#### Game 7: Southeastern (3-3) at Auburn (4-2)



Southeastern Louisiana (3-3) at Auburn (4-2)

The Southeastern Louisiana women's basketball team will open a three-game road swing on Thursday, when it travels to Auburn for a 6 p.m. contest at Auburn Arena.

Southeastern evened its record on Tuesday with a 62-35 victory over William Carey. SLU forced the Lady Saders to shoot 28.0 percent (14-for-50) from the floor. The 35 points were the fewest allowed by Southeastern since an 81-30 victory over UNO in 2011-12.

In Tuesday's win, senior guard **Symone Miller** finished with 18 points, while junior forward **Nanna Pool** posted her fourth straight double-double with 17 points and 15 rebounds. Senior guard **Elizabeth Styles** led SLU with nine assists and four steals, while senior forward **Jameika Hoskins** grabbed nine rebounds.

Through six games, Southeastern is averaging 68.8 points per game. Pool leads the team with 17.2 points per game and is joined in double figures by Miller (15.7 ppg). Styles (9.7 ppg), junior guard **Peaches Anderson** (8.3 ppg) and Hoskins (7.5 ppg) are the other top scorers. Styles leads the Southland Conference with 6.8 assists per game.

Southeastern is averaging 41.5 rebounds per game and currently has a plus-3.2 rebounding margin. Pool is averaging

a double-double with a team-high 10.2 rebounds per contest. Hoskins has chipped in with 8.8 boards per outing.

SLU has allowed 69.7 points and forced 13.8 turnovers per contest. Pool leads the team with seven blocks, while Styles has a team-high 13 steals.

Auburn snapped a two-game losing streak with a 79-53 victory over Marquette on Tuesday. Junior post **Tra'Cee Tanner** leads the team with 16.5 points per game, followed by sophomore guard **Brandy Montgomery** (13.0 ppg). Sophomore wing **Katie Frerking** leads Auburn with 6.3 rebounds per game, while freshman guard **Neydja Petithomme** has dished out a teamhigh 3.2 assists per contest.

SLU and Auburn will be meeting for the second time ever. In the 1997-98 season, the Tigers hosted Southeastern and defeated the Lady Lions, 92-55

# Southeastern's Enters Yolanda Southeastern's Moore Era Preseason

A new era of Southeastern Louisiana women's basketball was ushered in on April 4, 2014, when two-time WNBA champion and successful junior college head coach **Yolanda Moore** was named the fifth head women's basketball coach in school history.

Moore spent the 2013-14 season as the head coach at LSU Eunice. Taking over a program that had won 17 games combined in the previous two seasons, Moore led the Lady Bengals to a 26-3 overall record and the program's first-ever Miss-Lou Conference championship.

LSU Eunice was ranked as high as No. 22 in the NJCAA Division I national rankings, thanks in large part to the commitment to defense by the 2013-14 NJCAA Region 23 Coach of the Year. The Lady Bengals finished the season ranked sixth nationally in scoring defense, holding opponents to just 39.9 points per game.

A 2010 inductee into the Ole Miss Sports Hall of Fame, Moore was a three-time All-Southeastern Conference post player for the Lady Rebels, including earning unanimous first team All-SEC honors in her final two seasons. Moore went on to become a player in the inaugural seasons of the WNBA and was a member of the champion Houston Comets during the league's first two years.

Following her playing career, Moore put her Ole Miss degree in radio and television to work. In addition to serving as a women's college basketball analyst for Fox Sports South in 2005, she was the postgame radio analyst for the NBA's Memphis Grizzles in 2007.

Moore also has extensive experience as both a consultant and motivational speaker. She released her first book, "You Will Win If You Don't Quit", in September 2012.

Moore, a Port Gibson, Miss. native, is the mother of four and has a grandson.

## Southeastern's Pool Named Preseason All-Southland Conference

## Southeastern Adds Four for 2015-16

The Southeastern Louisiana women's basketball team has added four student-athletes who will continue their athletic and academic endeavors beginning in the 2015-16 season, Lady Lion head coach **Yolanda Moore** announced on Thursday.

The four newest Lady Lions include two in-state guards in **Jaclyn Scholvin** (Mandeville) and **Baylie Stears** (Walker). Moore and her staff also includes a pair or post players in **Chambria Harrison**  (Vidalia, Georgia) and **Kyle Felton** (Decatur, Georgia). All four players are entering their senior seasons at their respective high schools in 2014-15.

The SLU coaching staff needed to be aggressive during the early signing period, as it was faced with replacing five 2014-15 seniors. That quintet includes three starters in Elizabeth Styles, Symone Miller and Jameika Hoskins. Moore believes the four new additions will help offset the losses of her current senior class.

Scholvin enters her senior season at Fontainebleau High School approaching 2,000 career points. The 5-7 point guard has averaged 15.7 points, seven rebounds, 4.4 steals and 3.8 assists per game through the first three seasons at FHS.

Stears comes to Hammond from down the road at Walker High School, where she averaged 10 points per game and helped WHS to the Class 5A quarterfinals as a junior. In addition to basketball, Stears has also competed in golf, volleyball and track and field.

Named one of South Georgia's top prospects in the Class of 2015, the 6-0 Harrison will join the SLU program out of Vidalia High School. Harrison also has experience playing for the Big South Dream Team.

Felton will provide an added dimension to the Southeastern roster with her 6-2 frame. She also brings a winning pedigree, having helped Columbia High School to a state championship as a sophomore.
