Auburn Women's Basketball Quick Hitters

- Auburn enters Wednesday's game at 3-3 on the season, coming off a 1-2 week at the Challenge in Music City
- This is Auburn's second all-time meeting with Louisiana-Monroe and first in the regular season
- Northeast Louisiana defeated Auburn in the 1985 NCAA Regional Semifinal, 76-71, in Monroe
- Auburn has eight games against teams from the state of Louisiana this season; the Tigers are 1-0 after a win over LA Tech on Nov. 19
- Auburn's win over North Carolina A&T on Nov. 16 was the 900th win in program history, dating back to 1971-72
- Auburn is the 24th program in NCAA Division I to win 900 women's basketball games
- Under coach Terri Williams-Flournoy, Auburn is 35-3 in non-conference home games
- Auburn has forced at least 20 turnovers in all six games this season
- Auburn has won 19 of its last 21 games when forcing at least 25 turnovers (1-1 this season)
- Freshman Unique Thompson was named SEC Freshman of the Week after her first career double-double (16 pts, 14 rebs) vs. Louisiana Tech (11/19); she had 10 points and 10 rebounds by halftime
- Thompson had six blocks vs. LA Tech, most for Auburn player since 2011 (Jassany Williams, 7 vs. Duke)
- Thompson became the sixth Auburn freshman since 2005 to earn a start in her first collegiate game; she played 34 minutes in the opener at Virginia Tech
- Thompson pulled down 16 rebounds at Virginia Tech, the most by an Auburn player since Tra'Cee Tanner had 19 at Florida Gulf Coast in 2015
- Thompson is averaging a double-double through six games with 10.8 points and 10.0 rebounds
- Junior point guard Janiah McKay is Auburn's top scorer with 14.8 points/game; she also leads team in steals (2.3) and assists (4.8)
- McKay matched her career-high with 29 points vs. Louisiana Tech (11/19); also had 29 vs. Tennessee and Alabama last year
- McKay had a career-high 8 rebounds vs. North Carolina A&T (11/16)
- Sophomore Daisa Alexander scored a career-high 19 points in the season opener at Virginia Tech (11/13); she scored 26 points all of her freshman season
- Alexander is second on the team with 11.0 points/game; she has scored in double-figures in four of six games
- Junior Erica Sanders had a career-high 6 steals vs. Louisiana Tech (11/19)
- Junior Emari Jones had a career-high 7 rebounds at Virginia Tech (11/13) and earned her first start vs. N.C. A&T (11/16)
- Auburn's 52 rebounds at Virginia Tech were the most since pulling down 57 in an overtime loss at Marquette in 2015
- Auburn is 134-39 all-time in the month of November; Coach Flo is 26-12 in November at Auburn
- Auburn is 61-29 in non-conference games under Terri Williams-Flournoy
- Auburn returns three starters and nine letterwinners from the 2016-17 team
- The Tigers were selected to the NCAA Tournament for the second straight season in 2016-17 and finished 17-15 overall
- The Tigers face five non-conference opponents in 2017-18 that advanced to postseason play last year

OPENING TIP

» Auburn returns to the friendly confines of Auburn Arena for a Wednesday night tilt against Louisiana-Monroe. Game time is set for 6 p.m. with the broadcast on SEC Network +.

» Both teams enter Wednesday's contest at .500 for the season. Auburn is 3-3 with wins over N.C. A&T, Louisiana Tech and Georgetown. ULM, at 2-2, has defeated Division III foes Centenary and Millsaps for its two victories.

LAST TIME OUT

» Senior Janiah McKay led all scorers with 18 points, but the Auburn women's basketball team could not overcome a slow start in a 50-41 loss to Chattanooga in the final game at the Challenge in Music City.

» The Tigers (3-3) found themselves in a 16-point hole midway through the second quarter but were able to cut that deficit to as few as five points in the fourth quarter. But Chattanooga (4-4) took advantage of their opportunities at the free-throw line late to hold off any potential Auburn comeback.

» McKay's 18 points led all scorers; she was Auburn's only player in double figures and was named to the all-tournament team. Senior Tiffany Lewis added eight points against her hometown team, and senior Jessica Jones had six points and shared the team lead with five rebounds.

» Auburn actually made one more field goal than Chattanooga with the Tigers going 16-for-56 (28.1%) and the Mocs hitting 15-of-34 (44.1%). But UTC got to the free-throw line 20 times, knocking down 16 attempts, while Auburn was just 6-of-9 at the stripe with all nine attempts coming in the fourth quarter.

UP NEXT

» Auburn hits the road again for a Sunday showdown with Indiana. Game time is 1 p.m. from Assembly Hall in Bloomington, Ind.; Big Ten Network Plus will have the broadcast.

AUBURN vs. LOUISIANA-MONROE

» This is the first regular-season meeting between Auburn and UL-Monroe in women's basketball.

» ULM leads the series 1-0; the teams met in 1985 in the regional semifinal of the NCAA Tournament with second-ranked Northeast Louisiana - the previous name of the school - defeated 10th-ranked Auburn 76-71 in Monroe.

» This is the second of eight games against teams from the state of Louisiana this season. Auburn is 1-0 so far with a 75-59 win over LA Tech on Nov. 19.

SCOUTING LOUISIANA-MONROE

» ULM is 2-2 on the year but has not defeated a Division I team. The Warhawks have wins over a pair of Division III opponents, Centenary and Millsaps, but dropped road contest to Grambling and McNeese State.

» The Warhawks average 69.0 points/game and hold opponents to 55.0/game. Against the two Division I opponents, ULM has averaged 56.5 points and surrendered 63.0.

» Senior Gabriella Cortez leads the Warhawks in most categories with 21.0 points, 9.3 rebounds and 1.8 steals per game. Cortez was a preseason All-Sun Belt second-team selection.

SCOUTING AUBURN

» Auburn is 3-3 through its first three games with wins over N.C. A&T, Louisiana Tech and Georgetown.

» The Tigers are scoring 58.3 points/game while outrebounding opponents 39-34.

» Junior point guard Janiah McKay has scored 15 or more points in four of Auburn's first six games, including matching a career-high with 29 vs. Louisiana Tech. She averaged 12.9 ppg last season, tops among returning players. She led the Tigers in scoring eight times last season and had her first career double-double with 13 points and 13 assists vs. Ole Miss.

» Senior forwards Jazmine and Jessica Jones are the Tigers' other two returning starters. Jessica Jones is the team's leading returner in rebounds (5.2/game) and steals (1.4/game) and averaged 3.8 points last season. Jazmine Jones averaged 4.5 points and 4.3 rebounds last season and was a key component of Auburn's trademark pressure defense. Jessica pulled down 10 rebounds in a win over N.C. A&T.

» Freshman Unique Thompson has been a breakout star in the Tigers' first few games, averaging 10.8 points and 10.0 rebounds. She had a double-double vs. Louisiana Tech to earn SEC Freshman of the Week honors.

» Junior Emari Jones earned her first career start vs. North Carolina A&T on Nov. 16. She has averaged 3.8 points and 4.5 rebounds so far this year.

» Auburn has forced at least 20 turnovers in all six games this season and has forced 25 or more twice (29 vs. LA Tech; 25 vs. Northwestern).

SHE'S THE REAL MCKAY

» Junior Janiah McKay continues to be Auburn's do-everything player in her third year as the Tigers' starting point guard. In the Tigers' first six games, she has averaged 14.8 points, 3.7 rebounds, 4.8 assists and 2.4 steals. Her 8 rebounds vs. N.C. A&T were a career-high.

» McKay has moved into the Auburn career top-30 in

» Thompson's 16 rebounds were the most by an Auburn player since Tra'Ce'e Tanner had 19 at Florida Gulf Coast on Dec. 30, 2015. It marked the most by an Auburn freshman since Le'Co'e Willingham had 16 vs. South Carolina on Feb. 3, 2000.

» She followed that up with 11 points and 7 rebounds vs. N.C. A&T, then got her first career double-double with 16 points, 14 rebounds and 6 blocks vs. Louisiana Tech. Her performance earned her SEC Freshman of the Week honors on Nov. 21.

» Thompson's 6 blocks vs. LA Tech were the most by an Auburn player since Jassany Williams had 7 vs. Duke in 2011. She also had 10 points and 10 rebounds in the first half, making her the first Auburn player with a double-double by halftime since DeWanna Bonner in 2009.

» Thompson suffered an ankle injury vs. Northwestern and missed Auburn's next game vs. Chattanooga.

EVERYTHING'S COMING UP DAISA

» Sophomore Daisa Alexander played the best game of her collegiate career in Auburn's opener at Virginia Tech, setting career-highs in scoring (19), steals (4) and assists (3) while playing a career-high 22 minutes off the bench.

» Alexander averaged 5.7 minutes as a freshman, playing behind then-senior Brandy Montgomery, while scoring 1.3 points per game. She scored 26 points all of her freshman season with a previous career-high of 7 against Jacksonville.

» Alexander has scored in double-figures in four games this season, averaging 11.0 points/game. She had 12 points against N.C. A&T and 14 vs. Louisiana Tech.

CLUB PRESS, BACK FOR A SIXTH YEAR

» So far in 2017-18, Auburn has forced 23.2 turnovers and averaged 13.3 steals per game, scoring an average of 20.8 points off opponent turnovers.

» The Tigers forced Louisiana Tech into 29 turnovers on Nov. 19, which turned into 31 Auburn points. Auburn had 21 steals in the game, tying for the 10th-most in program history.

» Auburn is 1-1 this year and has won 19 of its last 21 games when forcing at least 25 turnovers.

» Auburn has had 20 or more steals 10 times in the Coach Flo era.

» Auburn set a school record in 2016-17 by forcing 709 opponent turnovers (22.2/game), breaking the previous mark of 702 from the 1986-87 season.

» The Tigers forced 25 or more turnovers eight times and 20+ turnovers 22 times in 32 games last season. Auburn was 8-0 last year and is 37-6 under Coach Flo when forcing 25+ turnovers.

» Auburn averaged 11.5 steals per game in 2016-17, which ranked eighth in the nation.

BLACKSBURG, Va.--Sophomore Daisa Alexander scored a career-high 19 points and freshman Unique Thompson pulled down 16 rebounds in her collegiate debut, but Auburn could not hold onto a halftime lead in a 72-63 loss at Virginia Tech Monday night.

The Tigers (0-1) led 32-28 at the half and were lights-out from the field in the first 10 minutes, but poor free-throw shooting and missed layups proved to be the Tigers' downfall in the season opener.

A four-point halftime lead evaporated in the third quarter as the Hokies opened the period on an 8-0 run to take a 36-34 lead and push that to a 48-41 advantage after three quarters. Auburn had ample opportunities at the free-throw line to keep the game within reach, but the Tigers were 12-of-26 (46.2%) at the charity stripe for the game while Virginia Tech (2-0) knocked down 15-of-22 attempts at the line.

Much like last year's win at Auburn, Virginia Tech was hot from beyond the arc, making nine 3-pointers with seven of those coming in the second half. The Hokies shot 37.5 percent from the field while Auburn was 31.9 percent.

Alexander's 19-point night off the bench smashed her previous career-high of 7 points, which came in the Tigers' win over Jacksonville last season. She hit three 3-pointers and was 7-of-16 from the field.

Thompson missed a double-double in her Auburn debut by one point with nine points and 16 rebounds. Her rebounding total was the highest by an Auburn player since Tra'Cee Tanner had 19 at Florida Gulf Coast during the 2015-16 season. Janiah McKay had 15 points and a team-high five assists.

Auburn led 22-20 after a high-energy first quarter that saw the Tigers shoot 56.3 percent from the field and keep pace with a Hokie offense that scored 99 points its first game. The second quarter was nearly the exact opposite as the teams combined for 18 points, leading to a 32-28 halftime lead for the Tigers.

Taylor Emery led Virginia Tech with 20 points, and Chanette Hicks had 14.

AUBURN --Three players scored in double-figures to lead the Auburn women's basketball team to a 63-53 victory over North Carolina A&T on Thursday night, the 900th victory in program history.

Junior Janiah McKay scored 15 points and added a career-high eight rebounds to go along with five assists and four steals, leading the Tigers (1-1) to their 39th consecutive victory in a home opener, a streak that dates back to 1978.

A 20-4 run that spanned the last part of the second quarter and the first five minutes of the third pushed the Tigers to a lead they would not relinquish. After A&T took a 24-23 lead with 2:04 to play in the second quarter, the Tigers finished the period on an 8-0 run, sparked by four points from Daisa Alexander and back-to-back layups from McKay and Jessica Jones to give Auburn a 31-24 lead at the half.

The run continued into the third quarter as Auburn pushed its lead to 44-28 halfway through the period. The Aggies (1-2) would get as close as eight points in the final minutes of the fourth quarter, but never seriously threatened the Auburn lead after halftime.

Alexander added 12 points off the bench, and Unique Thompson had 11 points with seven rebounds. Jessica Jones added 10 rebounds off the bench, and Emari Jones, making her first career start, had six points and six rebounds.

Auburn shot 41.0 percent from the field and held the Aggies to a 35.4-percent night. At the free-throw line, Auburn showed improvement from its first game, hitting 9-of-16 attempts (56.3%). The Tigers also out-rebounded the Aggies 44-27 and outscored A&T in the paint 38-16.

Cinia McCray led A&T with 14 points and Kala Green added 13.

In its 47th season of women's basketball, Auburn now owns an all-time record of 900 wins and 455 losses. Auburn is the 24th team in NCAA history to reach the 900-win plateau.

NASHVILLE, Tenn. --Four players scored in double-figures, and Auburn shot a season-high 51 percent from the field in a 60-40 victory over Georgetown on Friday night at the Challenge in Music City.

The Tigers controlled the inside game all night, scoring 36 points in the paint to just 10 for Georgetown, and the Hoyas were held to 29.2-percent shooting on the night.

Senior Jessica Jones and freshman Unique Thompson shared the team lead with 12 points each, and sophomore Daisa Alexander and senior Jazmine Jones had 10 points apiece. Jessica Jones was a perfect 6-for-6 from the floor and pulled down four rebounds, Thompson led the Tigers with seven boards, and Alexander had five rebounds on the night.

Senior Tiffany Lewis added seven points and freshman Isabella Lopez had a career-best six. Auburn's leading scorer, senior Janiah McKay, was held scoreless, but dished out a season-best six assists.

Auburn was 26-of-51 (51.0%) from the field, a season-best, and scored 19 points off 20 Georgetown turnovers. Auburn's bench outscored the Hoyas' reserves 28-3, and the Tigers out-rebounded Georgetown 37-25.

A flurry in the final 90 seconds of the third quarter put the game out of reach. With Auburn leading by seven, Jessica Jones backed down a defender to beat the shot clock, Lopez banked in a 3-pointer, Jones drew a charge at the other end, Alexander hit a free throw with less than two seconds left, and then Alexander stole the in-bound pass and banked in a 15-foot jumper at the buzzer. After all that, Auburn led 45-30, and Georgetown managed just three points over the first four minutes of the fourth quarter as the Tigers built a 25-point lead, pulling ahead as much as 58-33.

Auburn took a 27-21 halftime lead on the strength of an impressive inside game -- 20 of Auburn's 27 first-half points came in the paint. As such, the Tigers shot 48 percent in the opening 20 minutes.

Mikayla Venson led Georgetown with 19 points, making half of the Hoyas' field goals on the night. She hit five of their six 3-pointers.

NASHVILLE, Tenn. --Auburn women's basketball mounted a valiant comeback from a 15-point second-half deficit but fell one point short in a 49-48 loss to Northwestern Saturday night in the Challenge in Music City.

Trailing 36-23 with 3:26 to play in the third quarter, Auburn went on a 12-0 run over the next four-plus minutes to cut the deficit to just one, then took a 46-43 lead on a Tiffany Lewis 3-pointer with 3:05 to play. But the Tigers would manage just one more basket the rest of the way.

With Auburn ahead 48-47, Northwestern (5-1) took the lead on a jumper from Jordan Hamilton with 12.8 seconds to play. The Tigers had one final attempt, but it would not fall, and Northwestern was able to get the rebound, call timeout, advance the ball and run out the clock.

Auburn shot a season-worst 31.7 percent from the field (19-of-60) and was 6-of-13 at the free-throw line. The Tigers did force 25 Northwestern turnovers, turning those into 21 points; the loss snapped a 10-game Auburn winning streak when forcing 25 or more opponent turnovers.

Janiah McKay led Auburn with 12 points and four assists. Emari Jones had nine points, two shy of a career-high, and shared the team lead with six rebounds. Unique Thompson also had six rebounds along with six points.

An ugly first half on both sides ended with Northwestern leading 26-13. Auburn managed just four points in the second quarter, shooting 21 percent in the opening half. But a 20-point third quarter, along with a strong second-half defensive effort, cut what had been a 15-point deficit to just three headed to the final period.

Northwestern was led by Abi Scheid, who scored 14 points. Lindsey Pulliam had 12 points with 10 of those in the second half.
