The Storyline... The Pioneers travel to Grand Bahama Island in the Bahamas for the Travelers Junaknoo Jam this weekend. Sacred Heart takes on Auburn in the first round of the tournament Friday at 12:00 pm. Depending on the outcome of that game SHU will face either Seton Hall or Boston College in the next round on Saturday. The Pioneers will play in the Lucaya Division of the tournament, the name of the city in which the teams are staying. There is a second section, called Freeport, that will also crown a champion but will have no impact on the Lucaya Division. In the opening matchup both the Pioneers and Tigers are looking to snap a small losing streak. Auburn is 1-3 and has lost three straight while SHU has dropped back-to-back contests since its opening night victory over Saint Peter's.

The Venues... Both of Sacred Heart's games at the Junkanoo Jam will be played at St. George's High School, a recently built gymnasium on the island. The facility can hold 1,200 people and will also share practice duties with the Grand Bahama YMCA.

Pioneer Sports Network... The Sacred Heart department of athletic communications has teamed up with Stretch Internet to broadcast the 2010-11 season on www.SacredHeartPioneers.com. All home games will feature video as well as audio coverage while most road games will be streamed live with audio only. This year two former SHU women's basketball alumni, Amanda Pape and Karen Bell, will join the broadcast team to provide color commentary. Play-by-play voices Jeff Holtz and Randy Brochu also return to the Pioneers Sports Network for another season to call all of the live action.

Scouting the Tigers... Auburn is 1-3 on the young season after finishing the 2009-10 campaign with a 15-16 record. The Tigers downed Mercer 79-61 to start the year but have lost three straight to Florida State, Duke, and South Florida. Auburn currently has two players averaging double figures in scoring this season. Jordan Greenleaf leads thd squad with 13.0 points per game while Blanche Alverson sits at 11.0 points per game. Greenleaf has also proved to be a force on the glass, averaging 9.3 boards. Opponents are currently shooting 44% from the floor and 37% from three agasint Auburn. The Tigers are also averaging nine steals and 3.5 blocks per game.

Scouting the Eagles... Boston College is a perfect 4-0 this year and has posted convincing wins over Boston University, Hartford, Dartmouth, and Vermont. The Eagles are outscoring its opponents by 26 points per game and have notched at least 84 points in every tilt this season. At least one Eagle has eclipsed 20 points in each game and has dominated the glass, out rebounding opponents by 16 boards per game. Carolyn Swords is off to a monster start in 2010-11, averaging 17.8 points and 13.5 rebounds per game. The senior center is shooting 70 percent from the floor and had 18 rebounds in the Eagles' season opener with Boston University. Boston College turns the ball over 19 times per contest but also grabs 15 steals. As a team BC has shot the ball at a 50 percent clip, 40 percent from three, so far this season.

Scouting the Pirates... Seton Hall is 3-2 entering the Junkanoo Jam having won its last two games before traveling to the Bahamas. The Pirates topped UMass 61-58 and Army 50-40 in the week leading up to the tournament. Kandice Green is averaging a double-double with 11.6 points and 10.6 rebounds per game in 2010-11. Jasmine Crew paces the squad overall in scoring with 12.4 and 2.2 assists per contest. Seton Hall is averaging 18.2 turnovers per game and only hands out 8.0 assists. The Pirates only have a scoring margin of .2 points this season and hold a rebounding edge of 1.8 boards per game. Seton Hall has not played a road game since its season opener at Florida Gulf Coast, a 64-57 loss.

Behind the Pioneer Bench... Ed Swanson (SHU '89) is in his 21st season as head coach at his alma mater. Swanson posts a 342-233 record in his career at Sacred Heart. His teams have a 216-114 record since joining the Division I ranks in 1999-00. Swanson was inducted in to the New England Basketball Hall of Fame in 2009 and is the program's longest tenured coach and all-time leader in coaching wins (342). He has been named the NEC Coach of the Year three times and is the all-time leader in regular season NEC wins (150).

Last Time Out... The SHU women's basketball team never recovered from an eight point deficit at halftime, suffering a 62-53 setback at the hands of the Hartford Hawks Monday night. Junior Callan Taylor (Overland Park, KS) grabbed seven offensive rebounds on her way to a double-double with 14 points and 10 boards. Hartford's Alex Hall dropped in a game high 18 points as SHU fell for the second straight game. Sacred Heart (1-2) used a 10-1 run in the late stages of regulation to cut the Hawk advantage to just seven at 53-46 with 3:12 to play. Alisa Apo (Freehold, NJ) buried a three and Morgan Merriman (Seattle, WA) finished a basket inside to pull the Pioneers back in the game late. Hall halted the SHU momentum with a lay-up followed by a long three from Daphne Elliott. Another 5-0 surge with less than two minutes on the clock proved to be the dagger for Sacred Heart. Maggie Cosgrove (Andover, MA) hit a pair of free throws to move the deficit back to single digits but SHU would not half enough time to close the gap before the final buzzer. Hartford (1-3) stormed out of the locker room after the intermission with a 16-6 run and moved the margin to 16 on a Mary Silvia jumper. In each of the next two possessions the Pioneers finished layups only to have Hartford respond with a basket of their own on their next trip up the floor. The Hawks came out on fire to start the game, sinking six-of-eight to start the game to build an early 16-6 cushion. The Pioneers did tally the opening bucket of the contest on a jump shot from Taylor. Hartford controlled the action inside and set the tempo by recording three blocks in the first eight minutes of play. SHU closed the first half strong with the last five points of the frame on a three ball from Cosgrove and a lay-in off the hand of Taylor. Cosgrove, the school's all-time leading three-point shooter, finished the game two-for-six behind the arc. As a team SHU shot 23.5% (4-for-17) from downtown compared to a 46% mark for Hartford. Freshman Ericka Norman (Chino Hills, CA) and Taylor each posted a team high four points in the first half. The Pioneers managed just eight-for-30 (27%) from the field in the opening twenty minutes. The Hawks shot at a 47% clip in the first stanza.

Taylor Leads the Way... Junior Callan Taylor leads the Pioneers averaging 16.7 points in the first three games of 2010-11. Taylor ranks second on the squad with 6.7 rebounds per game. In Sacred Heart's opening night win over Saint Peter's Taylor went a perfect nine-for-nine from the free throw line. She followed that performance by pacing the Pioneers in scoring each of the last two games. The Kansas native was a second-team All-NEC selection last season and ranked first in the league in rebounding, the first Pioneer to accomplish that feat.

First Half Struggles... The Pioneers have yet to hold a lead heading into the intermission in 2010-11. SHU has posted percentages of 33, 33, and 21 in the first half of games this season. Comparatively SHU has recorded shooting clips of 47%, 41%, and 38% in the final twenty minutes of regulation.

Apo Continues To Climb All-Time Lists... Senior captain Alisa Apo has posted 13 assists in the first three games of the season to reach 365 helpers in her career. In her six assist performance against Saint Peter's she passed Elaine Agosti for second all-time in SHU history. Apo needs just 30 more assists in 2010-11 to have the most assists in Pioneer history, a mark currently held by Kerri Burke's 394 assists. Apo also moved past Kim Filia for fourth in scoring all-time at SHU with her showing against Saint Joseph's. The senior guard now stands at 1,447 points in her career. Next in Apo's sights is her two year teammate Kaitlin Sowinski, who stands at 1,541 career points.

Merriman off the Bench... Despite not yet earning a nod in the starting five sophomore Morgan Merriman has played at least 26 minutes in every game this season. Merriman is averaging 8.7 points and 4.7 rebounds per game in 2010-11. She dropped in a career best 12 points last weekend against Saint Joseph's.

No Extra Time... Sacred Heart made its way through the entire 2009-10 schedule without playing a single overtime game. The Pioneers have not played an extra period of basketball in 63 straight contests dating back to November 22, 2008. In that game SHU lost a heart breaking 59-58 decision to cross-town rival Fairfield in the Arena at Harbor Yard. The Pioneers last played an overtime game at home back in a Northeast Conference semifinal on March 8, 2005 against Robert Morris. The Colonials earned a 68-62 victory in that contest to advance to the NEC championship game. Sacred Heart last won an overtime game February 26, 2004 in a 99-94 affair against Monmouth that needed double overtime to produce a winner.

Pioneers Ink Two NLI's For 2011-12... Gabrielle Washington (Mesa, AZ) and Katie Shepard (Lone Tree, CO) have signed a national letter of intent and will be Sacred Heart Pioneers in the fall of 2011. Washington, the 2008-09 Pima Region player of the year, has averaged over 20 points per game in her last two seasons. Last season she eclipsed the 1,000 point plateau en route to being named the East Valley Region player of the year. Shepard, a true point guard, averaged eight points and eight assists in her junior season at Chapparal high school. She is a two-time team captain and was a 2010 all-league selection.

Kiley Evans Named Choice Hotels/NEC Player of the Week...

Kiley Evans recorded her second career double-double with 17 points and 11 rebounds to take home the first Choice Hotels/NEC player of the week award of her career in the inaugural honor of the 2010-11 season. Evans went 6-for-10 from the floor including 2-of-3 from beyond the arc in the Pioneers 65-48 opening night victory over Saint Peter's. Her second three ball triggered a 17-4 SHU run that opened up a 48-37 second half lead for the Pioneers. The sophomore guard's 11 rebounds tied a career high set in her freshman year against Stony Brook. Evans point and rebound totals in her 37 minutes of action led all players on the floor. Evans is coming off of a solid freshmen campaign which saw her average 11.3 points per game en route to being named to the NEC All-Rookie squad.

Head Coach Ed Swanson - 21st Year, 342-234

Ed Swanson took the reins of the Sacred Heart University women's basketball program in 1990 and has built the Pioneers into one of the top teams in the Northeast Conference and throughout the Northeast. Swanson's career has seen the veteran coach eclipse the 300 career victories mark en route to a pair of NEC Championships as well as earning him the honor of being inducted into the New England Basketball Hall of Fame in 2009.

Beginning his 21st season on the Sacred Heart bench, Swanson has built the Pioneers into one of the top-teams year in and year out in the NEC. In the 2008-09 season he led SHU to a perfect run through the league and the program's second conference title in four years. The 2008-09 run for the Pioneers marked just the third perfect 18-0 mark in NEC history and earned Swanson his third NEC Coach of the Year award.

Over the past 15 seasons, the Pioneers have posted at least a .500 record or better under Swanson, a streak that has included five 20 win seasons. The magical run in '09-10 included a pair of coaching milestones as Swanson moved past former Mount St. Mary's head coach Bill Sheahan (124) in all-time Northeast Conference wins at 150 and counting while also eclipsing the 300 win plateau in career victories.

In their 11 years in the Northeast Conference, Swanson's Pioneers have never missed the playoffs and have never finished lower then third in the final league standings. He has guided Sacred Heart to a 216-115 record since joining the Division I ranks in 1999-00. After a 0-5 start to the 2008-09 season, Swanson's Pioneers got their season on track and finished the year with 25-8 record including 21-straight wins, a school record and mark that ranked second in the country. After a perfect run through the NEC schedule, the Pioneers finished off their amazing season by capturing their second league title and trip to the NCAA Tournament in the last four years.

The 2005-06 season was another fantastic run for Swanson and his program as the Pioneers made their first-ever NCAA Tournament appearance after capturing the NEC Championship in just their seventh season at the Division I level. Swanson led the Pioneers to a school record 26-5 record along with a then record mark of 16 NEC wins while he himself earned his 250th career victory. He has guided the Pioneers to five 20 win seasons including four in the last six years. Swanson's Pioneers enter this season riding a streak of nine-straight winning seasons and eight-straight seasons with at least 18.

Under his leadership, the Pioneers have become one of the toughest teams on their home court, the William H. Pitt Center. Since the opening of the Pitt Center in 1997, his Sacred Heart teams have won 82% (148-33) of their home games including a perfect 15-0 in 2005-06 and 14-0 in 2003-04. Between 2002 and 2004, the Pioneers put together a string of 19-straight regular season wins at home in the Pitt Center. Their .817 winning percentage at home ranks the Pitt Center nationally as one the toughest arenas for visiting teams to earn a win.

Since joining the Northeast Conference in 1999-00, the Pioneers have had a pair of Northeast Conference Player of the Year and three NEC Rookie of the Year award winners. In 2008-09 Alisa Apo became just the second player in conference history to win the league's top-player award after earning the rookie of the year award the previous season. SHU center Kaitlin Sowinski joined former Pioneer Amanda Pape with back-to-back All-NEC first team awards. Apo became a member of that club with her performance in 2009-10 claiming her another All-NEC first team selection. Pape, the program's all-time leading scorer, was named both the NEC's Player and Rookie of the Year while leading the Pioneers to their first-ever league title. Apo, Pape and Nicolle Rubino all earned Rookie of the Year honors

under Swanson's guidance.

Swanson has elevated the program to its current high state through a combination of shrewd recruiting, coaching acumen, fine assistant coaches and players who understand the team concept. The evidence is there for all to see. In the past 15 seasons, the Pioneers have assembled a 308-161 (.656) record, but they have been even more formidable against conference opponents during that span, with a 218-69 (.759) mark.

After directing the Pioneers to a 20-7 record — the program's first 20-win season — in 1995-96, Swanson was voted Coach of the Year in the New England Collegiate Conference (NECC) and the Women's Basketball Coaches Association's (WBCA) District I. He was runner-up for NEC Coach of the Year in 1999-2000, when Sacred Heart's inaugural Division I team produced a 14-14 record and tied for third (11-7) during the conference's regular season.

Basketball has always been an integral part of Swanson's life. From his days as a two-time captain at Kolbe Cathedral High School in Bridgeport, to the transition of elevating the Pioneers to the Division I level, to directing his two-week long NIKE Girls Basketball Camp at Sacred Heart each summer, Swanson has demonstrated a passion for the game exceeded by few.

He earned a bachelor's degree in business from Sacred Heart in 1989. He joined Dave Bike's men's coaching staff that year, and, after becoming head coach of the Pioneer women's program in 1990, did double duty for three seasons before becoming the University's first full-time women's coach in 1993.

Immediately prior to Swanson's arrival, the Sacred Heart women's team had a 4-21 record. Under his guidance, the climb to Division II respectability was accomplished within three seasons, from 8-19 to 11-16 and, in 1992-93, to 16-13 — the program's first winning record in 11 seasons.

A basketball aficionado the year round, Swanson spends a good portion of each summer coaching and lecturing at camps and attending AAU tournaments in several states, in addition to running his aforementioned NIKE Girls Basketball Camp.
