

Most North Carolinians Support Medicaid Transformation

New research from North Carolina for Better Medicaid assessed awareness of and opinions about the state's upcoming transition to Medicaid Managed Care.

In the research survey, **only 1 out of 3** North Carolinians knew about this transformation and its ability to **drive down long-term health care costs, increase access to care, and improve health outcomes**. However, once survey respondents were informed of Managed Care's key benefits, the **majority responded positively to the transformation**.



67%

of survey participants had a positive impression of Medicaid Managed Care's ability to **improve access to health care** for North Carolina's most vulnerable residents.



70%

of respondents looked favorably upon Medicaid Managed Care's focus on value-based health care, which improves access to **preventive health and wellness programs**.



66%

of survey participants had positive impressions of the Managed Care model's investment in **finding solutions that address key social determinants of health**, like food insecurity, affordable housing, interpersonal violence, and access to transportation.



65%

responded favorably to Medicaid Managed Care's potential to **improve overall health outcomes** of patients in North Carolina.



68%

supported a Managed Care Model's potential to **drive down long-term health care costs** through prevention and patient-centered care.
