#### Auburn Women's Basketball Quick Hitters

- Auburn and Belmont are meeting for the third time in women's basketball, all in Auburn
- Auburn has won both of the previous two meetings
- Auburn is 91-38 in non-conference games under Terri Williams-Flournoy, with a 54-5 mark at home
- Unique Thompson is 13 rebounds away from 1,000 in her career; would be 5th player in Auburn history to reach that
- Thompson's 26-point, 23-rebound game at Houston was Auburn's first 20-20 game since Lauretta Freeman had 30 points, 21 rebounds vs. Alabama on Feb. 17, 1993
- · Thompson's 23 rebounds at Houston were a career-high and tied for the third-most in Auburn history (Sharon Stewart, 23 at Vanderbilt, Feb. 28, 1988)
- As of Dec. 17, Thompson's 23 rebounds at Houston were the most by a player in NCAA Division I so far this season
- Thompson leads the nation with 6 double-doubles this season; she ranks third nationally in rebounds/game (14.1)
- Thompson is the SEC's active leader in career double-doubles (48), rebounds (987) and steals (161)
- Annie Hughes scored a career-high 17 points with 7 rebounds in the win over North Florida
- Honesty Scott-Grayson has scored 16 points in back-to-back games; both career-highs
- Auburn's 97 points in their win over Gardner-Webb tied the most scored by the Tigers under Terri Williams-Flournoy
- The Gardner-Webb win was Auburn's eighth 90-point game in the Williams-Flournoy era; the UNF win was the 9th
- The Tigers held USC Upstate to 41 points in the opener, the lowest for an opponent since Feb. 17, 2019 vs. Alabama
- Auburn's 41-point margin of victory over USC Upstate was its largest since a 56-point win at Elon (96-44) on Dec. 22, 2018; it tied for the fifth-largest winning margin at Auburn Arena
- · Ten players made their Auburn debuts in the win over USC Upstate; three newcomers were in the starting lineup
- · Aicha Coulibaly became the eighth Auburn player since 2005 and fourth under Coach Flo to earn a starting nod in their first game as a true freshman
- · Redshirt sophomore Jala Jordan scored a career-high 16 points off the bench to share the team lead in her Auburn debut vs. USC Upstate; the WVU transfer also hit 4-of-6 3-pointers on the night
- · Auburn is in its 50th season of women's basketball and has 952 program wins
- Senior forward Unique Thompson was a consensus preseason first-team All-SEC selection (coaches & media)
- Thompson is Auburn's leading returner in nearly all statistical categories, including scoring (16.2) and rebounds (11.4)
- Thompson is the nation's leading returner in double-doubles with 22 last season, one shy of the national lead in 2020
- · Thompson has averaged a double-double for two straight seasons, the first in Auburn history to do that
- Coach Terri Williams-Flournoy is in her ninth season at Auburn, her 17th as a head coach, and her 29th overall in college coaching

- Unique Thompson has 48 career double-doubles and is Auburn's all-time leader
- Unique Thompson needs 9 double-doubles to tie for 10th in SEC history (Alaina Coates, Chamique Holdsclaw, Armintie Price, 57)
- Unique Thompson is 5th in career rebounds with 987; needs 13 for 1,000 in career; needs 19 to tie for 5th (Vickie Orr, 1,006); needs 28 to tie for 4th (Lori Monroe, 1,015)
- Unique Thompson is 1st in career rebounding average at 10.4; Marianne Merritt (1975-79) is 2nd at 10.0
- Unique Thompson is 21st in career scoring with 1,300 points; needs 6 to tie for 20th (C.C. Hayden, 1,306); needs 10 to tie for 19th (Debra Larkin, 1,310); needs 27 to tie for 18th (Tra'Cee Tanner, 1,327)
- Coach Terri Williams-Flournoy needs 17 wins for 300 in her head coaching career
- Auburn needs 2 home wins for 100 all-time at Auburn Arena

#### **OPENING TIP**

- The Auburn Tigers close out the nonconference portion of the schedule Sunday afternoon when they take on Belmont at Auburn Arena. Game time is set for 2 p.m. CT.
- This game was originally scheduled for Dec. 8 but postponed due to COVID-19 issues within the Auburn program.
- Auburn is 5-2 on the year; the Tigers split two games in the midweek with Stephen F. Austin and North Florida, falling to SFA 67-54 and defeating UNF 94-81.
- » Belmont is 3-2 after a 71-55 win at Alabama A&M Friday night.

#### LAST TIME OUT

- Five Tigers scored in double-figures as Auburn topped the 90-point mark for the second time this season with a 94-81 win over North Florida Thursday night at Auburn Arena.
- The Tigers (5-2) were able to bounce back from tough offensive night Wednesday in their loss to SFA with their second-highest scoring total of the season, getting big nights from senior Unique Thompson and sophomore Annie Hughes to lead the way.
- "Thompson led Auburn with 19 points and 18 rebounds, her sixth straight double-double and the 48th of her career. Her 18 rebounds were the most in a home game in her Auburn career; she also contributed three assists and two steals. Hughes hit for a career-high 17 points and matched a career-high with seven rebounds, knocking down three 3-pointers for the second time in three games. She also shared the team lead with three steals.
- » Redshirt sophomore Honesty Scott-Grayson scored 16 points for the second straight night, matching her career high from Wednesday's game. She also had three steals. Freshman Romi Levy also had a career-high 12 points along with five rebounds, and Jala Jordan came up just short of her first career double-double with 11 points and eight rebounds. Alaina Rice added nine points off the bench, her best at Auburn, and Kira Lowery led the Tigers with five assists and a career-best three steals.

Auburn opens up SEC play Thursday, Dec. 31, on the road at LSU. Game time is set for 6 p.m. CT at the Pete Maravich Assembly Center.

#### **AUBURN-BELMONT SERIES**

» Auburn and Belmont are meeting for the third time in women's basketball. The Tigers won the two previous meetings, both in Auburn.

#### LAST MEETING: Nov. 15, 2011 Auburn 80, Belmont 53

Auburn coasted past Belmont 80-53 in its 2011-12 home-opener at Auburn Arena, putting the 800th victory in program history in the books. Sophomore Camille Glymph came off the bench, hitting five of Auburn's 10 3-pointers to lead the Tigers with 18 points in the win.

Olymph was one of three Auburn players in double figures as Tyrese Tanner added 16 points, including 4-of-5 from 3-point range, and Jassany Williams earned 12 points while also adding four blocks.

#### **SCOUTING BELMONT**

- » Belmont is 3-2 on the season, 1-0 in Ohio Valley Conference play. The Bruins have wins over Middle Tennessee, Tennessee State and Alabama A&M with losses on the road at Kentucky and at home to Marquette.
- The Bruins were picked to finish second in the OVC. Last year, Belmont went 22-9 overall, 16-2 in OVC play, claiming their fourth straight regular-season conference title.
- » Belmont scores 67.0 points/game while giving up just 57.6. The Bruins lead the OVC and rank 34th nationally with 11.0 steals/game.
- "Tuti Jones is the national leader in steals per game, averaging 5.5. She also leads the Bruins in scoring (12.0) and rebounds (5.0).

#### **SCOUTING AUBURN**

- >> Through seven games, Auburn is averaging 75.4 points/game while holding opponents to 64.4 points. The Tigers have topped the 80-point mark three times and scored 90-plus twice.
- » Auburn is second in the SEC and ranks 13th nationally in steals per game at 13.6; the Tigers are also 26th in the nation and 3rd in the SEC in turnover margin (+6.3).
- » Senior forward Unique Thompson is averaging 18.6 points and 14.1 rebounds through seven games; she also has six double-doubles on the season, which leads the nation. Thompson leads the SEC and ranks 3rd nationally in rebounds/game. An honorable-mention All-American and first-team All-SEC performer a year ago, Thompson is Auburn's lone returning starter. She averaged a double-double for the second straight year in 2020 with 16.2 points and 11.4 rebounds, leading Auburn in both categories. Thompson is also the nation's leading returner in double-doubles with 22 last season.
- "Two redshirt sophomore transfers that sat out last season are making an immediate impact. Honesty Scott-Grayson (Baylor) and Jala Jordan (West Virginia) have both earned significant minutes through the first several games. Scott-Grayson has started all seven games and had 16 points against both SFA and North Florida, along with 14 points, 7 rebounds and 5 steals vs. Gardner-Webb. Jordan is Auburn's second-leading scorer with 10.4 points/game; she's also the Tigers' second-leading rebounder (4.6/game) and leading shot-blocker (1.1/game)
- >> Four other returners saw game action for Auburn last season: redshirt junior Kiyae' White and sophomores Annie Hughes, Morgan Robinson-Nwagwu and Sania Wells. Hughes scored a career-high 17 points against North Florida and has started six of seven games. Wells and Robinson-Nwagwu played significant minutes in the opener; Robinson-Nwagwu had a career-high four steals and matched career-highs with 6 points and 4 rebounds. Wells scored a career-high 11 points in the win over South Alabama.

wore an Auburn uniform for the first time in game action vs. USC Upstate. All 10 newcomers saw the floor in the Tigers' 82-41 win on Nov. 25 and again vs. Gardner-Webb on Dec. 1.

- ... Auburn added three junior college transfers during the offseason, including two NJCAA All-Americans:
- >> Kira Lowery came to Auburn from Dyersburg State CC (Tenn.) where she ranked third in the nation in scoring (23.3 ppg) and second in steals (4.0/game) and was an NJCAA All-American in 2020. Lowery has started all seven games at PG and leads Auburn with 2.0 assists/game.
- >> Keya Patton was a two-time All-American at Wabash Valley College (III.), where she scored over 1,000 points in two seasons and averaged 20.8 points, 6.8 rebounds and 6.4 steals as a sophomore. She scored a season-best 14 points vs. Gardner-Webb (12/1).
- Alycia Reese joins the Tigers from just down the road at Chattahoochee Valley CC in Phenix City, where she led the team with 12.8 points/game last season. Reese scored 10 points and hit Auburn's only two 3-pointers at Houston (12/5).
- Sophomore Alaina Rice joined the Tigers in June after transferring from Florida A&M. Rice was MEAC Rookie of the Year in 2020 at FAMU where she averaged 10.3 points and 4.7 rebounds. Rice led Auburn with 5 assists in the season-opener and scored 9 points vs. North Florida.
- >> The Tigers signed two freshmen during the offeseason: Romi Levy (6-2, F, Herzliya, Israel) and Aicha Coulibaly (6-0, F/G, Mali). Two others joined Auburn as walk-ons: Riley Donahue (5-10, G, Atlanta, Ga.) and Carsen McFadden (5-7, G, Fairview, Texas). Coulibaly started the first four games; Levy is averaging 6.1 points and 3.1 rebounds. McFadden played significant minutes in the win over South Alabama, sharing the team lead with three assists.

#### **UNIQUE LEADS THE WAY**

- >> Through games of Dec. 17, Unique Thompson leads the nation in double-doubles (6), ranks third in rebounds per game (14.1) and is tied for second in offensive rebounds per game (6.0). She leads the SEC in all three categories.
- >> In addition to being the SEC's active career leader in double-doubles, Unique Thompson is the league's active leader in career rebounds (987) and steals (161) and is third in career scoring (1,300).
- >> Last season, Thompson was second in the SEC and 10th nationally in rebounding (11.4/game), led the SEC and was 8th nationally in offensive rebounds (4.4/game), and was third in the SEC and 15th nationally in field goal percentage (58.2%).

#### **SEEING DOUBLE**

- "> With six double-doubles so far this season, Unique Thompson has 48 career double-doubles, the all-time Auburn career record. She surpassed Auburn great DeWanna Bonner's record with her 41st double-double at Missouri on Feb. 27, 2020.
- >> Unique needs 9 more double-doubles this season to enter the SEC's all-time top 10.
- In 2019-20, Thompson had 22 double-doubles to lead the SEC and finish second overall nationally. She is the nation's leading returner in doubledoubles.
- Thompson has averaged a double-double for two straight seasons and for her career, the first Auburn player to accomplish that feat.

#### THIS, THAT AND THE OTHER

Auburn has utilized three different starting lineups in 2020-21. Five players - Aicha Coulibaly, Jala Jordan, Romi Levy, Kira Lowery and Honesty Scott-Grayson - have made their first Division I starts this season.

Auburn's 97 points in the win over Gardner-Webb (12/1) tied for the highest-scoring output of the Terri Williams-Flournoy era. It was the eighth 90-point game for Auburn under Coach Flo. Auburn got its 9th 90-point game of the Coach Flo era with 94 points against North Florida.

Auburn's last five women's basketball games played the same day as an Iron Bowl have been decided by a combined nine points - two-point wins over Samford (2020), Dayton (2019) and Minnesota (2015) along with a one-point loss to Northwestern (2017) and a two-point loss at Winthrop (2014).

**AUBURN**-- The new-look Auburn women's basketball team showcased its depth, speed and balance in their season-opener, running away with an 82-41 win over USC Upstate Wednesday night at Auburn Arena.

All 14 players on the roster saw action for the Tigers (1-0), 11 of the 14 found the scoresheet, and 12 players grabbed at least one rebound. Auburn's trademark defense was back, too, turning 25 USC Upstate (0-1) turnovers into 21 points.

Senior Unique Thompson and redshirt sophomore Jala Jordan shared the team lead with 16 points apiece. Thompson also pulled down seven rebounds to lead the Tigers, but the Tigers' 45 rebounds were spread amongst 13 players as Auburn did a great job crashing the boards.

Auburn's newcomers made an immediate impact. Along with Jordan's 16 points and three rebounds, freshman Romi Levy turned some heads with eight points, three rebounds, two assists and two steals. Sophomore transfer Honesty Scott-Grayson finished with seven points and two assists in her Auburn debut. And fellow newcomers Keya Patton, Kira Lowery, Aicha Coulibaly, Alaina Rice and Alycia Reese all found their way onto the scoresheet. Rice was the team's assist leader with five on the night, and Coulibaly had Auburn's only blocked shot.

Among the returners, sophomore Morgan Robinson-Nwagwu matched a career-high with six points along with four rebounds and a team-leading four steals, a career-best. And Sania Wells finished with seven points, one shy of her career-high.

As a team, Auburn shot 46.2 percent from the floor (30-65) and hit 8-of-20 3-point attempts (40%). The Tigers also knocked down 12-of-17 attempts at the line (82.4%). The Tigers outrebounded the Spartans 45-26.

Auburn never trailed, jumping out to a 16-0 lead before the Spartans got on the board late in the first quarter to make it 16-2 after one period. That lead would balloon to 31 points at the end of the first half as the Tigers led 40-9; it's the first time Auburn has held an opponent to single digits since the 2016-17 season when Jacksonville scored just eight in the opening 20 minutes.

**AUBURN**-- Senior Unique Thompson picked up her first double-double of the season, and Auburn was able to fend off a late 3-point flurry from Samford to pick up a 66-64 win Saturday night at Auburn Arena.

The Tigers (2-0) led by as many as 16 early in the second half. But Samford (0-2) chipped away over the final 20 minutes – led by five 3-pointers from the Bulldogs' Katie Allen in the fourth quarter, three of them in the final 79 seconds – to put major pressure on the Tigers.

A pair of key shots from redshirt sophomore Jala Jordan kept the Bulldogs at bay, and clutch free throws from Thompson and junior Kira Lowery secured the win as Samford missed a final 3-point heave at the buzzer.

Thompson led Auburn with 16 points for the second straight game and pulled down 11 rebounds for her first double-double of the season and 43rd of her career. She also led the Tigers with five steals. Lowery added 12 points on 4-of-6 shooting and had a team-leading four assists in her second game as a Tiger. She also added a pair of steals.

The Tigers led 22-16 after one on the strength of hitting five of their first seven 3-point attempts of the night. But they would only make 2-of-18 from long range the rest of the way. Crashing the offensive glass in the second quarter helped pad the lead to 38-26 at the break.

It would be 42-26 less than a minute into the third on back-to-back buckets from Lowery, but from there, Auburn began to cool as Samford heated up. The Tigers saw their lead shrink to 50-42 at the end of three, then an 8-4 Bulldog run over the first three minutes of the fourth cut it to 54-50.

Auburn would make just two more field goals the rest of the way – both clutch shots from Jordan in the final three minutes. Her second, a 3-pointer with under a minute to play, pushed the lead to five at 61-56. From there, Allen sank two treys in a 10-second stretch, sandwiched around four free throws from Thompson and Lowery, to make it a 1-point game at 65-64. Lowery was fouled again, made one of two, and a long-range heave from Samford's Makaila Woolard was off the mark.

**AUBURN**-- Five Auburn players scored in double-figures, and Auburn's defense helped lead the charge as the Tigers ran away from Gardner-Webb with a 97-61 victory Tuesday night at Auburn Arena.

The Tigers (3-0) shot better than 50 percent in all four quarters, finishing at 53.4 percent for the game, and turned 24 turnovers by Gardner-Webb (0-2) into 25 points. All 14 players dressed saw the floor for Auburn, and 12 of 14 found their way onto the scoresheet.

Auburn's 97 points equaled its highest scoring output of the Terri Williams-Flournoy era, matching a 97-point effort in the season opener against Grambling State in

Thompson led Auburn with 21 points and 12 rebounds for her second double-double in as many games; she now has 44 in her career. She also had four steals on the night.

Redshirt sophomore Honesty Scott-Grayson and junior Keya Patton both had their best Auburn performances to date as both tallied 14 points. Scott-Grayson also pulled down a season-best seven rebounds along with a team-best five steals and three assists. Jala Jordan hit double-digits for the second time this season with an 11-point night along with a team-best four assists, and freshman Aicha Coulibaly finished with a season-best 10 points and six rebounds.

Freshman Romi Levy just missed double-digits with a nine-point effort that also included grab two rebounds, two steals and two blocks, one of which saw her sprint from half-court after a turnover to reject an otherwise open layup for the Runnin' Bulldogs. Annie Hughes added six points, all in the first few minutes. And freshman walk-on Riley Donahue scored her first collegiate points, hitting a 3-pointer in the final minute off an offensive rebound and assist from fellow freshman walk-on Carsen McFadden.

After Gardner-Webb hit the first basket of the game, Auburn pulled away early and never looked back, leading 28-9 after one period and 49-28 at the half. The Tigers kept up the pressure throughout, holding the Runnin' Bulldogs to a 29.4 percent shooting effort.

**HOUSTON**-- Auburn senior Unique Thompson scored 26 points and had 23 rebounds, but the Tigers were unable to climb out of a deep first-half hole as Auburn fell for the first time this season, 71-61 at Houston.

The Tigers (3-1) had turnover trouble early, went cold for a large portion of the second quarter, and dealt with foul trouble to key contributors as Houston (2-1) took a 34-17 halftime lead. But Auburn fought back in the second half, cutting the deficit to as few as six points before running out of time to complete the comeback.

Thompson's career night was the first 20-point, 20-rebound game by an Auburn player since 1993, when Lauretta Freeman had 30 points and 21 rebounds against Alabama. Thompson's 23 rebounds tied for the thirdmost in a game in Auburn history, the most since Sharon Stewart had 23 against Vanderbilt in 1988. She now has three double-doubles in four games this year and 45 for her career.

But the rest of Auburn's offense struggled as the Tigers shot 36 percent for the game (22-of-61) and hit just two 3-pointers. Both of those treys came from junior Alycia Reese, the Chattahoochee Valley CC transfer, who scored 10 points off the bench. Jala Jordan added 13 points and five rebounds, hitting 5-of-5 free throws.

Auburn turned the ball over 10 times in the first quarter and finished with 23 for the game, which turned into 21 Houston points. The Cougars led 22-9 after one, then with Thompson on the bench in foul trouble, both teams went cold to start the second before Houston took a 34-17 lead to the break.

The Tigers started chipping away, cutting the deficit to 14 at the end of the quarter and getting within single digits with 6:47 to play. It would be as close as six points at 59-53 with 4:18 to play after a Jordan layup. But every time Auburn threatened to get within striking distance, Houston answered. The Cougars hit four of their final five shots in the game to extinguish Auburn's comeback hopes.

**AUBURN**-- A shorthanded Auburn women's basketball team fought its way back from an early double-digit deficit to earn a 74-66 win over South Alabama Sunday afternoon at Auburn Arena.

Led by 21 points and 14 rebounds from senior Unique Thompson, four players scored in double-figures as the Tigers (4-1) trailed by as many as 12 and led by as many as 12 in a game that was truly a tale of two halves.

A flurry of 3-pointers to open the game gave South Alabama (3-2) an early lead, and a cold streak by the Tigers to open the second period pushed the Jaguars' lead to as many as 12 points at 24-12 with 6:04 to play in the half. But Auburn knocked down five straight 3-pointers in the final four minutes of the period to cut the halftime deficit to just six at 34-28.

With the Jaguars still holding the lead as the teams traded buckets the first six minutes of the second half, Auburn turned USA turnovers into points in a 9-0 run that spanned 82 seconds late in the quarter to take a 49-46 lead, its first since it was 2-0 to start the game. The Tigers would never trail again. pushing their lead to as many as 12 points with just over a minute to play.

Thompson's double-double was her fourth of the season and 46th of her career; she's totaled 47 points and 37 rebounds over her last two games. Sophomore Sania Wells added a career-high 11 points, knocking down three 3-pointers and a pair of free throws to go along with a pair of assists.

Sophomore Annie Hughes also poured in 11 points with a career-high three 3-pointers, and junior Kira Lowery added 10 points on the night. Freshman Romi Levy also had a strong performance with 8 points, 7 rebounds, 3 assists and 3 steals.

Auburn missed its first 11 3-point attempts of the night but made eight of its final 11 to finish at 36 percent. Overall, Auburn was 23-of-65 (35%) from the field and had a strong night at the free-throw line, going 20-for-26 (77%). The Tigers out-rebounded the Jags 44-37 and turned 21 USA turnovers into 15 points. Meanwhile, the Jags hit their first five 3-point attempts of the night but went just 2-of-14 from long range the rest of the way.

**AUBURN**-- Auburn and Stephen F. Austin traded blows for 35-plus minutes Wednesday night, but the Tigers went cold over the final five as the Ladyjacks pulled away late for a 67-54 win at Auburn Arena.

The Tigers (4-2) led throughout much of the first half, fell behind in the third period and briefly regained the lead midway through the fourth. But a tie game with less than five minutes to play got away from Auburn as SFA (6-2), the preseason pick to win the Southland Conference, ended the game on a 13-0 run.

Redshirt sophomore Honesty Scott-Grayson led the Tigers with a career-high 16 points and a pair of assists. Senior Unique Thompson picked up her fifth straight double-double with 11 points and 14 rebounds; she also led Auburn with four steals and a pair of blocks.

But baskets were tough to come by as the Tigers shot a season-low 33.9 percent (19-of-56), including 2-of-15 (13.3%) from 3-point range. Normally steady at the charity stripe, Auburn also struggled at the free-throw line, hitting 14-of-23 attempts (60.9%). Auburn was also out-rebounded for the first time this season, 43-34. The Tigers were able to force SFA into 24 turnovers, converting those into 18 points.

Auburn jumped out to a 6-0 lead and led 17-12 at the end of one. Both teams were ice cold for the next several minutes, but SFA started clawing its way back late in the half with three straight 3-pointers over a 90-second stretch to cut into the Tigers' lead. A Ladyjack layup at the buzzer would tie the game 27-27 at the half.

SFA took the lead early in the third and led 45-39 with a minute to play. But Auburn picked up the pressure and ended the quarter on a 6-0 run to tie it up 45-45 headed to the fourth. The Tigers moved back ahead 52-51 with 5:46 to play on an old-fashioned 3-point play by Scott-Grayson, but the Tigers would manage just one basket the rest of the way, missing their final eight shots of the game.

**AUBURN**-- Five Tigers scored in double-figures as Auburn topped the 90-point mark for the second time this season with a 94-81 win over North Florida Thursday night at Auburn Arena.

The Tigers (5-2) were able to bounce back from tough offensive night Wednesday in their loss to SFA with their second-highest scoring total of the season, getting big nights from senior Unique Thompson and sophomore Annie Hughes to lead the way.

Thompson led Auburn with 19 points and 18 rebounds, her sixth straight double-double and the 48th of her career. Her 18 rebounds were the most in a home game in her Auburn career; she also contributed three assists and two steals. Hughes hit for a career-high 17 points and matched a career-high with seven rebounds, knocking down three 3-pointers for the second time in three games. She also shared the team lead with three steals.

Redshirt sophomore Honesty Scott-Grayson scored 16 points for the second straight night, matching her career high from Wednesday's game. She also had three steals. Freshman Romi Levy also had a career-high 12 points along with five rebounds, and Jala Jordan came up just short of her first career double-double with 11 points and eight rebounds. Alaina Rice added nine points off the bench, her best at Auburn, and Kira Lowery led the Tigers with five assists and a career-best three steals.

Auburn shot 42.5 percent for the game, hitting 34 of a season-high 80 shots. The Tigers also hit a season-best 11 3-pointers, three from Hughes and two each from Jordan, Levy, Rice and Sania Wells. It was also a much-improved night at the free-throw line as the Tigers hit 15-of-18 attempts (83.3%). Auburn out-rebounded UNF 48-34 and forced the Ospreys into 22 turnovers, leading to 26 points.

Auburn maintained its double-digit lead throughout the third as the Ospreys kept launching 3-pointers, but the Tigers increased their lead by one more point to 66-53 headed to the fourth. Taking advantage of tired legs on the part of Auburn, UNF cut the lead to as few as seven points, shooting 58 percent in the fourth. But Auburn got big buckets from Thompson, Levy and Rice down the stretch to hold off the Ospreys' comeback bid.
