LEXINGTON, Ky. – Alabama hung tough, but ultimately came up short against No. 15/15 Kentucky, 66-62, on Thursday night inside Memorial Coliseum in Lexington, Ky. The Crimson Tide (13-10, 3-7 SEC) lost its sixth game to a nationally ranked opponent this season, while the Wildcats (18-4, 7-3 SEC) bounced back from a loss against Florida.

Junior Jasmine Walker led the Tide with 17 points and seven rebounds, while sophomore Brittany Davis was the only other UA player in double figures with 10 points off the bench.

From Coach Curry

"I thought we rebounded, we had some second chance opportunities in the second half compared the first half," head coach Kristy Curry said. "Brittany Davis came off the bench and played well along with Cierra Johnson, Ashley Knight and De'Sha Benjamin. I thought our bench really tried to help us in the second half. The offensive rebounding was also a lot better in the second."

Quarter-by-Quarter

The two sides started the game slow with the Wildcats taking the 14-10 edge into the second frame.

Alabama and Kentucky traded leads in the second period, with neither team gaining a significant advantage. UK held the four-point lead into the halftime break, 31-27.

Kentucky led by as many as 10 in the third quarter after two free throws made it 39-29 with 5:30 to go in the period. Alabama stormed back and a layup by Walker with just under a minute to cut it to 45-43, before a Wildcat three-pointer at the buzzer pushed the lead back to five heading into the final 10 minutes.

In the fourth, UK added to its lead and went up 57-49 with 3:34 to go. A quick 5-0 run by Alabama made it a one possession game with 2:56 on the clock. Kentucky responded by going up 64-57 with just over a minute remaining when Walker knocked down a clutch triple to trim the deficit to four.

26 seconds were on the clock as sophomore Brittany Davis converted

two free throw attempts to give Alabama a chance late, however, two free throws by Kentucky with 21 seconds sealed the 66-62 victory.

Player Spotlight

Walker bounced back after scoring in single digits over the last three games by scoring a game-high 17 points, 15 of which came in the second half. Senior Cierra Johnson provided quality minutes off the bench with seven points, five rebounds and five assists.

Key Notes & Stats

The Crimson Tide shot 42 percent (23-of-55) from the floor, while the Wildcats shot at a 38 percent (23-of-61) clip.

Alabama outrebounded Kentucky 40-35 and outscored the Cats 28-22 in the pain.

The Tide bench came up big again, outscoring UK 30-20.

Kentucky took care of the ball, only turning the ball over six times, while forcing 17 UA miscues.

NEWS AND NOTES

OPENING TIP

• Alabama is set to take on Auburn for the second time this season in the annual Power of Pink/Play4Kay game on Sunday, Feb. 9 at 2 p.m. CT in Coleman Coliseum. The Crimson Tide (13-10, 3-7 SEC) routed the Tigers (8-12, 2-7 SEC) on Jan. 12, 75-48, in Auburn Arena.

• Last time out, the Tide fell on the road to No. 15/15 Kentucky 66-62 on Thursday night in Lexington, while the Tigers picked up a win over Vanderbilt on Sunday and had a bye on Thursday.

The matchup on Sunday is the 92nd between the two rivals. In their last meeting, Alabama defeated
the Tigers on Auburn's home court 75-48 on Jan. 12, 2020. The win was Alabama's largest margin of
victory against the Tigers in Auburn Arena and at the time, it was also the Crimson Tide's first win of
the decade and the first in Southeastern Conference play.

SUNDAY FUNDAY

• The Crimson Tide has played its best basketball on Sundays by compiling an 8-1 record on the year. All three of Alabama's conference wins have come on Sunday with victories over Auburn, Vanderbilt and Ole Miss.

SHOOTERS SHOOT

• Junior Jasmine Walker is one of the best three-point shooters in the conference, as she fifth in the SEC in three-point makes (46), makes per game (2.0) and percentage (38.3). In conference play, Walker is averaging 2.4 three-point makes in 6.1 attempts per contest for a 39.3 clip.

• Walker leads the team in shots attempted (244), shots made (98), three-point makes (46) and threepoint attempts (120). The Montgomery native also is tops on the team in rebounds per game with 6.9.

"FREE" THROWS

• Crimson Tide sophomore Megan Abrams has converted 20 of her last 21 free throw attempts, dating back to the South Carolina game on Jan. 5.

• Alabama is one of the best in the country at getting to the free throw line. The Crimson Tide is No. 27 in the nation in free throw attempts (453) and No. 27 in makes (317). UA is knocking down its attempts at a 70.0 percent clip which is good enough for fourth in the SEC.

LEWIS DOES IT ALL

• Redshirt junior Jordan Lewis became the program's 29th 1,000-point scorer on Jan. 20 at Tennessee. She currently has 1,050 career points. Lewis took over the No. 7 spot in career assists at Alabama last game against Kentucky. For the season, Lewis leads the team in points (12.6), assists (3.7) and is second in steals (1.2).

• Off the court, Lewis was named to the 2019 SEC Community Service Team and represents the Tide at SEC meetings. She graduated with a degree in marketing in August 2019 and is currently working on her MBA. She is a three-time SEC Academic Honor Roll member and in AKA sorority. Lewis is also a team captain.

• Alabama is one of the best three-point shooting teams in the SEC, coming in at fourth in the conference in attempts (469), makes (159), makes per game (6.9) and is fifth in percentage (33.9).

THE GAUNTLET TO START SEC PLAY

• The Crimson Tide had one of the toughest schedules to start Southeastern conference play with five out of its first eight games coming against top-25 teams. Six of the seven of the teams the Tide has played are in the top-50 in RPI, which included, Arkansas, Texas A&M, Tennessee, Kentucky, South Carolina and LSU.

RECORD-BREAKING PERFORMANCE VS. VANDY

• The Crimson Tide had a record-breaking performance against Vanderbilt on Sunday, Jan. 26, with the Tide putting up the most points against an SEC team since 1999 after exploding for a 98-61 win over the Commodores. The 37-point victory was the largest margin of victory against an SEC team since Alabama defeated Mississippi State 97-64 on Jan. 13, 1996. Alabama was on fire from beyond the arc going 12-of-17 (70.6 percent) which is a school record for three-point percentage in a game with a minimum of eight three-pointers made.

KNIGHT BECOMES ALL-TIME BLOCK LEADER AT ALABAMA

• With three blocks against UNC (12/15), senior Ashley Knight passed Alabama great Yolanda Watkins for the most blocks in UA history. She currently has 210 career blocks, which is the most actively in the SEC. She still holds the single season block record with 90 her freshman year.

• Knight is currently averaging 1.83 blocks per game which is No. 54 in the nation and sixth in the SEC. Her 42 blocked shots this season are good enough for No. 42 in the country and sixth in the conference.

DAVIS EARNS NATIONAL RECOGNITION

• In the win over North Carolina (12/15) Davis dropped a career-high 23 points on an impressive 10-of-12 shooting, which earned her multiple awards and recognition.

• On Dec. 16, College Sports Madness named Davis the National Player of the Week for her performance. On Dec. 17, the Southeastern Conference tabbed Davis as the SEC POW and then on Dec. 18, the NCAA placed her on the Starting Five, which is the top 5 players in the country for the week.

CURRY PICKS UP 100TH WIN AT ALABAMA

• Head Coach Kristy Curry picked up her 100th win of her career at Alabama on Nov. 17 against Mercer. Curry is in her seventh season with the Tide and is the program's No. 2 winningest coach in history. She is one of 10 coaches nationally to lead three different programs to 100 wins.


