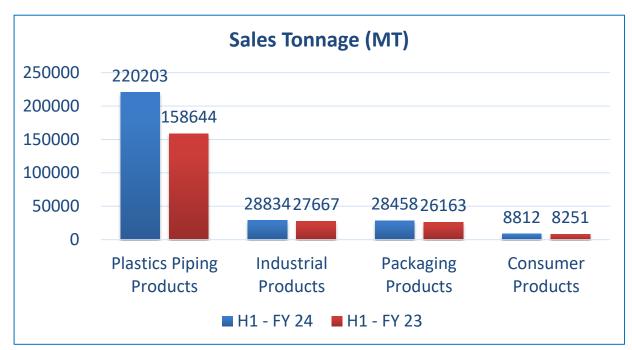


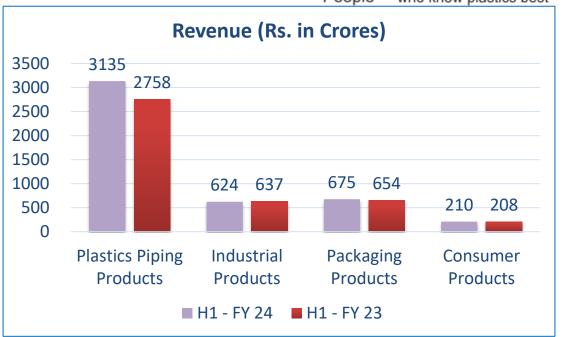


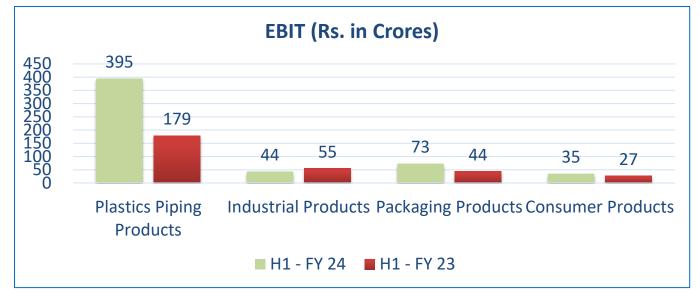


KEY SEGMENT PERFORMANCE – H1 FY24



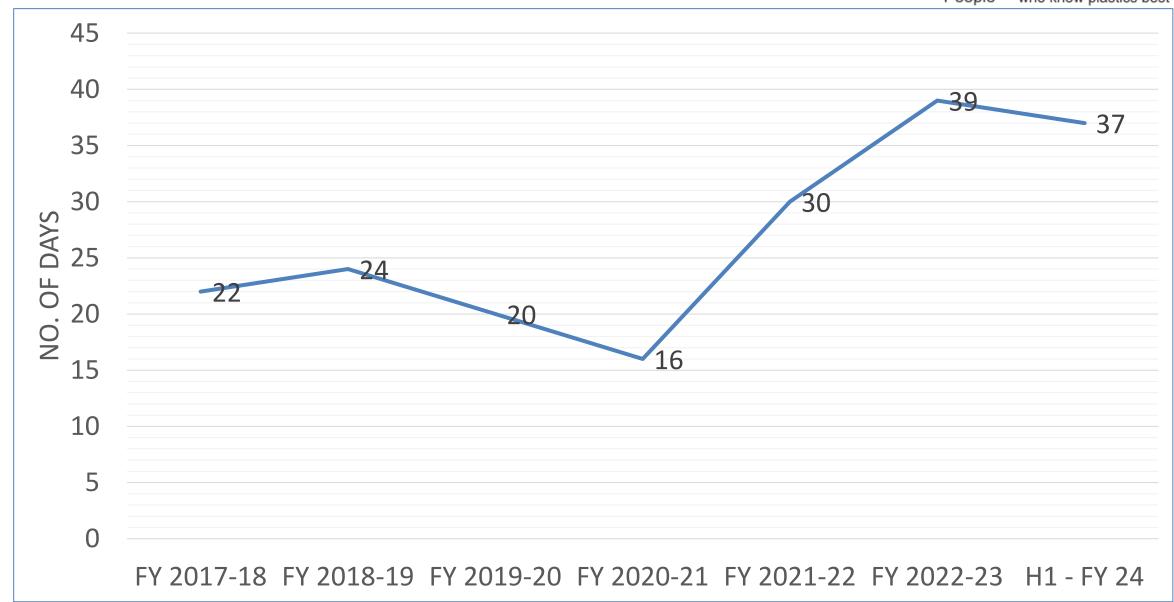






WORKING CAPITAL CYCLE

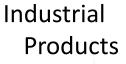

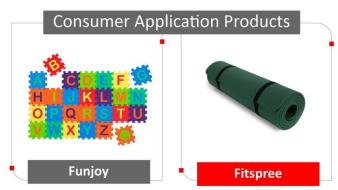

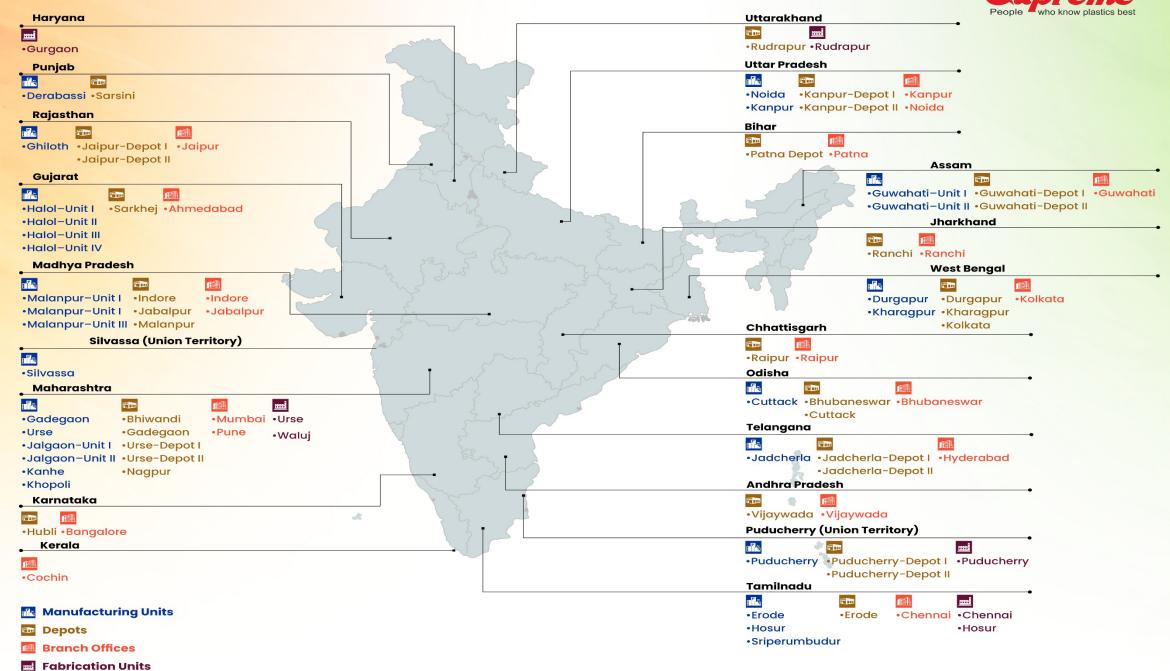
