### EAGLES POISED TO MAKE A LEAP IN THIRD SEASON OF HOWARD ERA

Head Coach Anita Howard begins her third season at the helm of Georgia Southern women's basketball in 2021-22. In each of her first two seasons, the Eagles have improved in the win column (7 in 2018-19, 10 in 2019-20, 11 in 2020-21 despite playing six fewer games) as well as statistically. Georgia Southern ranked among the Top 25 in NCAA Division I in eight separate statistical categories in 2020-21. Highlights include ranking seventh in rebounds per game at 45.25, 15th in the nation in steals per game at 10.9 and 16th in turnovers forced per game at 20.12. All of this was accomplished with the fourth-youngest team in NCAA Division I.

This season, the Eagles return nine players from last season's squad and bring in six newcomers. Georgia Southern is still a relatively young squad - eight players are sophomores or freshman, while two other juniors will be making their NCAA Division I debuts. Only one player on the roster, senior captain Tsubasa Nisbet, has played more than two seasons at Georgia Southern.

Coach Howard notes that the Eagles were third in the nation in pace of play in 2020-21, and she wants to keep that up going into 2021-22. She has set a goal of 100 possessions per game, which is quite lofty, but it's an attacking mindset that has prevailed throughout her preseason practices and sessions with the team. Every player on the roster will have the opportunity to produce, and it starts on Thursday night with a statement game opportunity at SEC foe Auburn.

### ABOUT THE TIGERS

Auburn enters its own new era as long-time SEC assistant and associate head coach Johnnie Harris finally gets the chance to take the reins of her own program. The 2018 WBCA National Assistant Coach of the Year was named the new head coach on April 3 of this past season after spending 16 years combined at Arkansas, Texas A&M, Mississippi State and Texas.

The Tigers went 5-19 a year ago and were 0-15 in SEC action. The team returns three starters and 10 players total from last season's squad, including Honesty Scott-Grayson, who started all 24 games last season and averaged 14.5 ppg. Mississippi State transfer Xaria Wiggins and Iona transfer Adoora Onwumelu headline the newcomers for Coach Harris. Auburn leads the overall series between the two teams, 5-1. The two teams last met in the 2013-14 season opener, a 69-59 win for the Tigers in Auburn, Ala. Auburn has won five straight in the series - the lone win for Georgia Southern in the series came in the first meeting, back on January 29, 1977. It was a 69-62 win for the Eagles. Auburn is 4-0 all-time against the Eagles in Auburn.

## EAGLES PICKED NINTH IN SUN BELT PRESEASON POLL

It was a good news-bad news situation when the Sun Belt Conference released its 2021 Preseason Coaches Poll for the Eagles. Georgia Southern was picked the highest it's ever been picked in the poll since joining the league in 2014-15, which is the good news. However, the Eagles were picked ninth (out of 12 teams) in the poll, receiving 54 points. Georgia Southern is picked to finish ahead of Arkansas State, Coastal Carolina and ULM. In the divisional format last season, Georgia Southern finished fifth in the East Division with a 5-9 mark. But the Eagles did not get to play any of their scheduled four games against Coastal Carolina due to COVID-19 issues, and Coastal Carolina finished the season winless in league play. This season, the Sun Belt is back to the single division format.

## ALL EYES ON WARD

Sophomore guard/forward Terren Ward became just the third Georgia Southern women's basketball player to earn conference Freshman of the Year honors in 2020-21, as she was the Sun Belt's top freshman. She joins 1990 TAAC Freshman of the Year Markisha Vereen and 2007 SoCon Freshman of the Year Carolyn Whitney. This season, Ward was a third-team Preseason All-Conference selection in a vote of the league's coaches. The Jesup, Ga., native played in 22 games last season, averaging 7.9 points and 4.6 rebounds per game. She was the Sun Belt's Player of the Week on February 8, becoming the first freshman to earn a weekly POTW honor, and she averaged a team-best 9.2 points per game in Sun Belt contests.

## EAGLES IN SEASON OPENERS AGAINST SEC FOES

Georgia Southern has opened the season against SEC foes several times in its history. Thursday's matchup against Auburn will be the seventh time, and the Eagles have a 3-3 record in those contests. The Eagles opened the 1976-77 and 1977-78 seasons by defeating Georgia at home in Statesboro, then hosted Florida in a season-opening tournament in Statesboro to begin the 1987-88 year and downed the Gators, 79-68. Georgia Southern then dropped the 1993-94 opener at home to South Carolina and the 2010-11 opener at Georgia. The last opener against an SEC team was also the last meeting for the Eagles against Auburn - the 2013-14 campaign kicked off with Auburn hosting Georgia Southern and winning, 69-59.

## THE CALIFORNIA CONNECTION

Head Coach Anita Howard wanted to expand the recruiting footprint for Georgia Southern when she took over the program, and one of the first things she did was sign a pair of Californians to travel across country to suit up for the Eagles. Fresno native Daeja Holmes and San Diego native Simone James each had solid debut seasons for the Eagles in 2020-21, with Holmes leading the team in three-point shooting (23-88, 36.4%) while averaging 7.3 ppg, and James starting 17 of 24 contests and averaging 6.6 points per game with 22 steals. The pair will get the opportunity to play in their home state coming up in just nine days as the Eagles will travel to face San Diego State on November 20th.

## THE POST PRESENCE

Georgia Southern ranked second in the Sun Belt in rebounding in 2020-21 due in large part to the post play, and this year looks to be no different as the Eagles will feature not only 6-5 sophomore Lydia Freeman and 6-2 redshirt sophomore Eden Johnson back in the mix, but the addition of 6-4 grad transfer Maya Banks from Wake Forest and 6-1 junior college transfer Thaniya Marks from Shelton State CC. The Eagles' 45.3 rebounds per game last season was the fifth-best single-season rebounding average in program history and the overall best since 2002-03.

## HIGH OCTANE

Georgia Southern averaged 75.5 points per game in 2020-21, ranking 25th in NCAA Division I in scoring offense. It was the most points scored for the Eagles in a single season in more than 20 years - the 1997-98 squad averaged 77.1 points per game. Last year, the Eagles topped the century mark against Coastal Georgia, scoring 118 points - just one off of the school single-game record - while Georgia Southern topped 85 points six times. One of the Eagles' signature wins was a 96-91 victory over Sun Belt regular season champion Troy, which was the most points scored in a Sun Belt Conference contest by Georgia Southern since joining the league in 2014.

## STEAL AWAY

Head Coach Anita Howard has preached defense since her first day on campus for Georgia Southern. As a three-time conference Defensive Player of the Year at Fort Valley State, she made her living as a collegiate player with defense. Last season, the Eagles were one of the top teams in the Sun Belt and the nation in forcing turnovers and collecting steals. The 10.9 steals per game that led the Sun Belt and ranked 15th nationally were the most for Georgia Southern since 2000-01, and the 20.12 turnovers forced per game ranked 16th in the nation and also led the Sun Belt. For the Eagles to continue on their upward trend, they will have to continue to be active defensively and generate possessions.

# HEAD COACH ANITA HOWARD



## anita **HOWARD**

**Head Coach • Third Season**  
**Griffin, Ga. • Armstrong Atlantic State (2003)**

Anita Howard enters her third season as the head women's basketball coach at Georgia Southern in 2021-22. The Eagles improved their win total in her second season despite playing six fewer games because of COVID-19 and finished the year ranking among the Top 25 in NCAA Division I in eight separate statistical categories.

Georgia Southern was 11-13 overall in 2020-21 and 5-9 in Sun Belt play, but shined at home where the Eagles were 8-4 at Hanner Fieldhouse, the best home record for women's basketball in more than a decade. Included in those Hanner wins was a 96-91 win over Troy, the first win for the Eagles over the eventual Sun Belt champs since 1978-79. Coach Howard had three different student-athletes earn Sun Belt Player of the Week honors and she also coached the 2020-21 Sun Belt Freshman of the Year, Terren Ward.

Statistically, the Eagles were seventh in rebounds per game at 45.25, while ranking ninth in offensive rebounds per game at 16.2. Georgia Southern ranked 15th in the nation in steals per game at 10.9, while also ranking 16th in turnovers forced per game at 20.12.

The Eagles placed 20th in total steals with 262, 24th in the nation in total rebounds with 1,086 and rebounding margin at +7.4, while ranking 25th in scoring offense at 75.5 points per game.

All of those numbers were among the top two among Sun Belt Conference schools, as the turnovers forced and steals per game led the league. Georgia Southern also ranked second in the league in free throws attempted and made (374-513) and in defensive rebounds per game (29.1).

Coach Howard arrived in Statesboro in April of 2019 after a three-year stint as the head coach at Columbus State University. In her first season with Georgia Southern she guided the Eagles to a 10-20 overall record and a 7-11 Sun Belt Conference mark. The seven Sun Belt Conference wins were the second-most achieved by the program since joining the league in 2014-15.

Howard is the eighth head coach in Georgia Southern women's basketball history. Her hiring made her the first African American female head coach of Georgia Southern women's basketball and, in essence, returned her home as Howard graduated from Armstrong State University in 2003, which consolidated with Georgia Southern in 2017.

In her three seasons prior to Georgia Southern, Howard led Columbus State to two NCAA Division II Championships appearances and an NCAA Elite Eight appearance in 2016-17. Her overall record was 66-25 over the three seasons, including an outstanding 45-18 mark in Peach Belt Conference play.

Prior to Columbus State, Howard served as the head coach at Livingstone College for two seasons and Salem College for three seasons. She led

Livingstone to a Top 5 national ranking and a record 23-game winning streak, while also turning around a Salem College program that won just four games before her arrival and directing the Spirits to 17- and 21-win seasons, earning Great South Athletic Conference Coach of the Year honors. In seven seasons as a collegiate head coach, she has compiled a 145-55 overall record, for an outstanding .725 winning percentage.

Born in Montgomery, Alabama, Howard was a standout high school player at A.E. Beach High School in Savannah under the legendary Ronald Booker. She played collegiately for three seasons at Fort Valley State University, earning SIAC Defensive Player of the Year honors all three years. She then transferred to Armstrong State for the 2002-03 season, where she helped the Pirates compile a school-record 27-4 mark, capturing the Peach Belt Conference regular season and tournament title while leading the team to their first NCAA Championships appearance.

She graduated magna cum laude from Armstrong State in 2003 with her bachelor's degree in fine arts design. Beginning her coaching career in Savannah, she was the head coach at Savannah High before moving into the collegiate ranks as an assistant coach at Winston-Salem State, Shaw (N.C.) and St. Augustine's (N.C.) before beginning her head coaching career at Division III Salem College in 2012.

Howard and her husband, Theo, have three children: Jason, Thallan and Theo II.


