PREVIEW STORY

The University of Maine women's basketball team (8-23, 4-12 America East in 2011-12) open up the 2012-13 season as it takes part in the Sheraton Raleigh Wolfpack Invitational. The Black Bears will begin the regular season with a contest against Auburn of the SEC. Maine will then play either Wofford or NC State the following day.

The Black Bears return four letterwinners to their 2012-13 squad as junior forward Ashleigh Roberts (7.2 PPG, 3.9 RPG) is Maine's top returning scorer. Roberts is joined by senior forward Corinne Wellington (4.4, 3.7) and sophomores Courtney Anderson (4.7, 3.2) and Danielle Walczak (5.8, 4.7).

Last season the Black Bears finished at 8-23 overall and 4-12 in league play, doubling both their overall and conference victories from the season before. Maine also won its first postseason contest since 2006 as it defeated Stony Brook by a score of 49-43 in the opening round of the America East tournament.

Maine has a brand new look this season as it welcomes in nine new freshmen to this season's squad, including six newcomers from overseas. The Black Bears have a bit of an international feel this season as they welcome in freshmen from Serbia, Israel, Sweden, Finland, the United Kingdom and Germany.

Auburn is coming off a disappointing 2011-2012 season where the Tigers finished under .500 with a 13-17 overall record, good enough for 9th place in the Southeastern Conference standings. The Tigers fell in Florida 70-60 in the first round of the SEC tournament. Auburn does return seven letter-winners including three starters from last year's squad. Junior Tyrese Tanner was the team's leading scorer a year ago averaging 10.9 points per game, also returning are other top scorers sophomore Hasina Muhammad (9.5 ppg) and senior Blanche Alverson (9.1 ppg). The Tigers add five newcomers to their roster this year including four freshman and Julie King, a senior rookie that starred on the Auburn women's soccer team for past four years. The Tigers will be guided by first year Auburn head coach Terri Williams-Flournoy. Williams-Flournoy comes to Auburn after coaching the Georgetown Hoyas for the past 8 seasons compiling a career 143-104 record while leading the Hoyas to three consecutive NCAA tournament appearances from 2010-2012, including a sweet-sixteen appearance in 2011. The Tigers were selected 10th in the preseason SEC poll.

The Wolfpack is coming off a solid 2011-2012 campaign in which they posted at 19-16 record and reached the Atlantic Coast Conference Tournament semifinals before falling to Georgia Tech 87-61. En route to the ACC semifinals the Pack upset top seeded Duke and became the first 9th seeded team ever to beat the 1st seed in the ACC tournament. They also earned a birth to the WNIT, losing to Appalachian State in the second round 66-62. Under 4th year head coach Kellie Harper, NC State returns three starters from last year, including their lone senior and scoring leader from a year ago Marissa Kastanek who averaged 12.9 points per game and shot 37% from beyond the arc. They also return their assists leader in Myisha Goodwin-Coleman (3.8 assists per game). Also returning is junior Kody Burke who averaged a solid 10.5 points and 1.5 blocks per game last season. This year NC State is looking to get help from USC transfer Len'Nique Brown who sat out the entire 2011-2012 season due to NCAA transfer rules. The pack is a combined 53-47 (.530) since 2009 under Coach Harper, boasting five wins over ranked opponents. They made their last NCAA Tournament appearance in 2010. This year the Wolfpack were picked

to finish 8th in the ACC according to the preseason poll. The Wolfpack tipped off the season with an exhibition game versus North Greenville at Reynolds Coliseum on November 4th beating them 111-39 and holding the opponents starting lineup to just nine points. Eight different Wolfpack players scored in double figures lead by Burke with 22 points and double-double (10 points, 11 rebounds) from junior Markeisha Gatling.

Wofford returns four starters from its 2011-12 squad which finished at 13-18 overall and 5-15 in the Southern (SoCon) Conference. The Terriers lost just one letterwinner and return eight overall letterwinners while welcoming in five newcomers. Edgar I. Farmer Jr. is in his tenth year with the Terriers and carries a 68-167 record into this season. Wofford returns its top two scorers in seniors Morgan Wrightson and Daniella Motley. Wrightson averaged 12.6 points per game a year ago while pulling down 4.5 rebounds. Motley averaged 10.3 points and led the Terriers in rebounding at 7.9 boards per game. Fellow senior Rachel Brittenham gets the offense rolling as she led the team with 161 assists a year ago.

This will be the first ever meeting between Maine and Auburn. The Black Bears will also be facing Wofford for the first time in history if the two should meet on day two. If Maine faces NC State it will be the fourth overall meeting between the two teams who last met on March 13, 1998, a 89-64 win by the Wolfpack in the NCAA Tournament in Raleigh, N.C. The two teams have met two other times with the first meeting coming on Dec. 2, 1989, a game won 77-66 by NC State. Maine is currently 0-3 against the Wolfpack with its last win against an ACC team coming against Miami on Dec. 29, 2007 when the Black Bears defeated the Hurricanes 54-53. Should Maine defeat Auburn, it would be the first win over a team from the SEC since the Black Bears knocked off Alabama 75-73 on Jan. 5, 1995.

Second Half Surge Powers Women's Basketball Past New Brunswick in Exhibition

ORONO, Maine -- The University of Maine women's basketball team began the second half with a 26-0 run to distance itself from New Brunswick en route to a 71-46 exhibition win over the Varsity Reds on Thursday evening. Freshman Anna Heise (Halle, Germany) paced the Black Bear offense as she scored 18 points to go along with five rebounds.

The Black Bears built a six point spread six and half minutes into the first half after Lauren Bodine (Louisville, Ky.) stepped back and knocked down a jumper. However, Maine saw its lead vanish after a seven point Varsity Reds' run capped with a layup out of a timeout by Claire Colborne at the 9:29 mark.

The teams continued to trade hoops as the sixth tie of the first half came when Colborne knocked down a pair of free throws with 2:15 to play in the opening half. New Brunswick ended the half on a 6-0 run to take a 33-29 advantage into the half.

Heise led the Maine first half attack, scoring eight of her final 18 points in the opening half while adding three rebounds.

Maine wasted no time erasing the four-point halftime deficit as Bodine quickly found Heise inside for a layup before the freshman center worked her way back inside, drawing a foul and hitting the pair to tie the game at 33-33 just 58-seconds into the second half.

The Black Bears continued its second half opening run as back-to-back three point hoops from Bodine and Liz Wood (Catlett, Va.) ran the Maine lead up to 14, 3:14 into the half.

Maine kept the pressure on as Chantel Charles (London, U.K.) forced a couple key

turnovers to keep fueling the run. Heise capitalized with a pair of layups before a bucket from Mikaela Gustafsson (Sodertalje, Sweden) and a two free throws from Ashleigh Roberts (Wilmington, Del.) ballooned the Black Bears' lead to 22. Rachel Cleary put an end to the Black Bears' 26-0 run with a jumper after the Maine held New Brunswick scoreless for the opening 9:03 of the half.

The Black Bear lead dipped to 18 after a free throw from Samantha Kaminsky but Maine was quick to answer as Courtney Anderson (Greene, Maine) raced the ball down the court before kicking a pass out to Bodine who buried a three-pointer, jump starting a 7-0 run and extending Maine's lead to 66-41 with 3:19 to play.

Maine's lead reached 28 after Bodine found Sophie Weckström (Espoo, Finland) cutting to the hoop for a layup with just over two minutes remaining. New Brunswick hit a pair of shots down the stretch but it was too little too late as Maine wrapped up the contest with a 71-46 win.

It was a tale of two halves as Maine outscored the Varsity Reds 42-13 in the second half after forcing 26 New Brunswick turnovers and turning them into 23 second half points.

A GROUP OF 'YOUNG GUNS'

The 2012-13 Black Bears welcome in nine freshmen while returning just four letterwinners from a season ago. Maine has just seven years of total experience on its active roster while its nine newcomers are the most in the NCAA (San Jose State has eight newcomers). The nine freshmen are also the highest number of freshmen on a squad in the NCAA as the next closest is seven (7).

ALL AROUND THE MAP AND ENDING AT ORONO

The Black Bears have a bit of an international feel this season as six of its 14 players are from overseas. Maine welcomes freshmen in this season from Israel, Sweden, the United Kingdom, Germany, Serbia and Finland.

DOUBLING THE WINS...

In Coach Barron's first season at the helm of the Black Bears, the team doubled its overall and conference wins from the year before. Maine also won its first postseason game since 2006 as it downed Stony Brook in the opening round of the America East Championships.

WALCZAK HONORED BY AMERICA EAST IN 2012

Danielle Walczak led Maine's rookie's in scoring at 5.6 points per game while also leading all Maine rookies in rebounding with 4.6. Walczak picked up her game in league play, averaging 7.4 points and 5.5 rebounds against America East opponents. As a freshman, this forward ranked 17th in the league in rebounding and 14th in offensive rebounding. Walczak ended the regular season as the second-highest rookie rebounder in the league. Her 7.4 points per game in league action was good for 30th overall while she finished tied for 15th in conference only rebounding at 5.5 per game. On the defensive end, Walczak ranked 12th in conference games in blocks (0.6).

WELCOME COACH STEELMAN

The only change to the Black Bears coaching staff is the addition of Associate Head Coach Todd Steelman to this year's crew. Steelman joins Maine with over 19 years of teaching and coaching experience, with his most recent job coming as the associate head coach at Ball State from 2010-12. Prior to joining Maine, Steelman had 10 years of associate head coaching experience.

AMERICA EAST PRESEASON POLL

Maine was selected to finish seventh in this season America East Preseason Coaches Poll, a year after finishing eighth. Defending America East Champion Albany was selected as the preseason favorite as the Great Danes received 61 total votes and five first-place tallies. Last season's regular season champion Boston University Terriers were selected to finish second with 56 votes and a pair of first place votes. Hartford also received two first place votes and a total of 54 points as the Hawks

Richard Barron begins his second year with the Black Bears, and his 13th overall season as a head coach. With a year under his belt at Maine, Coach Barron has already made significant steps forward with the Black Bear women's basketball program. In his first year as a Black Bear, Coach Barron doubled Maine's overall and conference wins from a season ago while leading the team to its first postseason victory since 2006. Along the way, Coach Barron helped a pair of players to All-Conference honors as Samantha Baranowski was named to the All-America East Third Team and rookie Danielle Walczak was honored to the America East All-Rookie squad.

Following the 2011-12 season, Coach Barron proved to Black Bear nation why he is known for his fantastic recruiting. Coach Barron, along with his staff, introduced a nine-member 2012-13 signing class to the University of Maine, which received national attention as the class was ranked 36th best in the nation by Blue Star Basketball's National Scouting director Chris Menig.

Off the court, Coach Barron made sure the Black Bears were involved in a variety of activities within the community in terms of public service, fundraising efforts and charity events with the most memorable moment off the court coming when the Black Bears and Coach Barron teamed up to raise over \$10,000 for the Play4Kay Breast Cancer Foundation.

The University of Maine introduced Richard Barron as its new women's basketball coach on Tuesday, May 10, 2011 in a press conference at "The Pit" in Memorial Gymnasium.

"Coach Barron brings a remarkable combination of experience, vision and energy to the University of Maine," says Director of Athletics Steve Abbott. "He exemplifies all the characteristics we were looking for in a head coach, particularly a track record of success at top-quality academic institutions competing at the Division I level."

Barron comes to the University of Maine after a two-year stint at North Carolina State where he served as an assistant coach under Kellie Harper. In Barron's first year with the Wolfpack, the Tennessee native helped guide the team to the NCAA Tournament with a 20-14 record. A team that was predicted to finish ninth in the preseason, ended up finishing tied for fifth in the ACC standings while making it to the 2010 ACC Tournament Finals.

Barron is well renowned for his fantastic recruiting as he spent two seasons at Baylor prior to his time at NC State as the associate head coach and recruiting coordinator with the Bears.

During his time at Baylor, Barron was responsible for landing the consensus top-ranked player (Brittney Griner) and the top ranked recruiting class of 2009 while also assisting in coaching the Bears to the Big XII Tournament Championship.

Baylor compiled a 54-13 record to go along with two trips to the NCAA tournament, including a run to the Sweet 16 in 2008-09; in the two seasons Barron was with the Bears' staff.

Barron began his Division I head coaching career at Princeton as he spent six seasons at the helm of the Tigers' program. After taking over the program fresh off a 2-25 season prior to his arrival, Barron guided the Tigers to an 11-16 record in his first season, making Princeton one of the most improved teams in the country that year. During his six years at Princeton, Barron managed the Tigers to an Ivy League title in 2005-06, setting a school record for overall wins (21-7) and conference wins (12-2). Barron mentored five different players to All-Ivy League honors while at Princeton.

Prior to his time at Princeton, Barron spent five seasons at the University of the South in Sewanee, Tenn, compiling a 77-48 record during his tenure. In his final season at the University of the South, Barron guided the squad to its first ever conference championship and a No. 8 national ranking in Division III.

Prior to his time coaching the Sewanee women, Barron was the assistant men's coach at Sewanee for four years. Barron comes to the University of Maine with an 11-year head coaching career record of 152-139.

In the summer of 2006, Barron looked to expand his coaching knowledge as he traveled to Treviso, Italy with the NBA's Phoenix Suns to observe and study under current New York Knicks head coach Mike D'Antoni. In 1998, Barron was one of just three collegiate coaches selected to serve as a floor coach at the American Basketball League's combine. He also served as the Ivy League Representative for the Women's Basketball Coaches Association from 2003-06.

Barron, who grew up in both Florida and Tennessee, graduated from Kenyon College with a B.S. in biology. He graduated cum laude after being named to the dean's list all eight semesters. Barron played both basketball and baseball while at Kenyon.

Barron and his wife, Maureen, a former Princeton softball coach, are the proud parents of nine-year-old twin daughters, Lane and Rae, and a six-year-old son, Billy.

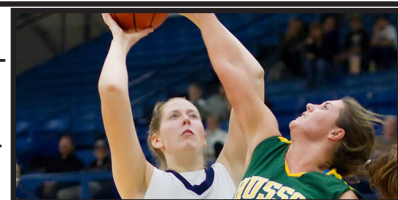
