03. GETTING THERE FROM THE AIRPORT

Francisco Sá Carneiro (OPO Airport or simply Porto Airport) is an international airport near Porto, Portugal. It is located 9.6 km northwest of Museu da Quinta de Santiago, Matosinhos.

TAXI

A taxi from the airport to an hotel in Matosinhos will take approximately 10 to 20 minutes (depending on traffic) and should cost approximately between 10 € and 12€.

UBER

An Uber from the airport to an hotel in Matosinhos will take approximately 5 to 15 minutes (depending on traffic) and should cost approximately 9€ –13€.

METRO

- The Metro do Porto line from the airport to the city of Porto or Matosinhos is Line E.
- To get to the Museu Quinta de Santiago from the airport, change to Line A, direction Senhor de Matosinhos, at Senhora da Hora station.
- The closest station to Museu Quinta de Santiago is Mercado, Line A.
- The ticket should cost approximately 2.20€
 (0,60€ Andante card + single trip).

BUS

- Buses are also available from the Francisco Sá Carneiro Airport (OPO) to Quinta de Santiago Museum.
- Line: 601, direction Cordoaria, stop ASSOC. EMP. PORTUGAL (AEP1).
- The ticket should cost approximately 2.20€
 (0,60€ Andante card + single trip).

04. RECOMMENDED ACCOMMODATIONS

A hotel near Museu Quinta de Santiago is recommended.

SEA PORTO HOTEL

(Av. Dom Afonso Henriques 354, Matosinhos) is located at an approximately 7 minutes by taxi or a 25-minute walk from Fiction Practice venue.

HOLIDAY INN EXPRESS PORTO EXPONOR (Av. Dr. António Macedo 163, 4450-617 Leça da Palmeira) is located at anapproximately at a 7-minute walk from Fiction Practice venue.

O VALENTIM HOTEL

(R. Gago Coutinho 11, 4450-142 Matosinhos) is located at an approximately at a 20-minute walk from Fiction Practice Venue.

There are also several other local accommodations in cities of Porto and Matosinhos.

05. GETTING AROUND

The best way to get around Porto and Matosinhos is by metro, by bus or on foot. Both cities boast an extensive public transportation system operated by Sociedade de Transportes Colectivos do Porto (which includes the metro, buses and trams) that helps visitors reach the top attractions in and around the city.

PORTO'S METRO (METRO DO PORTO) features six lines that run from around 6 a.m. to about 1 a.m. daily and are marked by letters and colors: A (blue), B (red), C (green), D (yellow), E (purple) and F (orange) lines. More than 80 metro stations are located around the cities and they are marked by signs with a wavy blue 'M'. The majority of the lines reach Porto's and Matosinhos' best sights, and traveling via metro is an affordable option when you're visiting the city.

Buying an ANDANTE (CARD) allows you unlimited transportation on the metro, buses and funiculars for a set period of time.

BUS, TRAM AND FUNICULAR

More than 75 STCP bus routes are available throughout Porto and its surrounding regions, including Vila Nova de Gaia and Vila do Conde. Buses run regularly from about 6 a.m. to 9 p.m., with limited service operation from 9 p.m. to 1 a.m.

STCP also operates three tram routes in Porto: Line 1, Line 18 and Line 22. Porto's trams (or cable cars) are a historic part of the city, dating back to 1872. Line 1 runs along the west coast and the Douro River from Matosinhos to Lóios. The single-track funicular runs up and down the hillside from Porto's Ribeira area to the higher elevated Batalha square.

CURRENCY

Official currency is the Euro (€, EUR): 1.00 GBP = 1.08EUR 1.00 USD = 0.89 EUR

POWER

TAXES

The Sales Tax Rate in Portugal stands at 23 percent.
