- ► The GW women's basketball returns to action with a non-conference road trip to visit the Auburn Tigers.
- ► The Colonials have dropped consecutive home games to Morgan State (L, 73-68) and Virginia Tech (L, 55-48) after opening the season with a 63-41 victory at UT Arlington.
- ▶ Wednesday's meeting between GW and Auburn is the seventh all-time in the series, all of which have come within the past six seasons. GW won the first three confrontations a home win in 2006, a buzzer-beating road triumph in Jan. 2008 and an NCAA Tournament first-round victory in March 2008. However, Auburn has bounced back for three consecutive wins one as a Top 10 team visiting Smith Center in Dec. 2008, a lopsided triumph in Alabama in December 2009 and last season's 52-45 victory at Smith Center.

- ▶ In last season's meeting, GW was overwhelmed 49-36 on rebounds. Auburn grabbed 27 offensive boards which translated to a 17-7 advantage in second-chance points. The Tigers also turned 15 Colonials turnovers into 15 points.
- ► The Colonials have been plagued by first-half shooting woes in the past two meetings. In 2009, GW shot just 16.7 percent en route to a 14-point opening half and a 62-43 road loss. Last season, GW managed just 15 points on 17.9 percent shooting and trailed 21-15 at halftime, eventually losing 52-45.
- ▶ Then-junior Tiana Myers paced GW last season with a game-high 12 points. Then-junior Tara Booker added eight points and eight rebounds.

SCOUTING AUBURN

- Auburn enters today's game with a 2-1 mark after finishing 16-16 overall with an 8-8 mark in the SEC in 2010-11.
- ► The Tigers were picked to finish ninth in the Southeastern Conference (SEC) preseason coaches' poll. AU was also picked ninth in the media poll.
- ▶ Auburn returns two starters and eight letterwinners. The Tigers are led by junior guard Blanche Alverson who averaged a 10.2 points, 4.7 rebounds and 1.0 assists per game in 2010-11.
- ▶ The Tigers are led by Tyrese Tanner and Camille Glymph. Tanner is averaging 13.0 points through three games while Glymph is averaging 11.3 points per contest.
- ▶ Auburn opened the 2011-12 season with consecutive victories over Mercer (W, 77-43) and Belmont (W, 80-53) before falling at No. 8/8 Duke, 70-53, last week.
- ▶ Glymph led Auburn against the Blue Devils with 12 points. Hasina Muhammad also posted double-figures with 10 points to go with three rebounds.

OPENING TIP TIDBITS

- ▶ GW, coming off a 8-21 overall record and 3-11 league mark, was picked to finish ninth in the 14-team Atlantic 10 Conference this season. A record eight A-10 teams have qualified for postseason play each of the past three seasons.
- ▶ Senior **Tara Booker** has climbed to a tie for eighth all-time at GW with 119 career three-pointers, just three shy of seventh place in program history. Her 58 three-pointers last season were seventh-most in the Atlantic 10 and tied 12th most in a single season in school history. Senior **Tiana Myers** has climbed to 15th in program annals with 79 career threes and is seventh in program history with a .802 free-throw percentage.
- ▶ Over the past two seasons, GW has lost 23 games by 10 points or less, including 12 games in 2010-11.
- ▶ In three seasons under **Mike Bozeman**, GW is 22-17 when scoring at least 60 points and 10-42 when scoring less than 60. Conversely, GW is 11-48 when allowing at least 60 points and 21-11 when allowing less than 60.
- ▶ GW returns four starters. Among the team's returners are two key players who missed most of the 2010-11 season due to injury:
- -Jr. **Megan Nipe** returns from a torn meniscus. She averaged 9.0 points and 6.3 rebounds in four games in 2010-11.
- -Jr. **Shi-Heria Shipp** missed all but five minutes of 2010-11. She averaged 7.2 points, 2.7 rebounds and 1.9 assists per game as a freshman in 2009-10.

NEW KIDS ON THE COURT

The Colonials welcome a trio of freshmen into the fold with guards Bria Bourgeois and Chakecia Miller along with forward Adrienne Phillips joining the team for the 2011-12 season.

- ► Miller was rated the 93rd-best point guard overall and second-best point guard prospect in Georgia by ESPN HoopGurlz. She averaged 12.5 points, 3.2 assists, 4.7 steals and 2.8 rebounds as a senior at Campbell (Ga.) High School in 2010-11 and was a McDonalds All-American candidate.
- ▶Bourgeois was rated the 24th-best wing player overall and top wing in Georgia by ESPN HoopGurlz after averaging 17.1 points, 7.6 rebounds and 2.2 steals at George Walton High School 2010.
- ▶ Phillips, a left-handed forward, averaged 10.2 points, 4.1 rebounds and 0.8 blocks to earn First Team All-District 24 Class 5A and Second Team All-Galveston County honors as a senior at Clear Creek (Texas) High School 2010-11.

NEW FACES ON THE BENCH

In addition to the trio of freshmen newcomers, Coach Bozeman welcomes assistant coaches Kristina Cole and Tamika Louis to his coaching staff following the departures of Katie Rokus and Kristeena Alexander, who took similar positions at Cincinnati and UNC Greensboro, respectively. Assistant coach Richard Moore returns for his third season on the bench at GW.

- ▶ Coach Louis has spent the past four seasons serving as assistant coach at Big East program St. John's (2009-11) and Big Ten program Illinois (2007-09). At St. John's she helped the Red Storm to a 47-18 overall record, 21-11 mark in the Big East and back-to-back trips to the second round of the NCAA tournament. She will serve as recruiting coordinator, work with the team's guards and assist with scouting and practice planning for the Colonials.
- ► Coach Cole most recently spent three seasons as the head coach at America East program New Hampshire from 2007-10. Coach Cole also served stints as an assistant coach at Xavier (2002-07), Ball State (2001-02), UNLV (1999-01) and Auburn (1996-99). She will assist Coach Bozeman with scouting, game preparation, recruiting, and player development, specifically the Colonials' post players.
- ►Also joining the women's basketball staff as Director of Basektball Operations is Eboni Tyler. Tyler comes to GW after serving as guest services manager for the District-based Monumental Sports & Entertainment and the professional basketball franchises Washington Wizards and Washington Mystics.
- ▶ Tyler is joined by Erin Hawkins, the Assistant Director of Basketball Operations. Hawkins concluded a stand-out career at Morgan State during which she helped the Lady Bears to 17 victories in each of her three collegiate seasons, including the programs first-ever Division I postseason appearance (WNIT) last season.

FOREVER TEAMMATES

GW has a set of former high school teammates on its 2011-12 roster - seniors **Tara Booker** and **Sara Mostafa** from southern New Jersey's Absegami High. Booker and Mostafa have been playing together since they were 10-year-olds participating on junior league and middle school teams.

HOMECOMING

GW has two players on its 2011-12 roster who returned to their home state for the season opener against UTA in senior Kristin Aldridge (Mansfield, Texas) and freshman Adrienne Phillips (League City, Texas)

COMEBACK KIDS

GW posted a 22-point turnaround to post a come-frombehind 67-58 victory over George Mason on Dec. 5 2011. The Colonials trailed by 13 points at halftime, 30-17, but shot 63.6 percent in the second half, outscoring the Patriots, 50-28, over the final 20 minutes. It marked GW's largest comeback win since overcoming a 16-point first-half deficit and posting a 28-point turnaround in a 68-56 victory over James Madison in Nov. 2006.

HISTORY LESSON

Despite last season's 14-43 record the past two seasons, GW still possesses one of the nation's best track records over the past 20 years. GW's resume includes the following since 1990:

REUNION WITH RUTGERS

- ► GW will renew its rivalry with Rutgers at the Charles E. Smith Center on Dec. 30. The Colonials trail the all-time series 29-9 against the Scarlet Knights.
- ▶ In the last season's meeting, GW faltered, 60-50, in Piscataway on Jan. 3, despite a career-high 23 points on 11-of-17 shooting from Sara Mostafa.
- ▶ GW trailed by two, 36-34, just over five minutes into the second half but Rutgers used an 11-0 second-half run to pull away. The Colonials got as close as seven, 56-49, with 65 seconds left but Tara Booker missed an open three and Rutgers clinched the 10-point victory with late free throws.
- ▶ The last time the two teams played at the Charles E. Smith Center, the Colonials used a late 13-0 run to shock Rutgers, 45-43 on Dec. 30, 2009.
- ▶ Trailing 40-32 with 10:05 to play, the Colonials held the Scarlet Knights scoreless for more than nine minutes and scored 13 unanswereed points to turn an eight-point deficit into a 45-40 lead with 1:12 remaining.

GW'S LAST TIME OUT - GW FALLS TO VIRGINIA TECH, 55-48

WASHINGTON - Virginia Tech used an 11-6 run over the final four minutes of action to defeat the George Washington women's basketball team, 55-48, on Saturday afternoon at Charles E. Smith Center.

Both GW (1-2) and Virginia Tech (2-1) started the game ice cold from the field, combining for just one field goal and four total points over the first five minutes. The Colonials played strong defense throughout the contest, especially in the first half when they held the Hokies to 35 percent (7-of-20) from the field, and did not surrender a field goal until nearly eight minutes into the game.

Junior Danni Jackson led all players with 14 points on 5-of-11 shooting with three rebounds and sophomore Chelisa Painter netted a career-high 10 points to go with three rebounds.

The Colonials used a 6-0 run midway through the half to build a four point cushion, an advantage they sustained and carried into halftime for a 23-19 lead.

GW started the second half with a 7-2 run but the Hokies responded midway through the period with a 9-2 spurt to tie the score 35-35 with 10 minutes remaining. The teams proceeded to trade baskets until Virginia Tech took their first lead of the second half at 41-40 with six minutes left on a layup by Monet Tellier.

Tellier, who entered the match as Virginia Tech's leading scorer, was held in check by the Colonials. She finished just 2-of-11 from the field for five points. The Hokies were led by Alyssa Fenyn who posted a double-double with 11 points and 11 rebounds.

The Colonials briefly regained the lead on a jumper from senior Sara Mostafa, but the Hokies retaliated with a layup from Taylor Avers to take a 43-42 lead. Virginia Tech would not trail again for the rest of the game as they closed on an 11-6 run to send GW to its second consecutive home loss. Overall the teams traded the lead six times and the game featured six ties.

After shooting an even 50 percent (11-of-22) from the field in the first half, the Colonials could muster only seven field goals on 25 percent shooting in the second half. GW also struggled at the free throw line, converting just 11-of-23 attempts for

Mostafa, Painter and Jackson combined for 32 of GW's 48 points, but the rest of the team shot just 6-of-25 from the field.

THIS IS GW

The main campus of The George Washington University is located just four blocks from the White House in the northwest quadrant of Washington, DC, in the historic Foggy Bottom neighborhood. The western border of campus is a couple of blocks from the Kennedy Center and the Watergate complex. The U.S. State Department is GW's next-door neighbor to the south. There are a total of 20,427 students enrolled at GW, the majority of whom are graduate students pursuing advanced degrees. Prominent alumni include the late Red Auerbach and Jacqueline Kennedy Onassis, and Colin Powell.

LAST TIME THEY MET - GW DROPS FIRST AT HOME, 52-45 AGAINST AUBURN (DEC. 15, 2010)

WASHINGTON - The George Washington women's basketball team used a 10-1 run late in the second half to get within 46-39 with less than two minutes to play, but Auburn held on for a 52-45 victory Wednesday that dealt the Colonials their first loss at Charles E. Smith Center this season.

It was GW's (5-5) first loss in six home games this season and third straight loss to Auburn (4-5), which evened the six-game all-time series that began in 2006 at 3-3.

GW limited Auburn to just 29.7 percent shooting from the field, but was overwhelmed 49-36 on rebounds. The Tigers grabbed a season-high 27 offensive rebounds, which led to a 17-7 advantage in second-chance points, and also turned the Colonials' 15 turnovers into 15 points.

Junior Tiana Myers scored all of her team-high 12 points in the second half, including six points in the final 2:38. Junior Tara Booker added eight points and team-high eight rebounds for GW Blanche Alverson (16 points) and Alli Smalley (14) combined for 11-of-30 shooting and 30 of Auburn's 52 points. No other Tiger player scored more than five points. Jordan Greenleaf finished with a game-high 11 rebounds and four blocks.

For the second straight meeting, GW found itself in too deep of a hole after an abysmal first-half shooting effort. A season ago, the Colonials shot just 16.7 percent en route to a 14-point opening half and a 62-43 loss in Auburn, AL. On Wednesday, GW managed just 15 points on 17.9 percent shooting and trailed 25-15 at halftime.

That's as close as it would get though as Auburn matched GW's final three baskets for the 52-45 final.

The Colonials improved to 33.3 percent from the floor overall after a 13-for-26 effort in the second half, but dropped to 1-3 this season when shooting below 35 percent.
