- » Auburn is 3-0 against Texas Southern all-time and is 23-0 against teams from the Southwestern Athletic Conference in program history.
- » Auburn is 41-3 (.932) in regular season non-conference home games under head coach Bruce Pearl. That mark is currently second among all SEC programs since 2014, only trailing Arkansas (57-3, .950).
- » The Tigers have won 30 straight regular season non-conference home games and hold perfect records over the last four seasons. Auburn is the only team in the SEC without a blemish at home against non-league foes since 2016-17. Arkansas (18) and Georgia (16) are next in the SEC regarding consecutive home wins against non-league foes.
- » Justin Powell tied an Auburn freshman record with 26 points in his home debut. Powell tied Eddie Johnson, who also had 26 points, exactly 47 years to the day vs. Western Illinois (Dec. 4, 1974). Powell set Auburn freshman home debut records with his nine assists and seven 3-pointers.
- » The Tigers have without a doubt one of the youngest rosters in college basketball with 15 underclassmen six freshman and nine sophomores. Auburn and UC Irvine have the fewest upperclassmen on their respective rosters with two each.
- » Auburn lost 84.1 percent of its scoring from a season ago the fifth-most in the country and graduated the winningest class in program history as the 2020 seniors had 99 wins through four years, besting the 2001 class (87).

### **BRUCE PEARL**

Head Coach 7th year at Auburn • 128-80 26th year overall • 590-225

- Has advanced to postseason play in 20 of 25 years as a head coach. Following a second-place finish in the SEC with a 25-6 record, including 12-6 in league play, that would be 21 of 25 had the postseason not been canceled due to COVID
- Set single-season wins records at four different schools (29 at Southern Indiana in 1995; 26 at Wisconsin-Milwaukee in 2005; 31 at Tennessee in 2008; 30 at Auburn in 2019)
- Pearl has achieved a top-5 national ranking at Southern Indiana, Tennessee and Auburn. He has been in the top five in 10 seasons (1994-2001 at Southern Indiana, 2007-08 at Tennessee, 2019-20 at Auburn)
- Bruce Pearl's teams have led their conference in scoring 17 of the 25 years that he has been a head coach. His squads were the SEC's scoring champion in four of his six seasons at Tennessee, averaging 77.4 ppg while allowing 70.5 ppg
- One of 12 coaches to lead three different DI programs to the Sweet 16, joining Rick Barnes, Gene Bartow, John Calipari, Lon Kruger, Frank McGuire, Ralph Miller, Rick Pitino, Bill Self, Tubby Smith, Eddie Sutton and Bruce Weber. Including his stint at DII Southern Indiana, Pearl is one of only three coaches to take four programs (with three at the DI level) to the Sweet 16, joining Lon Kruger and Eddie Sutton
- With the win over Kentucky that sent Auburn to its first Final Four in program history, Pearl notched his 100th win as head coach of the Tigers. He is the first coach in Auburn history to have 100 wins in his first five seasons
- Bruce Pearl is the 11th coach in SEC history to win four conference crowns (overall or division) in a 10-year span. He is on the same list as Adolph Rupp (UK), Babe McCarthy (MSU), Billy Donovan (UF), Dale Brown (LSU), Joe Hall (UK), John Calipari (UK), Nolan Richardson (ARK), Rick Pitino (UK), Rick Stansbury (MSU) and Tubby Smith (UK)
- Auburn sold out of season tickets for the sixth straight time in 2019-20, all under Pearl, to continue the school record streak. Prior to Pearl, the only other time the Tigers sold out of season tickets came was 1999-2000
- $\bullet$  In 25 full years as a head coach, Bruce Pearl's teams have finished either first or second in conference play 17 times
- At the Division I level, Pearl's teams have topped the 100-point mark 20 times, including a high of 124 in 2009 as well as 121 in the 2007 NCAA Tournament. In his second year as a coach at Southern Indiana the team averaged 101.7 ppg
- In the past four seasons, Auburn has the best non-conference record in the SEC during the regular season at 47-5 (.904), while scheduling regular NCAA Tournament teams in Arizona, Davidson, Dayton, Duke, Iowa State, Middle Tennessee, Murray State, Oklahoma, Texas Tech, UConn and Xavier

- His teams have been just as successful off the court as Auburn has had 29 graduates in six years the most in the SEC. In 2018, Auburn received an Academic Progress Rate Public Recognition Award marking the first time the Tigers have been honored since the award began tracking data in 2004. The NCAA annually honors teams earning multiyear Academic Progress Rates in the top 10 percent of all squads in each sport
- Auburn recently secured its fourth perfect APR score of 1,000 in mid-May, something that has never been accomplished in program history
- In the past five years, Auburn men's basketball has averaged an APR of 995 (out of 1,000). In the previous four seasons before Pearl and his staff arrived, Auburn's APR average score was 940
- Pearl started AUTLIVE at Auburn in 2015-16 to benefit cancer patients in the fight to beat cancer. AUTLIVE raises the awareness of cancer prevention and detection while t-shirt sales and donations raise money to benefit cancer patients. He initiated the OUTLIVE program in 2009 at Tennessee in recognition of former Vol Chris Lofton, who beat testicular cancer through early diagnosis and treatment and went on to play the entire 2007-08 season while recovering from his battle with the disease
- On Dec. 19, 2019, Children's Harbor in Birmingham, Ala. dedicated their on-site basketball court in honor of the charitible work done by Coach Pearl and the Pearl family over the last six years.
- Bruce Pearl has raised over \$1.2 million in only six golf tournaments at Auburn. Pearl and his wife, Brandy, have remarkably raised \$770,000 in the last three years benefitting Children's Harbor in Birmingham through the Bruce Pearl Fore the Children Golf Classic. The mission of Children's Harbor is to help children with serious illness and their families
- The Bruce Pearl Family Foundation in conjunction with L5 Foundation, an organization dedicated to addressing the essential and basic needs of cancer patients, donated \$20,000 to five charities in a ceremony in Knoxville in August 2015
- The Pearl family announced on Feb. 27, 2007, a \$100,000 donation to endow a scholarship in the name of former Tennessee player Dane Bradshaw. The Dane Bradshaw Athletic Scholarship Endowment is awarded to the male or female student-athlete at UT who best epitomizes the characteristics of the 2006-07 senior captain

### **AUBURN VS. TEXAS SOUTHERN SERIES**

- » Tuesday night's game between Auburn and Texas Southern is set to be the fourth in the series history. Auburn has won all three previous games, which all took place on The Plains.
- » The Tigers are 23-0 all-time against teams from the Southwest Athletic Conference.
- » Head coach Bruce Pearl is 1-0 against Texas Southern after winning 61-60 in his first season at Auburn. Pearl has faced TSU head coach Johnny Jones six times in his career and is 4-2 in those matchups with all six taking place while Pearl was at Auburn and Jones was at LSU.

### **POWELL NAMED SEC FOTW**

- » Justin Powell was selected as the SEC Freshman of the Week following his second consecutive 26-point performance, which matched a career high, in Auburn's 74-71 win vs. Memphis Saturday. He went 9 of 13 from the floor, including 4 of 6 from deep, in the victory.
- » The Prospect, Ky. native scored the Tigers' first 11 points of the game and then had 15 of Auburn's 37 second-half points to lead a comefrom-behind win in which the Tigers trailed by as many as eight.

### JP IS A UNICORN

- » On Dec. 4, Auburn freshman Justin Powell made history with his performance against South Alabama. Powell had 26 points on 7-of-9 from the floor, with all of his shots behind the arc, and nine assists.
- » Powell's 26 points vs. South Alabama tied Eddie Johnson for the Auburn record for most points in a home debut by a freshman. Johnson had 26 points vs. Western Carolina 47 years to the day of Powell (Dec. 4, 1973).
- » His nine assists and seven 3s vs. South Alabama were the most by a freshman in his home debut in program history.

- » Powell is one of six freshman in the country since 2010 to have nine assists and seven 3s in a game, joining Trae Young (Oklahoma), Ky Bowman (Boston College), Shamorie Ponds (St. John's), Jordan Bohannon (Iowa) and Braden Norris (Oakland).
- » He followed up that performance with 26 points and eight rebounds vs. Memphis, and was later awarded SEC Freshman of the Week.
- » Powell became one of two freshman guards in the country to have an outing of 26 points and eight rebounds this season, joining Jaron Pierre of Southern Miss.
- » In addition, Powell is the only player in the country to have performances of 25 or more points with eight rebounds and 25 or more points with nine assists this season.
- » In his first five games in an Auburn jersey, freshman Justin Powell has attacked the glass as well as anyone in his position. Powell is fourth in the country in total rebounds among freshman guards.

- » Auburn has won 30 straight regular season non-conference home games and holds perfect records over the last four seasons. Auburn is the only team in the SEC without a blemish at home against non-league foes since 2016-17.
- » The Tigers' streak of 30 straight regular season non-conference home wins is tops in the SEC by a wide margin, leading Arkansas (18) and Georgia (16). The last time Auburn lost at home to a non-conference foe was Jan. 30, 2016 vs. Oklahoma State in the Big 12/SEC Challenge, 74-63.

### TOP OF THE PACK

» Auburn is at the top of the SEC in terms of non-conference wins over the last four-plus years, including the 2020-21 season. The Tigers are the only team in the league to have won at least 10 non-conference regular season games over the last four seasons. Auburn's 47 non-league victories over the last four seasons are a school record in a 4-year span.

### PLAYER TO WATCH: BABATUNDE AKINGBOLA

Babatunde Akingbola has shown great improvement already in his second season on The Plains. The sophomore has swatted seven shots, including one in each game so far, after totaling five in 13 games last season. The Ogun, Nigeria native has also scored in every game this year, racking up 21 points after having just two total points during the 2019-20 campaign.

» Auburn is fourth in the SEC and 33rd in the country with 4.8 blocks per game. Jaylin Williams is sixth in the league at 1.6 per game, while Babatunde Akingbola is 10th at 1.4 swats per contest.

### WHOLE LOTTA HEIGHT

- » Auburn boasts the ninth-tallest team in the country, averaging 78.7 inches per player nearly 6-foot-7.
- » Auburn's average height of 78.7 inches on the 2020-21 roster is the tallest the Tigers have had over the last 15 seasons.
- » Since 2007, Auburn has boasted an average height of 77 inches or more just four times: 77.1 in 2010-11, 77.9 in 2015-16, 77.3 in 2019-20 and 78.7 in 2020-21.
- » Auburn's average height over the last 15 seasons is ranked in the middle of the pack nationally (160.5). The Tigers have had a roster in the top 100 in the country in terms of height just three times since 2007: 93rd in 2010-11, 48th in 2015-16 and ninth in 2020-21.

### TIGERS IN OVERTIME

» With a 96-91 win in overtime vs. Saint Joseph's, Auburn is 58-53 in overtime games all-time, including a 9-0 mark since the start of the 2018-19 season and 2-0 against Saint Joseph's.

### **CLASS OF THE SEC: MOST GRADUATES SINCE 2014**

When it comes to graduating players, nobody in the SEC has done it better than head coach Bruce Pearl and Auburn. Since 2014, the Tigers have had 31 student-athletes walk across the graduation stage and earn their degrees, which is the highest number in the SEC. Pictured below is recent graduate Anfernee McLemore, who earned two degrees in his four seasons with the Tigers.



- » The Tigers are 12-2 in overtime under head coach Bruce Pearl, including a perfect 5-0 last season.
- » Auburn's 9-game winning streak in overtime is currently the second-longet active winning streak behind Florida State (10). The all-time national record for consecutive overtime victories is 11 by Louisville (1968-75), UMass (1991-96) and Virginia (1991-96). Temple (seven) and Kansas (six) are next in the country in terms of longest active winning streaks in overtime.

### WELCOME TO THE JUNGLE

- » Known as one of the best homecourt environments in all of college basketball, Auburn has fed off of its consistently-packed crowds inside Auburn Arena, or as ESPN's Tom Hart has called it, "The Cathedral of Chaos."
- » The Tigers finished the 2019-20 season at 16-1 at home, marking the most wins in Auburn Arena history and the second-most home wins ever in program history, trailing only the 18 by the 2008-09 team at Beard-Eaves-Memorial Coliseum.
- » Auburn's 19-game home winning streak was snapped in the final home game of the season to Texas A&M, ending what was the eighth-longest active streak in the country.

### LATE HOME OPENER

» Auburn's game against South Alabama on Friday, Dec. 4 marks the latest home opener in a season since 1987 when the Tigers defeated VCU, 93-80, on Dec. 5 under former head coach and current radio analyst Sonny Smith.

### **AUBURN IN SEASON OPENERS**

» With a 96-91 overtime win against Saint Joseph's Thursday night, Auburn improved to 84-31 (.730) in season openers, including 61-9 at home, 13-16 on the road, 5-3 in neutral-site games and 5-3 in games played in unknown locations. The 2020 season was the first time since 2007 that the Tigers have not opened the season at home. Auburn has won 40 of its last 47 season openers.

### **BP IN SEASON OPENERS**

» Bruce Pearl improved to 25-1 (.962) in season openers, including 7-0 at Auburn. The Tigers defeated Georgia Southern 83-74 last season, South Alabama 101-58 in 2018, Norfolk State 102-74 in 2017, North Florida 83-66 in 2016, UAB 75-74 in 2015 and Milwaukee 83-73 in 2014 in Pearl's debut as Auburn's head coach. Overall, Pearl has won 15 consecutive season openers.

### **CLASS OF THE SEC**

» In the last three seasons, no team in the SEC has won more than Auburn as the Tigers are one of just three programs to amass 70 wins. Listed below are the records of all 14 SEC teams from the 2017-18 season until now.

### GAMEDAY EXPERIENCE: AUBURN ARENA

Built at a cost of \$86 million, Auburn Arena seats 9,121 fans for basketball games. Auburn Arena replaced the old Beard-Eaves Memorial Coliseum as the home of Tiger basketball for the 2010-11 season. The furthest seat in Auburn Arena is just 43 feet away from the court. Two-thirds of the seats are less than 27 feet in elevation from courtside offering a home environment that is unrivaled.



### **ANOTHER 20-WIN SEASON**

- » The Tigers have recorded three straight 20-win seasons for the second time all-time after first accomplishing the feat from 1983-84 to 1985-86. After a win against LSU last year, Auburn secured its third consecutive 21-win season, a first in program history for the Tigers.
- » Bruce Pearl joins Cliff Ellis and Sonny Smith as the only head coaches to lead Auburn to three 20-win seasons.
- » In the 25 seasons that Bruce Pearl has been a head coach, including the 2019-20 campaign, his teams have amassed 20 20-win seasons. In simple math, Coach Pearl has won at least 20 games in a season in 80 percent of his seasons as the head coach.

### **AUBURN VS. TOP-25 OPPONENTS**

» Auburn is 70-214 against teams from the AP Top 25 all-time. In 2018-19, the Tigers set a program record by defeating six top-25 teams, including five in a row from the SEC Tournament title to a trip to the Final Four.

- » The Tigers have won two of their matchups against top-25 competition last season, taking down No. 13 Kentucky (75-66) and No. 18 LSU (91-90 in OT) in a span of seven days. Auburn lost its most recent top-25 battle at No. 8 Kentucky, 73-66.
- » Auburn has won seven of its last eight games against the AP Top 25, which is the best stretch in program history by far. The next-closest similar streak was when the Tigers defeated six of nine ranked foes between the 1984-85 and 1985-86 seasons.
- » Auburn is 14-23 as a ranked team vs. a ranked opponent all-time, but has won seven of the last nine occurrences.

### **AUBURN TO FORGO 2021 POSTSEASON**

- » The Auburn men's basketball program will forgo postseason competition for the upcoming 2020-2021 season. The NCAA and the SEC have been notified.
- » The athletics department and university administration, in conjunction with Coach Bruce Pearl, made the decision after careful deliberation and in light of the ongoing matter that surfaced in fall 2017 regarding former assistant coach Chuck Person. Auburn has cooperated with the NCAA and will continue to do so.

### **Bruce Pearl Statement**

» "This was a difficult decision but the right decision. I hate it for our current players. They lost the opportunity for the postseason last year because of COVID, and now they will miss the postseason again. It's a two-year postseason penalty for them. However, we need to take this penalty now to put it behind us."

# **OKORO MAKES HISTORY**

Dreams became reality for former Auburn star Isaac Okoro Wednesday night when he was chosen with the No. 5 overall selection in the 2020 NBA Draft by the Cleveland Cavaliers.

Okoro's selection is tied for the third-highest selection in program history behind only Chris Morris (No. 4, 1988) and Chuck Person (No. 4, 1986). Charles Barkley was also chosen No. 5 in the 1984 NBA Draft.

The Powder Springs, Ga. native became the first one-and-done player in program history.

Okoro was just the sixth player in Southeastern Conference history to be named All-SEC, All-Defensive and All-Freshman in the same season.

Following Okoro's No. 5 selection and Chuma Okeke's No. 16 pick in the 2019 NBA Draft, Auburn has produced back-to-back first round draft picks for the first time in program history.

Okoro averaged 12.9 points, 4.4 rebounds, two assists, 0.9 steals and 0.9 blocks in 31.5 minutes per game while starting 28 games as a first-year player in senior-laden lineup. The Tigers posted a 25-6 record during the 2019-20 campaign.

Okoro scored in double figures 20 times and was named the SEC Freshman of the Week twice, becoming just the fourth freshman in program history to earn the conference distinction two times in a season.

Okoro is the second Tiger to be drafted by the Cavaliers, joining Mike Mitchell, who was taken with the 15th selection of the 1978 NBA Draft. Along with Mitchell (1978-82), former lettermen Eddie Johnson (1985-86) and Wesley Person (1997-2002) all played for the Cavs.
