NEWS & NOTES

- » Arkansas is the fifth youngest team in terms of returning scholarship players under the current head coach
- » Arkansas opened the SEC season facing five ranked teams in the Associated Press Poll - the only team in the Big Five Conferences to do so
- » The Razorbacks have three wins over ranked teams this year (No. 13 Texas A&M, No. 13 Tennessee, No. 24 Missouri)
- » The last time Arkansas defeated three ranked teams in a season was 2011-12 (Vanderbilt, South Carolina and Tennessee [not all at home])
- » It is the first time since 2001-02 that Arkansas has won back-to-back games over ranked opponents (2001-02 vs. No. 7 South Carolina, No. 8 Mississippi State)
- » Arkansas's 4-2 start in SEC play is the best conference start since starting the year 3-2 in 2010-11. Arkansas lost the sixth game moving to 3-3 to start SEC play that season.
- » This is just the second time in 10 seasons that Arkansas has started conference play with four wins in the first six games
- » Arkansas opened 5-1 in 2005-06 but lost the last nine games of the season that year
- » Arkansas is on a three-game winning streak, the longest of the year
- » Arkansas is currently tied for second in the SEC - the program's best SEC finish is fourth (1994-95) and tied for fourth (2000-01, 2011-12)

OUR OPPONENT

- Arkansas has won the last two meetings between the Razorbacks and Tigers
- Arkansas has scored 59 points in both of the last two meetings
- The Tigers have three players averaging double figures
- Brandy Montgomery leads the team with 16.6 ppg
- Montgomery leads the team in SEC only games as well with 14.0 ppg
- Tra'Cee Tanner is second on the team with 13.2 ppg and leads the team with 8.2 rebounds per game
- The Tigers upset nationally-ranked Kentucky in their first SEC game of the year and have a win over in-state rival Alabama this season
- All three losses are to nationally-ranked teams - at Mississippi State, at Tennessee and to South Carolina
- Auburn is out-scoring and out-rebounding teams in all games but is upside down in SEC games being out-scored 7.8 ppg and out-rebounded 2.3 rpg
- Auburn steals the ball and ranks third in the SEC and sixth in the NCAA with 219 swipes this year
- They average 11.5 steals per game

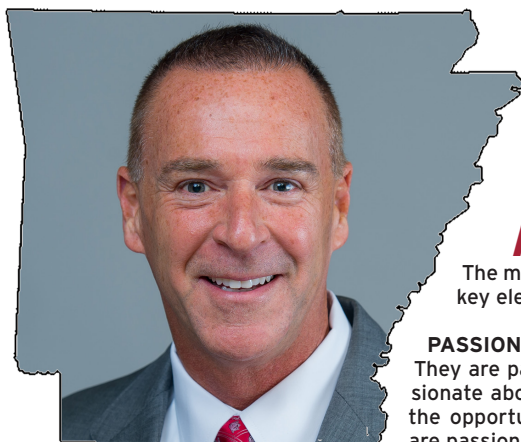

TOUGH START TO SEC SCHEDULE

Arkansas faces one of the toughest starts to the SEC schedule for the second consecutive season. Last year, the Razorbacks opened SEC play with three of its first four opponents ranked in the AP Top 15. They were one of just two programs in the Power 5 Conferences to do that.

This year, Arkansas again faces a tough start opening the season at No. 2/2 South Carolina, vs. No. 13/10 Texas A&M, at No. 7/6 Mississippi State and vs. No. 13/15 Tennessee (AP/Coaches). The Razorbacks also faced No. 5 Texas, No. 7 Oregon State and have Kentucky, Missouri, Georgia, Auburn and Florida who have been ranked or are receiving votes this year.

MORE ABOUT THE SCHEDULE

Arkansas opens SEC play facing five consecutive opponents who started conference play ranked in the AP Top-25 (Dec. 28). The Razorbacks are the only team in the SEC to open with five teams who were ranked as of Dec. 28, and they face six ranked teams in the month of January. Arkansas also faced two other league teams who are getting votes in the poll. Several other SEC teams play at least five ranked teams in January but Arkansas is the only one to start that way.

In addition to being the only team in the SEC to start with that schedule, Arkansas is the only team in the power five conferences to begin with such a tough league start. Several members of the ACC have three or four ranked conference opponents on their January schedules but none start like the Razorbacks. No one in the Big 12 faces more than two ranked conference opponents in January. No one in the Big Ten has more than three. The Pac-12 has several teams who face five ranked conference opponents in the month of January but, again, no one who starts with five consecutive ranked conference teams.

LONE WOLFF

Melissa Wolff is the only senior on the 2015-16 team. Named team captain, Wolff's leadership on and off the court will be heavily relied upon with eight newcomers to the Razorback family this year. Wolff led the team in rebounding last year with 7.8 per game and had six double doubles last year, including two in the NCAA Tournament.

As a senior, Wolff was a nominee for the WBCA, the NABC and Allstate Insurance Company's 2016 Allstate WBCA and NABC Good Works Teams®. In its fourth year, the Allstate WBCA and NABC Good Works Teams® recognize players at all levels of college basketball who have made outstanding

contributions in the areas of volunteerism and civic involvement. From establishing nonprofits that provide youth with the necessary tools to become leaders of tomorrow, to raising awareness around pertinent issues that could save lives, these student-athletes exhibit impeccable leadership skills both on and off the court.

WOLFF A SENIOR OF SIGNIFICANCE

Razorback Melissa Wolff was recognized recently as a Senior of Significance by the College of Education and Health Professions and the University of Arkansas. The Alumni Association has been recognizing the outstanding graduate for more than 50 years. Expansion of the awards program took place in 2014 when the committee selected 71 outstanding Seniors of Significance in honor of the University of Arkansas founding year of 1871. Razorback student-athletes represented nearly 13 percent of the entire Seniors of Significance class this year. Hundreds of students were nominated by the faculty and staff on campus. Completed applications were then reviewed by more than 100 alumni and university employees to select the top 71. The Seniors of Significance honored represent the top 2% from the Class of 2016.
