A Look At Auburn...

Auburn enters Friday's game with a record of 2-0 after opening the season with a 77-43 victory over Mercer last Friday and an 80-53 win against Belmont on Tuesday. The Tigers concluded the 2010-11 season with an appearance in the second round of the WNIT while compiling an overall record of 16-16. Under the direction of head coach Nell Fortner, who enters her eighth season at the helm of the program, Auburn returns three starters and 10 letterwinners for the 2011-12 campaign.

Tyrese Tanner (15.0 points, 2.0 rebounds), Camille Glymph (11.0 points, 2.0 rebounds), Jassany Williams (10.5 points, 6.0 rebounds) and Blanche Alverson (10.0 points, 6.5 rebounds) are all averaging double figures through the Tigers' first two games of the season.

The Series With Auburn...

Duke and Auburn will meet for the fifth time in school history with the Blue Devils leading the series,

4-0. The teams will square off for the third time in Cameron Indoor Stadium after Duke claimed a 75-62 victory in the meeting last year at Auburn.

Duke owns an all-time record of 28-13 against teams from the SEC -- Alabama (0-1), Arkansas (2-1), Auburn (4-0), Florida (2-1), Georgia (3-0), Kentucky (3-0), LSU (3-2), Mississippi State (1-0), South Carolina (1-1), Tennessee (6-5), Vanderbilt (3-2).

Storylines/Other Blue Devil Notes...

- The Blue Devils are coming off shooting 50.0 percent from the field and 42.9 percent from three-point land in the second half at BYU.
- Duke's eight returning letterwinners own 78 career starts, while 2011 graduates Jasmine Thomas, Krystal Thomas and Karima Christmas totaled 237 starts over the last four years.
- The Blue Devils feature nine freshmen and sophomores on the roster in 2011-12, which is the most since Duke had 10 on the roster in 2000-01.
- The average age of Duke's squad this season is 19 years old. This is the youngest since the 2000-01 squad that had an average age of 18.2.
- Over the last 12 years, Duke owns the third-most wins in the nation -- Connecticut (380), Tennessee (345) and Duke (335) *through games of 11/15.*
- Duke lost 45.8 percent of its scoring from a year ago with the graduation of Jasmine Thomas, Krystal Thomas and Karima Christmas. All three were selected in the 2011 WNBA Draft.
- The Blue Devils return only 458 points from its upperclassmen -- Shay Selby, Kathleen Scheer and Allison Vernerey. This is the fewest in school history with the next being 491 in 1990-91. The three returning upperclassmen also matches for the fewest in school history (1995-96).

to start her first collegiate game at BYU. She joins teammate Chloe Wells as she also started her first game a year ago. In Duke's history, only 23 freshmen have started their first collegiate contest.

At Home in Cameron...

Since Head Coach Joanne P. McCallie took over as head coach at Duke in 2007-08, she has guided the Blue Devils to a 57-4 overall record in Cameron Indoor Stadium. During that stretch, the Blue Devils posted a 14-0 mark in 2008-09 and 17-0 ledger in 2010-11, which was only the second and third undefeated home seasons in school history.

Duke is currently riding a school-record 25-game winning streak in Cameron and has won 48 out of the last 49 games at home. In Cameron Indoor Stadium, Duke has won 57 out of the last 61 contests, 71 out of the last 75 and 152 out of the last 162 games since 2000-01

Duke's current 25-game winning streak in Cameron Indoor Stadium ranks as the best in school history. The other top streaks are -- 24 (2005-06 through 2007-08; 2007-08 through 2009-10; 21 (2001-02 through 2002-03), 20 (2003-04 through 2004-05) and 16 (1998-99 through 1999-2000).

Williams Shines in Exhibition Games...

Blue Devil freshman Elizabeth Williams was solid in the two exhibition games averaging 19.0 points, 7.0 rebounds, 6.0 blocks, 3.5 steals and 1.5 assists as she started both contests. She led Duke with a 28.5 minutes per game average, but struggled shooting from the field with a 44.1 field goal percentage.

In the season opener at BYU, Williams scored all of her eight points in the second half, hit 4-of-5 field goals, had two rounds, one block and one steal all in the second stanza.

Duke Boasts Young Squad...

Duke returns only two starters -- Haley Peters and Chelsea Gray -- for the 2011-12 campaign but welcomes back eight student-athletes who started at least two contests from a year ago.

The Blue Devils feature only two seniors and one junior to go along with nine freshmen and sophomores

marking the youngest squad in Coach P's 20 years as a head coach.

Duke Returns Zero Double-Digit Scorers...

For the first time in school history, the Blue Devils will open a season with zero returning double-digit scorers in 2011-12. The highest returning scorer for Duke is Chelsea Gray with an 8.7 per game average.

In the ACC, Duke, Clemson, Virginia, North Carolina and Virginia Tech all return zero double-figure scorers.

Breaking Down the Exhibitions...

Duke knocked off Pfeiffer (112-27) and Lander (79-52) in two exhibition games. Three Blue Devils averaged double-figure scoring in those contests -- Elizabeth Williams (19.0), Chloe Wells (16.5) and Chelsea Gray (16.5). Haley Peters led Duke with 15 rebounds, while Gray had team-bests in assists (13) and steals (10). Williams swatted 12 shots and notched 11 offensive rebounds.

As a team, Duke hit 49.7 percent from the field and 35.7 percent from downtown. The Blue Devils hit only 56.8 percent from the free throw line.

Blue Devils Preseason Ranked No. 8...

Duke has been preseason ranked No. 8 nationally in both the Associated Press and USA Today ESPN Division I Coaches polls to open the season. It marks the 12th year in a row that Duke has been preseason ranked in the top 10 by both polls.

Gray Gets Preseason Honors...

Sophomore guard Chelsea Gray has been tabbed a preseason John R. Wooden Award candidate for National Player of the Year as well as an honorable mention preseason Associated Press All-America. Gray was one of 30 preseason selections for the Wooden Award.

On This Date...

Duke owns an all-time record of 4-1 in games played on Nov. 18 over the history of the program. This will be only the second time the Blue Devils have played at home on Nov. 18 with the other game coming in 2007 against UNC Greensboro with an 84-39 victory.

Wins Last Five Years...

Duke owns the fourth-most wins over the last six years in the nation -- Connecticut (184), Stanford (168), Tennessee (162) and Duke (147) - updated 11/15.

Blue Devils Lead Gatorade Lists...

The 2011-12 Duke roster features seven former Gatorade State Players of the Year selections -- Amber Henson (Florida), Elizabeth Williams (Virginia), Chelsea Gray (California), Richa Jackson (Oklahoma), Tricia Liston (Illinois), Kathleen Scheer (Missouri) and Shay Selby (Ohio).

The seven honorees are the most of any other team in the nation -- Tennessee (6), Ohio State (5), Connecticut (5), Stanford (4), Baylor (4), Maryland (4), North Carolina (4) and Kentucky (4).

Duke Picked Second in ACC...

The Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) released the preseason ACC women's basketball poll on Tuesday with Duke selected No. 2 by a vote of the Blue Ribbon Panel, which consists of national and local media, as well as school representatives.

Duke received 10 first place votes, while Miami earned 30 first place votes on its way to being picked No. 1. Following Duke to round out the top five of the preseason selections was Maryland, Florida State and Georgia Tech. North Carolina was picked to finish sixth, followed by N.C. State, Virginia, Boston College, Wake Forest, Clemson and Virginia Tech.

The Blue Devils have now been selected in the top three of the ACC Preseason poll for the 11th straight year.

Career Double-Doubles For The 2011-12 Blue Devils

Head Coach Joanne P. McCallie 5th Season at Duke 20th Year as Head Coach

Accomplishments

- Signed the No. 1 ranked recruiting class in the nation at Duke in 2009-10 and 2010-11.
- Led the Blue Devils to 30 victories in 2010-11, which marks her third 30-win season as a head coach and Duke's ninth all-time
- Led the Blue Devils to the 2010 and 2011 ACC Championship, which marked the sixth and seventh overall conference titles in school history.
- Became the first Division I head coach to win a conference title in four different leagues ACC, Big Ten, America East, North Atlantic.
- Won 82 games in her first three years at Duke, which is the second-most in NCAA Division I history by a coach in the first three years at a school.
- Is the first Division I head coach to be named conference coach of the year in four different conferences.
- Reached 100 wins at Duke in only 122 games, the second-quickest to ever reach 100 wins at a school.
- · Led Duke to its ninth 30-win season out of the last 11 years.
- Became only the second Division I head coach to lead two different programs to 30-win seasons.

- Became only the second Division I head coach to lead two different programs to a No. 1 seed in the NCAA Tournament.
- Is one of only three Division I head coaches to guide three different programs to the NCAA Tournament.
- Led Duke to a 17-0 record at home in 2010-11, marking just the third time in school history the Blue Devils have gone undefeated in Cameron Indoor Stadium in one season.
- Coach P is one of only four head coaches in Division I history to lead three different programs to 25 or more wins in a single season.



- Won a gold medal as coach of the 2006 U20 National team and the 2007 U21 World Championship team.
- $\bullet\,$ In 2005, led MSU to the Big Ten regular season and tournament championships and the NCAA National Championship game.
- Left Maine as the school's all-time winningest women's basketball coach (167 victories).
- Appeared in two NCAA National Championship games as an assistant coach at Auburn.
- Honored on Dec. 21, 2009, with her name on a banner in the rafters at Maine.
 She was the first coach to have their name in the rafters in Alfond Arena.
