

Fortuitous Society Membership Agreement & Guidelines

Age Restriction

To ensure a safe and responsible environment, all members and guests must be at least 21 years of age to consume alcohol at Fortuitous. A valid government-issued ID (such as a driver's license, passport, or state ID) is required for age verification. Minors under the age of 21 are not permitted on the premises.

Behavior and Conduct

All members and guests are expected to conduct themselves with respect and courtesy. Disruptive, aggressive, or inappropriate behavior towards staff, members, or guests will not be tolerated. Fortuitous reserves the right to take action against any individuals who violate these standards.

Consequences

Members or guests displaying inappropriate behavior may be asked to leave the premises immediately. Repeated offenses or severe breaches of conduct may result in permanent expulsion from Fortuitous. Please note that no refunds will be issued for any membership fees or other charges in the event of expulsion or ban.

Health and Safety

We are committed to providing a clean and safe environment for all members and guests. Please adhere to all health and safety protocols, including hand sanitizing stations and cleanliness guidelines.

Alcohol Consumption

Fortuitous encourages responsible drinking. We reserve the right to refuse service to any member or guest who appears intoxicated or engages in unruly behavior.

Membership Policies

Application and Approval

Membership requires the submission of an application, which is subject to approval by Fortuitous at management's discretion.

Automatic Renewal

Memberships automatically renew on the first day of each month, with charges applied accordingly.

Charges for New Members

New members joining between the 1st and the 15th of the month will be charged the full monthly fee. Partial-month charges are not applicable.

Upgrade Options

Members may upgrade from Spirit Society to Fortuitous Society at any point during their membership term. For more information, please contact us directly.

Termination

Memberships may be terminated by either the member or Fortuitous with appropriate notice. Members must provide a 30-day written notice to cancel their membership. If this notice is not given, the member will be charged for the following month's fees.

Pausing Membership

Members may request to pause their membership, changing their status to non-active. A 30-day written notice is required to pause membership, and members may pause a maximum of twice per year. During the pause period, membership benefits will be suspended, and credits will not accrue.

Credit System

Purchases at Fortuitous are made using credits, with a conversion rate of one dollar to one credit. Credits can be used for purchases at both Fortuitous and Vendome Wine & Spirits. Unused credits roll over to the following month. Please note that credits cannot be transferred between memberships.

Sharing Membership

Membership can only be shared with a spouse, partner, or significant other. All other adults must hold their own membership. q

Members' Guest(s)

Members must always be present with their guests. Guests cannot access the premises without a member in attendance.

Non-Active Members

- **Definition:** Members who fail to pay fees or have paused their membership will be classified as non-active.
 - **Grace Period:** Non-active status lasts for three months. During this period, members can pay overdue fees or resume their membership to avoid termination. After three months, non-active memberships will be terminated, and members will need to reapply.
 - **Impact of Non-Active Status:** Non-active members will not accrue credits and will have restricted access to events. Non-active members cannot use benefits, including guest passes, until their status is reinstated.
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Reservation Policies

Reservations are required for all events and daily operations. Reservations can be made online or by phone. Members must reserve in advance for themselves and their guests.

Service Policies

Payment

We accept various payment methods, including membership credits, credit/debit cards, and cash. Gratuity is appreciated and may be added at the member's discretion.

Assistance

For assistance or to address any concerns, please approach our staff. We are here to ensure your experience is enjoyable.

Noise Levels and Music

- **Noise:** Members and guests are encouraged to maintain reasonable noise levels to preserve a comfortable atmosphere for all.
 - **Music:** Music is provided at management's discretion. Requests for specific music preferences should be made in advance.
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Food and Drink Policies

Outside Food

Outside food is not permitted.

Allergies and Special Dietary Requirements

Special dietary requirements or allergies should be communicated to our staff in advance, and we will do our best to accommodate your needs.

Smoking and Vaping

Smoking and vaping are prohibited on the premises.

Property and Personal Belongings

Personal Items

Members and guests are responsible for their personal belongings. Fortuitous is not liable for lost, stolen, or damaged items.

Lost and Found

Lost items should be reported to staff immediately. Unclaimed items will be held for 30 days before being donated or discarded.

Dress Code

At Fortuitous, we maintain a **Smart or Trendy Casual** dress code to ensure a polished, comfortable, and stylish atmosphere for all members and their guests. Members are responsible for informing their guests of the dress code, and compliance is expected at all times.

- **Relaxed Attire for Men:** Smart polo or button-down shirt, well-fitted slacks, chinos, or jeans, paired with closed-toe leather shoes, deck shoes, or clean, stylish sneakers.
- **Relaxed Attire for Women:** Chic dresses, skirts, tailored slacks, or jeans paired with a stylish top. Footwear options include closed or open-toe shoes, loafers, dressy sandals, or clean, fashionable sneakers.
- **Traditional Attire for Men:** A business suit or sport jacket with tailored slacks, collared shirt, necktie, and polished closed-toe dress shoes.
- **Traditional Attire for Women:** Equivalent formal attire to men's traditional dress, including a tailored business suit, pantsuit, or dress, complemented by a blouse, skirt, tailored slacks, and dress shoes.

Not Permitted:

- Athletic wear, sweatshirts, or hoodies
- Torn, overly distressed, or faded jeans
- Flip-flops or overly casual footwear
- Graphic T-shirts or overly casual tops
- Shorts, mini skirts, or excessively revealing clothing

Enforcement:

Management reserves the right to determine and enforce the dress code. Members and guests not in compliance may be asked to adjust their attire or may be denied entry. Exceptions will be made at management's discretion.

Thank you for adhering to our dress code and helping maintain the atmosphere at Fortuitous.

Complaints and Feedback

Members are encouraged to provide feedback or file complaints directly with management. We aim to address concerns promptly and professionally.

Special Events and Private Bookings

Event Policies

Special events or private bookings may have specific rules or altered policies, which will be communicated to guests at the time of booking.

Membership Terms and Conditions

We reserve the right to cancel or terminate your membership at any time, with or without cause, in accordance with applicable laws. Cancellation will not affect any liabilities incurred prior to the cancellation date.

Membership fees are non-refundable. By paying the membership fee, you acknowledge and agree that no portion of the fee will be refunded, even in the case of membership cancellation or termination.

We also reserve the right to update or modify the terms and conditions of membership and bylaws at any time. Any changes will be effective immediately upon publication or notification. Continued membership after such updates constitutes acceptance of the revised terms.
