South Carolina Notables

- This is the Gamecocks' 39th season as a varsity sport, the fifth with head coach Dawn Staley at the helm.
- South Carolina's No. 15 ranking in this week's Associated Press poll is the program's highest mark since coming in at No. 15 the week of Feb. 10, 2003.
- Senior guard Ieasia Walker was named SEC Player of the Week last week for her efforts in the Gamecocks' wins over then-No. 5/4 Kentucky and at Arkansas. She averaged 11.5 points, 3.5 assists, 4.0 steals and 5.0 rebounds.
- Through 21 games, the Gamecock defense has allowed just one opponent to score 60 or more points in a game to rank third in the country in scoring defense. South Carolina is allowing just 47.3 points per game, including just 50.2 points per SEC contest. No Gamecock opponents has scored its season average entering the game, and only four have come within 10 points of their season average. Seven have been held 30 or more points below their average, including two SEC opponents on their own home courts.
- Senior guard Ieasia Walker scored her 1,000th career point as part of her 24-point outing against LSU (Jan. 17). She is the 28th member of that club and just the 12th to also compile at least 200 career steals. She is one of just three active SEC players to have 1,000 career points in combination with 200 career steals and 200 career assists. Walker has an outside chance to reach 500 rebounds as well, sitting at 428 in her career.
- Senior forward Ashley Bruner is one of 26 Gamecocks to amass 500 career rebounds and has a chance to become just the 18th to record at least 600, needing 12 to achieve that plateau.



Uniform Patch

The Gamecocks continue to wear the patch added to their uniforms last season to honor teammate Shelbretta Ball, who was medically disqualified from playing in Fall 2011. The team wanted Brett and everyone watching to know that she will always be an integral part of them and whatever they achieve this season.

Additionally, senior guard Ieasia Walker changed her jersey number this season to honor her teammate who was slated to wear that number prior to being medically disqualified.

A South Carolina Win Would...

- Make the Gamecocks 7-2 in SEC play for the first time since the 2001-02 team opened league play with a 9-2 mark.
- Match the 2001-02 team's overall 19-3 start to the season. The Gamecocks reached 21 wins before recording their fourth loss that season, finishing 25-7 in the NCAA Tournament Elite Eight.

By the Numbers

- 1 Opponent that has scored 60 or more points against the Gamecocks this season, helping South Carolina to No. 3 in the nation in scoring defense

The Auburn Series

The Tigers hold a 21-15 edge in the series, but the teams have evenly split the six games played in the Dawn Staley era. Additionally, the Gamecocks hold a 9-7 advantage in games played in Columbia.

Auburn claimed the most recent meeting between the two, a 53-49 decision on the Tigers' home court on Jan. 19, 2012. South Carolina has won the last two match-ups in Columbia, most recently a 65-49 effort on Feb. 20, 2011. Auburn's last win over the Gamecocks in Columbia was an 80-76 decision on Jan. 8, 2009.

Gamecocks' Five-Second Count

With a complementary blend of youth and experience, South Carolina opened a season 10-0 for the first time since the 1981-82 team also won its first 10 contests. The Gamecocks, now 18-3 overall and 6-2 in SEC action, have shown they have both inside and outside offensive options and are dominant on the glass this season while the defense has dropped off very little from last season's NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 effort. Two Gamecocks average double-figure points with three others netting 5.0 or more per game. South Carolina ranks seventh in the nation with a +10.1 rebounding margin and has three players ranked among the SEC's top 20 rebounders. Defensively, the Gamecocks are third in the nation in scoring defense, yielding just 47.3 points per game. South Carolina has held 16 of its 21 opponents this season to 50 or fewer points and limited seven of the 20 to under 30 percent field goal shooting, including Hampton (Nov. 22), which hit just 19.3 percent (11-57) from the field for the second-lowest

opponent field goal percentage of the Staley era, and Vanderbilt (Jan. 10), which shot just 26.5 percent after coming into the game with the SEC's second-highest field goal accuracy at 45.2.

Home Sweet Home

South Carolina is in its 11th season at Colonial Life Arena and enjoys a 114-57 (.667) record in that time. Overall, the Gamecocks are 359-154 (.700) all-time in home games. Head coach Dawn Staley has amassed a 49-24 (.671) home record in her fifth season at the helm.

Figuring On February

South Carolina is 180-139 (.564) all-time in the month of February, including a 12-16 (.429) record under fifth-year head coach Dawn Staley. The Gamecocks are 102-39 (.723) in home games during the second month of the calendar year, including an 18-16 (.529) mark at Colonial Life Arena. South Carolina is 60-83 (.420) in February road games and 12-9 at neutral sites during the month.

Life in the League

South Carolina is 97-194 (.333) all-time in its 22nd season of SEC regular-season play. The Gamecocks are 62-84 (.425) in SEC games played in Columbia with a 35-110 record (.241) on the road. Under head coach Dawn Staley, the Gamecocks have a 33-37 (.471) SEC record, which includes a 2-12 slate in her first season at the helm. The program's 27 SEC regular-season victories in Staley's first four seasons are the best four-year mark for the program in more than a decade.

Last season's 10 wins matched the 2001-02 team for the best since joining the league for the 1991-92 season. It was just the third time in its 21 seasons in the league that South Carolina posted at least nine conference wins. In fact, the Gamecocks have only won seven or more league games six times in their 21 seasons with three of those coming under Staley.

Overall, Staley boasts a 132-62 (.680) record in league play, including eight seasons leading her Temple teams to a 99-25 (.798) Atlantic 10 mark.

Rendering the RPI

With an 18-3 record, including eight wins away from home, the Gamecocks are 11th in the NCAA RPI released on Jan. 28. South Carolina is one of six SEC schools rated among the top 30 with five others coming inside the top 100.

The Gamecocks' strength of schedule ranks in the top 20 and will continue to build over the course of the season. The Gamecocks are slated to play five teams currently ranked in the top 25 – then-No. 1/1 Stanford (Dec. 19), then-No. 12/13 Tennessee, at then-No. 13/12 Georgia (Jan. 13), home against then-No. 5/4 Kentucky (Jan. 24), on the road against No. 8/7 Kentucky and No. 16/16 Texas A&M.

Reading the Rankings

South Carolina is ranked in both national polls for the eighth-straight week. The Gamecocks moved up to No. 15 in the Associated Press Poll this week after cracking into that poll at No. 24 the week of Dec. 10. It is South Carolina's highest ranking since the week of Feb. 10, 2003, saw the Gamecocks in the No. 15 spot. South Carolina is in USA Today Coaches Poll for the 10th-straight week, rising to No. 13. Ieasia Walker, Sancheon White, Tiffany Mitchell, Ashley Bruner and Aleighsa Welch – account for 76.8 percent of the offense and 69.2 percent of rebounds while playing 72.7 percent of the minutes available. Each of the five averages at least 5.0 points, more than any Gamecock off the bench. Still, the four reserves available have out-scored their counterparts on the opposite bench 12 times this season, during which the Gamecocks are 11-1.

Front Runners

South Carolina has won each of the 16 games this season in which it has taken a lead into the locker room at halftime. In head coach Dawn Staley's fourth season at the helm, South Carolina is 74-13 after leading at halftime and 3-5 when tied at the game's midway point.

Locking It Down

South Carolina has held an opponent to 48 or fewer points 15 times this season, already exceeding last season's school record of 14. In program history, the Gamecocks have lost just one of the 127 games in which they held an opponent to 48 or fewer points – 40-42 at Georgia on Jan. 13, 2013.

Good Hands

South Carolina is ranked 30th in the country in turnovers, committing just 14.2 per game. The Gamecocks have committed 10 or fewer turnovers seven times this season, including a pair of seven-turnover games that rank among the top five in the Dawn Staley era. South Carolina has turned it over more than 15 times in a game just seven times, while the defense has forced more than 15 turnovers 14 times. The Gamecocks' 14.2 turnovers per game matches last season's mark as the lowest average by the program since the 1983-84 team set the school record of 8.2.

Demanding Defense

The hallmark of the Gamecocks under head coach Dawn Staley has always been defense, and this season's team is no different. South Carolina's defense ranks third in the nation in points allowed per game (47.3), trailing just Connecticut (46.6) and Green Bay (47.2). The Gamecocks have allowed just one opponent to score 60 or more points this season (Tennessee, Jan. 3) and have held 15 to 48 or fewer.

One of the more interesting facets of the Gamecocks' stifling defense is that it has not necessarily held opponents to a sub-par shooting percentage. Through Staley's tenure, opponents have shot 39.6 percent from

the field (3,142-7,925). The defensive success has come from limiting opponent shot attempts entirely, especially from the 3-point line. South Carolina has attempted more total shots than its opponents every season except Staley's first (2008-09). Opponents have attempted more 3s than the Gamecocks just once as well (2009-10).

As the difference in shot attempts has increased over the course of the Staley era, so has the team's win totals, culminating in last season's 25-10 record, the program's best in more than a decade, and this season's 18-3 start.

Going Glass

Looking at South Carolina's roster of seven guards and four forwards/centers, the casual observer might think that rebounding would not be the Gamecocks' bailiwick, but South Carolina out-rebounded its opponent in all but three games this season – at Arkansas (-7, Jan. 27), #5/4 Kentucky (-1, Jan. 24) and then #1/1 Stanford (-11, Dec. 19). The Gamecocks' effort includes four games of 20 or more rebounds than their opponent and seven others in which they out-boarded the opposition by at least 10. The team effort has the Gamecocks ranked 10th in the nation in rebound margin at +10.1.

While rebounding is a team focus, this season has seen a surge in individual performances. In 2011-12, a Gamecock posted double-figure rebounds just seven times over 35 games. Through 21 games this season, South Carolina has amassed 18 double-digit rebound efforts, including eight from sophomore forward Aleighsa Welch, who ranks fourth in the SEC in the category. Three Gamecocks rank among the SEC's top 20 rebounders – Aleighsa Welch (7th, 8.2), Ashley Bruner (10th, 7.3) and Tiffany Mitchell (16th, 6.3). South Carolina is especially adept on the offensive glass where Welch and Bruner rank first and eighth, respectively, in the SEC, and Mitchell is among the league's top 15 in conference games.

Walkin' on Sunshine

Senior guard Ieasia Walker has shown tremendous leadership in guiding this season's team that includes four newcomers among its nine active players to an 18-3 record. Walker showed patience through the non-conference season, stepping out of the spotlight to allow her younger teammates to find their way on offense while still providing dominant defense borne of quick hands and lightning fast reflexes.

In SEC play, however, Walker as re-asserted herself offensively raising her scoring average from 8.5 in non-conference play to 11.5 in SEC action. She ranks among the 30 top scorers in league games. Walker turned up the scoring while still contributing 2.4 assists and an SEC-best 3.0 steals per game in league play.

In evidence that she has spent her career as an all-around contributor, Walker joins Kentucky's A'dia Mathies and Georgia's Jasmine James as the only active SEC players to have amassed at least 1,000 points in combination with 200 career assists and 200 career steals. In South Carolina history, just 11 Gamecocks have reached all three plateaus. Only six of those have more career rebounds than Walker's 428, including two who played prior to the Gamecocks joining the SEC.

Movin' On Up

South Carolina seniors Ashley Bruner and Ieasia Walker have made the most of their time in the Garnet and Black, posting and heading toward significant milestones while moving up the all-time leaderboards in several categories.

Bruner made the first move by becoming just the 26th Gamecock to pull down at least 500 career rebounds, hitting the mark as part of her seven-rebound outing at Seton Hall (Dec. 2). Currently tied for 20th on the total rebounding list with 588, she needs just 19 more rebounds to join just 17 other Gamecocks to reach 600 career boards.

Walker joined the 1,000-point club 18 points into her 24-point performance against LSU (Jan. 17) at Carolina Coliseum. She is just the 28th Gamecock to reach the plateau and is one of just 12 in the group to pair the milestone with at least 200 career steals. Walker hit that mark with five swipes against Western Carolina (Dec. 29). She moved into the program's top 10 in that category on the same night she scored her 1,000th point, swiping five steals from the Lady Tigers to get to 216 and climb into sixth place in school history. Currently at 225, she needs two more to tie Cristina Ciocan (2000-04) in fifth place.

Oh Captain, My Captain

South Carolina's captains for this season are seniors Ieasia Walker and Ashley Bruner along with sophomore Aleighsa Welch.

Working Overtime

After its 58-55 win over Drexel, South Carolina is 16-14 all-time in overtime games, including a 1-3 mark in double-overtime contests. Since taking the reins for the 2008-09 season, Gamecock head coach Dawn Staley has amassed a 5-3 record in extended games. South Carolina played a school-record four overtime games in 2010-11, going 2-2, and in 1995-96, going 1-3.


