TODAY

The Blue Devils (6-4) face Auburn (6-4) in the third place game of the New York Life Holiday Invitational hosted by Hofstra. Central and Auburn have never faced each other in women's basketball. The Blue Devils have never played a school from the Southeastern Conference.

HOFSTRA

The Blue Devils dropped a close game against the host Pride on Wednesday (12/21). The Blue Devils closed to within four points late in the game on a three point field goal by sophomore Jessica Babe. Junior Jaclyn Babe scored a gamehigh 20 points and freshman Kaley Watras delivered a career-high 12 points as the Blue Devils fell, 67-60.

AT JAMES MADISON

The Blue Devils nearly upset James Madison on Sunday afternoon (12/18). Central went on the road to Harrisonburg and cut the Dukes' lead to a single basket with minutes remaining in the game, but JMU pulled away for a 71-64 victory. Central's Kirsten Daamen led all scorers with 23 points.

DAAMEN'S CAREER-HIGH

Junior center Kirsten Daamen delivered a career-high 23 points in Sunday's (12/18) loss to James Madison. Daamen led all scorers in the game and it was her fifth time leading the Blue Devils in points this season. Her previous career-high of 20 points was set earlier this season against UMass (11/16).

SERIES HISTORY - AGAINST THE FIELD

HOFSTRA - Series Record 6-4 Hofstra - Last Meeting: 2006-07, Hofstra 65-49

Central trails Hofstra 6-4 in the all-time series between these teams. The Blue Devils won the first three Division I games between these programs, but have gone 1-6 since the 1991-92 season. The first game between these teams produced one of the largest victories in CCSU women's basketball history. The Blue Devils defeated Hofstra by thrity points, 86-56, during the 1989-90 season.

MARIST - Series Record: 2-2 - Last Meeting: 1989-90, Marist 62-53

The Blue Devils have not seen the Red Foxes on the basketball court since the 1989-90 season. Central played Marist in its first four seasons of Division I play, the teams have not met since. The Blue Devils won the first meeting 67-49 in only their second Division I contest. Marist captured the next match-up 64-55 and the final game 62-53. The Blue Devils claimed the 1988-89 game by a score of 79-67.

AUBURN - Series Record: 0-0 - Last Meeting: N/A

The Blue Devils and Tigers have never faced each other in women's basketball. This would be Central's first women's basketball game against a team from the SEC.

SIENA VICTORY

Last Saturday (12/10) the Blue Devils defeated Siena 51-47 in Detrick Gym. Junior Kirsten Daamen led the way with a 15-point, 10-rebound double-double. On defense, she tied a CCSU single-game record with seven blocks. Junior Jaclyn Babe and sophomore Lauren Arbogast also scored in double-digits.

SEVEN BLOCK GAME

Junior Kirsten Daamen's seven block game against Siena was the second in the Division 1 history of the CCSU women's basketball program. Justina Udenze was the last Blue Devil to acomplish the feat, with seven blocks at Mount St. Mary's on December 6, 2008. Daamen and Udenze are the only Central Connecticut women's baskteball players to block more than five shots in a single-game. Daamen is the only player to post multiple 6+ block games with three, including two last week.

AMONG THE BEST

Junior Kirsten Daamen blocked 13 shots in only two games last week against URI (12/7) and Siena (12/10). The pair of performances increased her career total for blocks to 95 and places her third all-time at CCSU. This season she has recorded 25 blocks in eight games, good for a 3.1 per game average. Her mark is tied for 10th in the nation as of the December 13, NCAA stats release.

BLOCKING URI

The Blue Devils defeated Rhode Island on Wednesday night (12/7) behind a solid team defensive effort. Sophomore Jessica Babe led the way with six steals on the perimeter and junior Kirsten Daamen blocked six shots in the paint, but it was sophomore Jaleen Thomas who had the biggest defensive play of the night. Down 48-45, with six seconds to play, Rhode Island set up for a final shot, but Thomas stepped out to the perimeter, blocked the shot, grabbed the loose ball and was fouled securing the victory for Central. Thomas finished off the game by hitting both of her free throws, making the score 50-45.

NEC OPENER

Sophomore Jessica Babe posted her second straight double-double in the loss to Sacred Heart on Saturday (12/3). Babe set a career-high with 13 rebounds, she added 12 points to pick up the double-double. Junior Kristen Daamen was the leading scorer for Central, she had 14 points. The loss drops the Blue Devils to 0-1 in NEC play, but Central is still 13-3 at home over the last two years.

TRIPLE-DOUBLE

Sophomore Jessica Babe posted a near triple-double in the Blue Devils win over Holy Cross on Wednesday night (11/30). Babe scored 13 points and grabbed 12 rebounds in posting her first double-double of the season, but her

nine assists fell just one shy of the rare triple-double. Since begining Division I play with the 1986-87 season the women's basketball program has never had a player post a triple-double.

SCORING

Junior Jaclyn Babe dropped in a season and career-high 24 points in the victory over Holy Cross on Wednesday night (11/30). With her team trailing 29-27 with 18:20 left in the game, Babe scored 13 straight points to put the game away. Her 24 points are the most in a game since Justina Udenze scored 29 at Bryant on Feb. 12, 2011. Babe's back-to-back 20+ point games are the first since Kerrianne Dugan scored 21 against Colgate (12/31/08) and 22 at Long Wood (1/2/09). The last Central player to score 20 or more points in three striaght games was Gabriella Guegbelet who scored 20, 23, 21, 26, and 20 over a five game stretch late in the 2006-07 season. Guegbelet had at least 20 points in 17 of 29 games that season.

OFFENSIVE DISPLAY

The Blue Devils scored 83 points on Sunday (11/27). That mark tied for the highest total since Coach Beryl Piper took over the program in the Fall of 2007. The last time the Blue Devils scored more than 83 points was an 85-point showing against Monmouth during the 2000-01 season. The Blue Devils have now scored 80+ points 32 times since moving to Division I before the 1986-87 season. Here is a look at the top point totals for Central:

THE BABE SISTERS

Junior Jaclyn Babe and her sophomore sister Jessica anchored the Blue Devil perimeter in Sunday's (11/27) victory. Jaclyn scored a game-high 22 points and Jessica posted a game-high nine assists. Jessica also grabbed game-highs with seven rebounds and five steals. Not to be out done, Jaclyn finished with four rebounds, four assists, and two steals.

UNDER THE HOOP

Junior center Kirsten Daamen helped the Blue Devils outscore New Hampshire 44-18 in the paint. Daamen, single handedly matched the Wildcats point total in the paint with 18 points. She also grabbed five rebounds and

blocked a pair of shots in the game.

DVERTIME WIN AT UMASS

The Blue Devils went on the road and knocked off Atlantic-10 member Massachusetts on November 16. The Blue Devils were led by a career-high 20 points from senior Kirsten Daamen and 12 points each from the Babe sisters. The Blue Devils captured the 58-55 overtime victory, by holding the Minutewomen scoreless in the extra period.

DAAMEN'S 20

Junior center Kirsten Daamen dominated under the basket against UMass on 11/16. She posted a career-high 20 points to go along with five rebounds and a pair of blocks in 36 minutes on the floor. Daamen scored 12 of her 20 points in the second half and overtime, including the game winning basket. For the season she is averaging a team best 14.5 points per game.

THE BABE SISTERS MATCHING TOTALS

Junior Jaclyn Babe followed up her opening night 16 point performance with 12 points in the win over UMass on 11/16. Sophomore Jessica Babe, seeing her first action of the season, also contributed 12 points in Wednesday's victory. For the season, Jaclyn is averaging 14 points per game.

SEASON OPENERS

The Blue Devils have opened the last two seasons with home victories over teams from the America East Conference. Central's 53-48 victory over Maine (11/11), followed a 46-41 victory over Hartford to open the 2010-11 season. Central's season opening win a year ago sparked a program record 5-0 start to the season. Last year the Blue Devils played a pair of home games before five road games to start the season. This year the Blue Devils opened at home and now play a pair of road games before a five game home stand.

STARTING HOT

Junior Jaclyn Babe had not played a college basketball game since March of 2010, but she had no signs of rust in the Blue Devils' opener. The 5-8 guard delivered a team-high 16 points in the 53-48 victory over Maine. During the second half Babe scored 10 of her team's 26 points as Central held off the surging Blackbears who scored 30 points in the second half.

AT THE POINT

Freshman Kaley Watras started her first collegiate game at the point guard position. She led the offense throughout the game posting five assists and a positive assist-to-turnover ratio. In addition to passing, she also grabbed a team-high eight rebounds and made a pair of steals in a team-high 34 minutes on the court.

IN THE PAINT

The Blue Devils received solid production from the center position in Friday's victory. Starter Kirsten Daamen posted nine points, six rebounds, two blocks and an assist over 26 minutes. Freshman Johnna Fisher came off the bench and posted seven points, four rebounds and a block in nine minutes and junior Jameilia Dillon recorded four points and two rebounds in her time on the court. In all the Blue Devil centers totaled 20 points, 12 rebounds and two blocks under the basket.

Coach Beryl Piper has posted a career record of 59-71 over the last four

Blue Devils Picked Ninth in NEC Preseason Coaches' Poll

The Central Connecticut women's basketball team was picked to finish ninth in the preseason NEC Coaches Poll. The Blue Devils finished last season with a 19-11 record and an 11-7 mark in conference play, but lost five starters from last years squad.

plus seasons. After a disapointing first season, Piper retooled her team and posted the best turn around in the NCAA going from 4-25 to 18-14 and earning a spot in the Women's National Invitational Tournament. Piper is 55-46 over the last three plus seasons. Also during that stretch, her squad is 31-23 in Northeast Conference play, and each year the Blue Devils have reached the NEC Semifinals. Piper has coached the Blue Devils in six of the programs 11 NEC playoff games and she is responsible for three of the schools four NEC playoff game victories.

BEST DIVISION I START

Last season the Blue Devils started 5-0, the run was the best start to a season in the programs Division I history which dates back to the 1986-87 season. Included in the 5-0 start was a 62-57 victory over Maine. The 1985-86 team is the only other squad to start a season 5-0. That was CCSU's final season in Division II and the team featured Coach Beryl Piper as a player.

HISTORY

This is the 26th season in Central Connecticut women's basketball NCAA Division I history. The Blue Devils have gone 231-457 in their previous 25 years at the D1 level, which they joined prior to the 1986-87 campaign. Their best season, a 21-7 effort, came in 1989-90. It is one of five winning seasons for CCSU during the D1 era, the most recent coming last season when the Blue Devils posted a 19-11 record. Also during that span, the Blue Devils have made seven postseason appearances, including back-to-back trips to the NEC tournament in the 2004-05 and 2005-06 seasons and a current run of three straight from 2008-09, 2009-10 and 2010-11. Also the 2008-09 season saw the Blue Devils advance beyond the conference tournament for the first time, with an appearance in the Women's Postseason NIT.

MORE HISTORY

Prior to joining Division I, Central Connecticut enjoyed 15 seasons at the Division II level. During those 15 years, the Blue Devils were 165-138. Their final year at the lower level ended with a school record 24 victories and program-best .857 winning percentage (24-4).

COACHING TIMELINE

Piper is the fourth coach during Central's D1 years. Dr. Brenda Reilly finished the first 10 seasons at the helm with an 86-180 record. Kim Foley followed with a six-year stint during which the Blue Devils went 56-104. Beginning in 2002, Yvette Harris went 36-105 in five seasons. Piper's .438 winning percentage is the highest among Central's four Division I coaches. Piper is second in Division I wins at Central to only Dr. Brenda Reilly, her former coach.

BACK IN BLUE

The Blue Devils lost five starters from last year's team and face an up-hill battle to replace those players. Junior's Jaclyn Babe and Kirsten Daamen will be expected to carry much of the load as the Blue Devils rebuild. Daamen split time under the basket with Justina Udenze a year ago and will get the bulk of the minutes this year. Jaclyn Babe didn't suit up for Central last year, but has been selected as a captain heading into the season and brings the experience of 60 collegiate games played at Duquesne. Jessica Babe is the Blue Devils top returning scorer from a year ago and will see a lot of time on the floor. Sophomore Lauren Arbogast and juniors Brook Bailey and Jameilia Dillon will all see time trying to replace the production of Leanne Crocket in the four position.

NEW DEVILS

Four new players will be wearing the Central Blue this season. Freshman guards Kaley Watras and Danielle Davis will see significant minutes on the outside and post players
