Nikki Caldwell

HEAD COACH • SECOND SEASON AT LSU, FIFTH SEASON OVERALL

Nikki Caldwell, who won national championships as both a player and an assistant coach at Tennessee and turned UCLA into a national power in just three years, has quickly brought LSU women's basketball back to national prominence.

Caldwell revived the LSU program from her opening press conference. A summer full of speaking engagements, building the fan base and connecting with her players led to a season where attendance increased by an average of over 1,500 fans from the previous season. LSU also signed a top-20 recruiting class as ranked by ESPN HoopGurlz.com.

After missing the NCAA Tournament for the first time in 13 years a season prior to her arrival, Caldwell spearheaded the squad to the 2012 NCAA Tournament second round and its first appearance in the Southeastern Conference Tournament championship game since 2008. The Lady Tigers reached 23 wins – their highest total since the 2008 Final Four season – won 10 conference games for the first time since 2009 and claimed wins over five ranked teams during the season.

Well respected in coaching circles, Caldwell was then selected by the USA Women's Basketball Committee to serve as an assistant coach for the USA U18 National Team in the summer of 2012. She became the first coach in LSU history to serve on a USA U18 team staff since the squad's inception in 1988. Caldwell and the Americans celebrated on the international stage as the USA U18 team cruised to a 5-0 record and beat Brazil to win the 2012 FIBA Americas Championship gold medal in Puerto Rico.

Caldwell has been a part of a championship and winning pedigree at every level of her career. She played, coached and studied under one of the game's greatest

figures, the legendary Pat Summitt at Tennessee and she assisted Women's Basketball Hall of Famer Debbie Ryan at Virginia.

Widely recognized as one of the nation's top assistant coaches during stints at Tennessee and Virginia, Caldwell took over at UCLA in 2008. In three years with the Bruins, she turned around a UCLA program that had won only one NCAA Tournament game in the nine years prior to her arrival.

Caldwell led the Bruins to a 72-26 (.735) overall mark, reached the NCAA Tournament twice and finished second in the Pac-10 Conference in both 2010 and 2011. She was named the Pac-10 Coach of the Year in 2010 after going 25-9 overall and advancing to the second round of the NCAA Tournament.

Caldwell broke into the head coaching ranks after serving as an assistant on the staff of legendary women's coach Pat Summitt at Tennessee from 2002-08. During that time, she helped the Lady Vols capture a pair of NCAA titles in 2007 and 2008 and reach the Final Four a total of five times. The Lady Vols compiled an impressive 195-24 mark and won three Southeastern Conference regular season titles during her six years as an assistant coach.

Off the court, Caldwell is a passionate crusader for breast cancer awareness. She and Tennessee head coach Holly Warlick have founded the non-profit organization, Champions for a Cause. Since 2007, they have raised over \$300,000 through Cruisin' for a Cause, a long-haul motorcycle adventure to raise dollars and awareness for a cure for breast cancer. Caldwell has been prominent in the Baton Rouge community since her arrival, making appearances at the Baton Rouge Food Bank and schools in the East Baton Rouge Parish system.

NOTEBOOK

Last Time Out: #5/4 Kentucky 73, LSU 60 • Jan. 27 in Lexington

Fourth-ranked Kentucky made all the plays down the stretch and converted its free throws in the final two minutes as the Wildcats handed LSU its fifth straight road loss by a score of 73-60 on Sunday in Memorial Coliseum. The Lady Tigers were out-scored 27-6 on bench points and couldn't make a crucial shot or get stop in the final minutes after cutting the deficit to two possessions with 1:57 to play. LSU's **Theresa Plaisance** led all scorers with a game-high 19 points, marking her 19th consecutive double-figure scoring game. **Adrienne Webb** fired in 18 points, while **Danielle Ballard** matched a career-high with 10 rebounds. The Lady Tigers did a good job weathering Kentucky's press early and trailing only 31-26 at the break. Webb and Ballard ignited an 8-1 run and pulled LSU to within a point after the first official timeout of the second half. Webb had four straight during the spurt and Ballard climbed on the offensive glass. Her two free throws cut the deficit to 37-36 with 14:35 to play. Webb hit a wide-open three from the left corner that put the Lady Tigers within striking distance, 64-60, with 1:57 left in the game. LSU was unable to get a stop after that. Samarie Walker crashed the boards for a tip-in. She was later called for a technical foul, but Webb missed both free shots. The Lady Tigers trailed 67-60 in the final minute and Kentucky sealed the game at the free throw line.

Offensive Explosion

This season, LSU is averaging 70.9 points per game, which ranks fifth in the SEC and 36th in the nation. In addition, the Lady Tigers are one of the nation's top 25 best field goal percentage teams, connecting for 43.6 percent, which is fourth in the SEC. LSU's scoring offense is nearly 10 points better than it was a year ago as the Lady Tigers posted 62.2 points per game in 2011-12. The current scoring offense is LSU's highest production since putting up 74.1 points per game during the 2004-05 season.

Getting To The Free Throw Line

Dating back to last year's SEC Tournament run, LSU has done a tremendous job of getting to the free throw line. Since the 2012 SEC Tournament semifinal game against Kentucky where the Lady Tigers set a school record of 34 makes, LSU has attempted at least 20 free throws in 15 of its last 24 contests, including 13 of 20 games this season.

- LSU tied the school record of 34 makes on Dec. 21, by burying 34-of-47 from the line in a Dec. 21 comeback win over McNeese State. The top two highest made free throw games have now occurred in the **Nikki Caldwell** era. The 47 attempts against McNeese ranked second in LSU single-game annals and the most since the Lady Tigers attempted 50 on Feb. 5, 1996 against UL-Lafayette.
- Six times this year, the Lady Tigers have accounted for at least 20 free throw makes and

SERIES HISTORY: AUBURN LEADS 29-17, 13-7 IN AUBURN

Auburn leads the all-time series with LSU, 29-17, but the Lady Tigers have won the last two meetings in the past two seasons. Neither team has been able to reach the 60-point mark in the last two meetings. Auburn owns a 13-7 record on LSU in Auburn. This will be the Lady Tigers' second appearance in Auburn Arena. LSU lost its only game there by a score of 75-51 in 2010. That was LSU's last appearance in Auburn. Here is a look at the recent meetings:

LSU is 5-1 in those contests -- Wichita State (W), Hampton (L), West Virginia (W), McNeese State (L), Ole Miss (W).

- LSU has made (317) and attempted (459) more free throws than any team in the SEC this season. The percentage of 69.1 overall ranks seventh in the conference. Ole Miss (317) is the next closest to LSU in made free throws.
- LSU is one of only two teams in the SEC this season to make at least 30 free throws in a game, doing so in the record-tying 34 makes against McNeese State on Dec. 21.
- **Theresa Plaisance** has made (92) and attempted (124) more free throws than any player in the SEC this season. Plaisance's 74.2 percent from the line ranks sixth in the SEC. It marks the second straight year that LSU has produced the SEC's leader in free throw makes and attempts as LaSondra Barrett did so last year in **Nikki Caldwell's** first season.
- **Theresa Plaisance** recorded the third-most made free throws (13) and third-most free throw attempts (19) in LSU single-game history against McNeese State on Dec. 21. Both registered as the highest such marks by an SEC player in any game this season.

Danielle Ballard, One of the Nation's Top Freshmen

Freshman guard **Danielle Ballard** arrived at LSU with an impressive set of credentials as a top 25 high school player. Through 20 games, she has lived up to the billing as the Memphis native has three times been named SEC Freshman of the Week, doing so on Nov. 26, Dec. 24 and most recently on Jan. 7.

- Ballard is second among all SEC freshmen in scoring with 13.1 points per game, which also ranks 13th overall in the conference. Her 43.6 percent shooting from the floor is second on the team and is eighth overall in the SEC.
- Ballard is already one of the most prolific perimeter defenders in school history, tied for the SEC lead in steals per game with 3.0. She has already accumulated 60 steals, which is the most by an LSU player in a season since Allison Hightower recorded 63 during the entire 2010-11 season. The 3.0 steal per game average leads all freshmen in LSU history, surpassing the mark of Joyce Walker (1980-81) with 2.9.
- Ballard carried LSU to its highest win over a non-conference ranked opponent since 2010 with a career-best 25 points in a 71-63 win over No. 12 West Virginia in the FIU Thanksgiving Classic on Nov. 25. The 25 points were the most by an LSU true freshman in a game since LaSondra Barrett had 27 at Arkansas on Jan. 8, 2009. Ballard scored the final 10 points of the first half for LSU against West Virginia. She earned a spot on the FIU Classic all-tournament team after averaging 19.0 points in LSU's two games as the Lady Tigers won the tournament. She collected a clutch steal in the final minutes of the FIU game to help preserve the victory.
- On Dec. 19, Ballard tied Joyce Walker's LSU freshmen record with seven steals to go along with a game-high 21 points against Grambling. Ballard's steals tied for fifth overall in LSU single-game annals. Walker collected seven steals against Southeastern Louisiana on Feb. 12, 1981 during her freshman campaign.
- Ballard produced back-to-back 21-point games against Grambling and McNeese State, representing the first time an LSU freshman has done that since SEC Freshman of the Year Seimone Augustus did it in the 2003 SEC Tournament. Augustus had 22 points against Arkansas in the SEC quarterfinals on March 6, 2003 and followed that up with 20 points against Vanderbilt in the SEC semifinals on March 7, 2003.
- In SEC games, Ballard is fifth in the conference with 2.4 steals per game. With her three steals at Kentucky, she tied Roberta LaCaze to enter the LSU freshman steals top five with

"A & W" Webb Gem

LSU's leadership this season relies heavily on guard **Adrienne Webb**, one of only two seniors on the team. Webb, a native of Madison, Ala., is a Coaches Preseason All-SEC Second-Team selection. She is currently second on the team in scoring and ninth in the SEC with 13.6 points per game.

- Webb has produced four 20-plus point performances in her career, none bigger than her career-high 28 points in a blowout win over Mississippi State on Jan. 13. Webb fired in 9-of-14 from the floor -- one field goal shy of a career high -- while burying a season-best 4-of-6 from three-point land. She also tied a career-high with a perfect 6-of-6 at the free throw line.
- Webb credited her 28-point outing to getting up over 400 shots in the two previous practices leading up to the Mississippi State game. The 28 points tied for the highest scoring output by an LSU player this season and the highest in SEC play since Allison Hightower had 29 points at Auburn on Feb. 14, 2010. The 28-point performance was also the second-highest by any player in the SEC in a league game this season.
- Webb has produced 66 double-figure scoring games for her career, including 17 of the 20 games she has played in this season. Webb missed the East Tennessee State game on Dec. 13 after suffering a head injury against Tulane a game prior on Dec. 9.
- Webb is in sixth place in LSU career made threes with 146 and sixth in threes attempted with 436. She's seven made treys away from entering the top five.
- Webb became the 30th player in LSU history to eclipse 1,000 points in a career with 19 in the win over Grambling on Dec. 19. She became the first LSU player to do so since LaSondra Barrett on Jan. 27, 2011 against Arkansas. Webb has recorded 1,146 career points, which currently ranks 23rd in LSU history.
- Webb has been on fire in SEC play, posting four straight double-figure scoring games

and combining for 70 points in her last four games (17.5 ppg). Webb has reached double-figures in six out of seven SEC games.

Theresa Plaisance Shines In First Year As A Starter

Junior forward **Theresa Plaisance** is making the most of her opportunities this season. Through 20 games, Plaisance is averaging a team-high 18.3 points and 8.0 rebounds per game. She ranks first in the SEC in scoring and she is tops in blocks per game (2.8 bpg). She is also ninth in the conference in rebounding and sixth in the league in field goal percentage (46.3).

- Plaisance has produced an SEC-leading eight 20-plus point games this season, representing the most by an LSU player since Allison Hightower had 11 during the entire 2009-10 season.
- The New Orleans native owns four double-doubles this season: at Hampton (18 points, 11 rebounds); vs. Tulane (24 pts, 11 reb.); vs. McNeese State (21 pts, 14 reb.); vs. New Orleans (25 pts, 11 reb.). The four double-doubles are the most by an LSU player in a season since LaSondra Barrett had eight last season.
- Plaisance grabbed a career-best 15 rebounds, including 12 on the offensive end, in the season-opening win against Wichita State. The 15 rebounds were the most by an LSU player since Kristen Morris had 16 against Green Bay in the first round of the 2009 NCAA Tournament on March 22, 2009. It was the first time an LSU player had double-digit offensive rebounds since Sylvia Fowles collected 10 vs. Auburn on Jan. 28, 2007.
- Against NC State on Dec. 2, Plaisance notched a career-best 28 points on 11-of-17 shooting. The 28 points were the most by an LSU player since Allison Hightower scored 29 at Auburn on Feb. 14, 2010. Plaisance had 21 points in the first half against the Wolfpack, representing the first 20-point half by an LSU player since **Adrienne Webb** had 21 at Ole Miss on Feb. 6, 2011.
- Plaisance nearly had a triple-double against Tulane on Dec. 9. She scored 24 points, grabbed 11 rebounds and blocked a career-high eight shots. The eight blocks tied for the second-most in school history and the most by an LSU player since Dee Dee Franklin had eight blocks against Purdue on March 19, 1989. The eight were also one shy of the school record set by Cheri Graham against Nicholls State on Dec. 2, 1982.
- Plaisance owns the SEC's two highest block performances this season with eight in that Tulane game and seven at Florida International on Nov. 25.
- For the season, she has 56 total blocks, which ranks 12th nationally. The 56 blocks are already the most by an LSU player in a season since Sylvia Fowles had 69 in 35 games during the 2007-08 Final Four year. It's also ninth in LSU single-season annals.
- Plaisance's 2.8 block per game total is on pace for the highest bpg tally by an LSU player since a school record 3.9 by Heidi Olsen during the 1982-83 season.

- Plaisance had the highest output of her career in an SEC game with 26 points in a comeback win over Vanderbilt on Jan. 20. She scored 21 points in the second half. During a 13-0 run that turn the game around, she had seven points. She also scored nine straight points for LSU at one point. Plaisance tied a career high with 11 field goals in the game. It represented the most field goals by an LSU player in an SEC game since Allison Hightower converted 11 at Auburn on Feb. 14, 2010.
- Plaisance has scored in double-figures in 19 consecutive games (every game except the season-opener). It is the longest stretch by an LSU player since Sylvia Fowles did it in 26 straight games during her junior season from Nov. 2006-March 2007.
- The last time LSU had a player finish as the SEC's scoring champion was Seimone Augustus when she finished the 2005-06 season with 22.7 points per game.
- In SEC play, Plaisance is putting up 17.7 points per contest, which ranks fourth in the league. She has also swatted 14 shots in SEC play, which ranks third in the conference.

Jeanne Kenney 2nd in SEC in Assist/Turnover Ratio in SEC Games

It's no secret that junior guard **Jeanne Kenney** is LSU's most vocal player. Her leadership on the floor has been a big reason why the Lady Tigers' offense is the team's best in years. Kenney has dished out a team-high 86 assists for a 4.5 assist per game average, which ranks eighth in the SEC. The Baton Rouge native is also fourth in the league in assist/turnover ratio (2.2, 86 assists, 40 turnovers). In SEC play, Kenney's numbers improve 5.0 assists per game, which is fifth in the SEC. Kenney is second in the SEC in assist to turnover ratio in SEC games with a 3.0 ratio. She has accounted for 30 assists and only 10 turnovers in LSU's seven SEC games. With her four assists against Vanderbilt on Jan. 20, Kenney eclipsed the 200 assist mark for her career. She heads into the Auburn game as LSU's active leader in career assists with 206. Kenney also has a knack for taking charges on the defensive end. She leads LSU in that category too.

809 Wins and Counting ...

Nov. 25, 2012 became a monumental day in LSU Lady Tiger history as the program claimed its 800th all-time victory in a 76-69 win at Florida International. The Lady Tigers became the fourth team in SEC history to register 800 victories, and they became the third-quickest team in league history to do so. LSU owns an 809-373 (.682) all-time record since the first season of 1975-76 (38 years). Legendary coach Sue Gunter accounted for 442 of those victories. LSU Signs Two Highly-Touted Prospects During Early Signing Period

Raigyne Moncrief, a 5-foot-10 guard from Fort Lauderdale, Fla., and Jasmine Rhodes, a 5-foot-10 wing player from Mobile, Ala., will join the LSU Lady Tigers for the 2013-14 season. The two signed with LSU on Wednesday, Nov. 14 as the NCAA early signing period began. Moncrief is ranked the No. 18 overall player in America by ESPN Hoop Gurlz, and she is the highest ranked guard signee for LSU since Allison Hightower, who was tabbed as the No. 6 player in the Class of 2006. A five-star guard and excellent defender, Moncrief hails from American Heritage High School in Florida, the same school that produced current LSU senior **Bianca Lutley**. Moncrief was selected first team All-Broward County in her sophomore and junior seasons. She is considered to be the No. 6 ranked guard in the country by ESPN Hoop Gurlz. Moncrief was on hand to watch LSU win the FIU Classic in Miami over Thanksgiving. Rhodes will come to LSU as one of the top prospects in the state of Alabama and one of the top-15 wing players in the country as rated by ESPN Hoop Gurlz.

Nikki Caldwell Named USA Basketball U19 Assistant Coach

Nikki Caldwell will once again represent the red, white, and blue as she has been selected to serve as an assistant coach for the 2013 USA Basketball U19 World Championship team that will compete in Lithuania this summer, it was announced by USA Basketball on Tuesday. Caldwell will reunite with head coach Katie Meyer of Miami and Gonzaga's Kelly Graves. The three of them led the Americans to a gold medal at the FIBA Americas U18 Championship last summer. All three were elected by the USA Basketball Junior National Team Committee and approved by the USA Basketball Board of Directors. The USA U19 squad will compete in the 2013 FIBA U19 World Championship, hosted by Lithuania from July 18-28 in Klaipeda and Panevėžys. Trials to select the 12-member USA squad will be held May 16-19 at the U.S. Olympic Training Center in Colorado Springs, Colo. The team will regroup for training on July 1 at the USOTC prior to traveling to Lithuania for the competition. The USA U19 team will be going for a fifth straight gold medal. Caldwell and the Americans went 5-0 and beat Brazil to win the 2012 FIBA Americas Championship in Puerto Rico. She will become the first LSU coach to serve on a USA U19 staff.
