GAMECOCK STORYLINES

- For the first time in program history, Jacksonville State will host Auburn and Alabama on back-to-back nights when the Tigers and Crimson Tide visit Rudy Abbott Field at Jim Case Stadium on Tuesday and Wednesday evening.
- The Gamecocks enter the week having won seven of their last 10 games, including an 11-6 decision over AU at Plainsman Park on April 9. JSU scored 11 unanswered runs after trailing 6-0 early in the contest. JSU, the leaders in the Ohio Valley Conference (12-6), holds a 21-17 overall mark after claiming is four consecutive league series against Eastern Kentucky in Richmond, Kentucky. Auburn, ranked as high as No. 20 by Baseball America, stands at 26-14 on the season after taking a series against Ole Miss in Auburn over the weekend. The Crimson Tide will visit Jacksonville with a record of 24-17. UA dropped all three games to Vanderbilt in Tuscaloosa. Jax State will be looking to avenge an early season setback to UA. Dating back to the 2017 season, JSU has won three-of-the-last-five matchups with the Crimson Tide with all five meetings in Tuscaloosa.
- Junior Alex Webb is hitting above the .300 mark with 41 hits and a team-high 13 doubles. The Columbia, Tennessee product has a team-best 31 RBI. In the month of April, Webb has highlighted JSU's offensive numbers, which has helped the club to seven wins in the last 10 games. Over the last 10 games, Webb has raised his average to .389 with 14 hits, including six doubles and three home runs.

GAMECOCK NOTEBOOK**JSU SET TO DEBUT OF RUDY ABBOTT FIELD AT JIM CASE STADIUM IN 2019**

The wait is finally over! Jacksonville State's multi-million, state-of-the-art baseball facility will officially open on opening weekend of the 2019 season with the Gamecocks hosting North Alabama.

After spending the last two seasons in their home-away-from-home at Oxford, Alabama's Choccolocco Park, the Gamecocks will play their first game on campus since May 21, 2016 against UT Martin. Construction delays and the affects of the March 19, 2018 tornado that came through the JSU campus held JSU out of its home.

The baseball stadium includes a 1,000 seat spectator grandstand with a shade canopy, seven VIP suites that will be able to entertain large groups with seating inside and outside, a new state-of-the-art press box to include radio and television broadcast booths, a game operations center. The facility also houses an indoor hitting facility, clubhouse, coaches offices and a team room.

Jax State dedicated the stadium on September 28, 2018 and hosted Southeastern Conference foe Mississippi State on the same weekend.

GAMECOCKS PICKED SECOND IN OVC POLL

Jacksonville State was picked to finish second in the 2019 season, according to the coaches and sports information directors throughout the OVC.

The Gamecocks, who finished fourth in the 2018 standings with an 18-12 league mark, collected 173 total points in the voting process, including six first-place votes. Morehead State, who won the 2018 OVC Baseball Tournament in Oxford, Alabama last May, claimed the top spot with 185 points and 11 of the available first-place votes. Tennessee Tech, the prohibitive favorite the last two seasons the 2018 regular season champion, was placed in the third spot in the order of finish. Tech joined MSU last season in the NCAA Baseball Championship field of 64 and reached the NCAA Super Regionals in Austin, Texas. Austin Peay and Southeast Missouri round out the top-five in the poll.

JSU PICKS UP PRESEASON NOTORIETY

Two prominent national college baseball media outlets have tabbed JSU to win the Ohio Valley Conference in 2019. Web-based outlets D1Baseball and Perfect Game prognosticators have the Gamecocks claiming the title this season.

Junior pitcher Garrett Farmer was D1Baseball's pre-season pick for OVC Pitcher of the Year, while Perfect Game also tabbed Farmer as the top hurler in the league. Perfect Game also gave the OVC Freshman of the Year nod to JSU's Isaiah Magwood.

Nic Gaddis, Cole Frederick and Christian Edwards were mentioned on PG's Preseason All-Conference Team.

JAX STATE TRIO NAMED PRESEASON ALL-OVC

JSU's high expectation in the Ohio Valley Conference this season by its peers can be attributed to its three members named to the 2019 Preseason All-OVC.

Senior Nic Gaddis, redshirt junior Garrett Farmer and sophomore Cole Frederick were among the 17 players on the list. Jax State's trio was the second-most among the 11 teams in the league. Preseason favorite Morehead State placed four players on the all-conference list.

Gaddis finished his junior campaign with a .324 batting average. Gaddis collected 67 hits, which ranked second on club behind Daniel Clayton, and turned in a team-best 10 home runs as a junior. He led Jax State with 55 RBI and reached base 32 times via a walk. Farmer is one of the top returning pitchers in the league and viable candidate for OVC Pitcher of the Year. Farmer posted a 7-2 record in 2018 and recorded 107 strikeouts. Frederick turned in an All-OVC performance with a spot on the All-OVC Freshman Team. Frederick, a utility-type player, played five different spots on the diamond, including all three outfield spots. The Tuscaloosa, Alabama native finished with nine home runs and four doubles.

GADDIS NAMED COLLEGIATE BASEBALL PRESEASON ALL-AMERICAN

Senior catcher Nic Gaddis garnered national attention from *Collegiate Baseball*, one of the premier baseball publications as he was named by the publication as a 2019 Preseason All-American, Powered by Diamond Sports. The Gamecock catcher was tabbed to Collegiate Baseball's Second Team, released by the publication in December.

Gaddis is one of four players from the Ohio Valley Conference who were among the preseason selections. Kevin Strohschein of Tennessee Tech and Parker Phillips of Austin Peay were named to the First Team, while Trevor Snyder of Morehead State was named to the Third Team.

EDWARDS NAMED TO NCBWA STOPPER OF THE YEAR WATCH LIST

Sophomore Christian Edwards was named to the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association Stopper of the Year ahead of the start of the 2019 season.

The award is given to the top relief pitcher in NCAA Division I Baseball. The organization's list included 75 players on the 2019 edition.

Edwards, the leading candidate to take over the closers role in 2019, was groomed for the role as a freshman with a solid first season as a Gamecock. The right hander from Hartselle, Alabama collected 55 strikeouts in 33.0 innings of work and registered three saves. Edwards posted an earned run average of 1.91 in 33 appearances out of the bullpen. His best outing of the season came in the season finale in the 2018 Ohio Valley Conference Baseball Tournament against Eastern Kentucky. He collected nine strikeouts in 4.1 innings of work out of the pen.

JIM CASE STADIUM

When Jacksonville State announced that the new state-of-the-art baseball facility would be named Jim Case Stadium, head coach Jim Case joined Florida State's Mike Martin as two of the current coaches on the NCAA Division I level to coach in a stadium that bears their name. The field at FSU is named Mike Martin Field at Dick Howser Stadium.

The JSU Board of Trustees approved the naming of the stadium at its quarterly meeting in July, granting the request of Bob Kenamer and Earlon McWhorter, the two private donors that made the facility a possibility with their contributions to the project.

CASE ACCUMULATES 1,000 GAMES AT JSU

Head coach Jim Case has accumulated 1,000 games in his 18-year tenure at Jacksonville State. The 'Dean of OVC Baseball Coaches' has an overall record of 554-448 as skipper of the Gamecocks. His 1,000th game was the series-opener against FIU on March 1.

GAMECOCK NOTEBOOK

JSU CHRISTENS THE NEW RUDY ABBOTT FIELD AT JIM CASE STADIUM

Jacksonville State christened its new stadium with a decisive 14-1 win over in-state rival North Alabama on Opening Day of the 2019 season.

The season opener marked the Gamecocks return to campus after a two-year hiatus to Oxford, Alabama and Choccolocco Park while the new Rudy Abbott Field at Jim Case Stadium was being constructed over the past two seasons. The last time Jax State played on campus was in May, 2016. Not even an overcast day and threat of rain dampened the excitement surrounding the opening of the state-of-the-art, multi-million stadium as 1,112 witnessed on offensive outburst by the Gamecocks.

Jax State collected nine extra base hits out of its 14 total hits on the day, including a trio of home runs. Senior catcher Nic Gaddis proved early why he was named a preseason all-conference selection and a preseason All-American as he belted a pair of two-run home runs. It marks the second time in two seasons that the Trenton, Georgia native has turned in a multi-home run day as he posted two home runs last season at Morehead State. Junior transfer Taylor Craven recorded his first home run as a Gamecock with a two-run blast in the sixth. Gaddis' first home run of the day started the scoring for JSU in the first and his second extended the lead in the fourth. He finished the day with four RBI. Jax State tallied a pair of RBI triples, one each by sophomore Isaac Alexander and junior Chase Robinson. Robinson finished with two RBI.

BUILD IT AND THEY WILL COME

With a new state-of-the-art facility in Rudy Abbott Field at Jim Case Stadium completed, people wanted to see the multi-million project on the opening weekend. JSU drew 1,112 on Opening Day, while a second crowd of over 1,000 braved chilly temperatures for a Saturday doubleheader. The Opening Day crowd was the largest since JSU hosted Alabama in on May 14, 2014.

Through the first 16 home games, JSU has averaged over 900 in attendance (924). Jax State ranks in the top-60 in attendance in NCAA Division I Baseball.

CASE COLLECTS CAREER WIN NO. 550

JSU's win at UAB on February 26 at Regions Field marked another milestone in head coach Jim Case's 18-year career at Jax State. The 5-3 win over UAB marked career win No. 550 for Case. Ironically, for the Birmingham, Alabama native, his 500th career win came over the Blazers in 2017.

GADDIS NAMED TO BUSTER POSEY LIST

senior catcher Nic Gaddis has been named to the 2019 Busty Posey Award Watch List, announced by the Greater Wichita Area Sports Commission.

The commission also announced a new name for the 20th anniversary of the national collegiate catcher of the year award. Previously known as the Johnny Bench Award, the Buster Posey National Collegiate Catcher of the Year Award will continue to honor the nation's top NCAA Division I Baseball catcher as voted on by head coaches and sports information directors.

Seventy-nine catchers were nominated for the 2019 Buster Posey Award by their coaches. Because the award is given annually to the top division one collegiate catcher, the list will be updated to include other candidates until May 6, 2019.

Gaddis is one of three catchers from the OVC mentioned on the initial watch list. Belmont's Jackson Campbell and Eastern Kentucky's A.J. Lewis are under consideration for the award.

GADDIS GARNERS OVC WEEKLY HONOR

After hitting .500 during the week of March 25-31 (Spring Break), Nic Gaddis was named the OVC Player of the Week. Gaddis helped the Gamecocks to a 3-1 week, including an OVC series sweep of Tennessee Tech over the weekend. The multi-position player went 9-for-18 in the four games, including a pair of three-hit games. Gaddis had six of his nine hits for extra bases with four doubles and a pair of home runs. He collected eight RBI on the week. Both of his home runs came in the ninth inning against Alabama State on Wednesday and Sunday's series finale versus TTU.

GADDIS ENTERS 100 CAREER RBI CLUB

Senior Nic Gaddis became the 29th Jacksonville State baseball player to reach the 100 career RBI mark. He reached the milestone on March 15 against Purdue. He enters the weekend with 110 career RBI, which ranks 23rd all-time at JSU. His next RBI will match former Gamecock Bert Smith, who had 111 RBI in his career.

LEAGUE LEADER IN TRIPLES

Jacksonville State leads the Ohio Valley Conference in triples this season with 17 through the first 38 games of the season. The Gamecocks are among the NCAA Baseball Division I leaders as well, ranking 10th in the nation in triples. Arizona leads the NCAA with 20 triples this season.

FITTS JOINS JAX STATE STAFF

Jacksonville State has added Trevor Fitts to its baseball coaching staff as a volunteer assistant coach.

Fitts, a native of Helena, Alabama, comes on board at JSU after serving as the coordinator of baseball operations at Mississippi State during the 2018 season. He was on the staff that helped the Bulldogs to the 2018 College World Series in Omaha, Nebraska. MSU was one of the four finalist in the CWS. Fitts, a former pitching standout for MSU from 2012-15, was a member of 2013 club that reached the national championship series against UCLA at the CWS in 2013.

Prior to returning to MSU in 2018, Fitts started his coaching career at Daphne High School in the spring of 2017. He also spent three summers as a head coach within the East Coast Sox Organization. Fitts earned his master's in education in physical education in May 2017 from South Alabama where he served as the baseball graduate assistant.

During his time in Starkville, Fitts appeared in a total of 62 games during his four-year career and posted a 10-8 mark with six saves and a 2.62 ERA in 144 innings pitched. He served as a team captain during his senior season in 2015 and was a three-time member of the SEC Academic Honor Roll and appeared in 18 games for State's 2013 NCAA College World Series finalist team. Fitts graduated from MSU in May 2015 with a bachelor's in kinesiology, sports pedagogy.

QUE THE LIGHTS!

The Gamecocks have four walk off wins this season, including JSU's series finale against Tennessee Tech. Nash Adams' 11th inning grand slam vs. Troy matched the celebratory finish from Cole Frederick's walk off home run in the 12th inning in the series opener with OVC foe Eastern Illinois.

Junior Andrew Naismith turned in the first heroics of the 2019 season with a two-run home run against North Alabama on the opening weekend of the campaign.

STREAKIN'

Jacksonville State's Isaac Alexander currently owns the Ohio Valley Conference's longest active hitting streak. The Muscle Shoals, Alabama shortstop has hit safely in the last 14 games, dating back to JSU's March 27 contest with Alabama State. Alexander has 18 hits in the last 14 games (.310) and nine RBI.

GAMECOCK NOTEBOOK**EIGHT (LONG) BALLS**

Jacksonville State matched a program record for home runs in a game with eighth and broke JSU's NCAA Division I mark in an 18-3 rout of Eastern Kentucky on April 18 at Earle Combs Stadium.

Seven different Gamecocks collected home runs on a blustery day on Turkey Hughes Field, while junior Alex Webb belted a pair of home runs in the contest. Jax State matched a 42-year old record as the last time it had eight home runs in a contest was in the Gulf South Conference Championship game against Nicholls State in 1977. The game was played at University Field, what is now the JSU softball complex. The eight home runs surpasses the Division I mark, which was established twice at Morehead State during the 2010 campaign.

JAX STATE BASEBALL EARNS OVC TEAM ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

Jacksonville State baseball team has claimed the 2017-18 Ohio Valley Conference's Team Academic Achievement Award for the sport.

The OVC Team Academic Achievement Awards are presented annually in each of the 16 Conference-sponsored sports to the member institution's team with the greatest percentage of its eligible student-athletes who achieved a 3.25 grade point average or higher.

A total of 17 Gamecocks were named to the 2017-18 OVC Commissioner's Honor Roll, which accounts for nearly 50 percent of the club. To be listed, recipients must have achieved at least a 3.25 grade point average, have been eligible and on the team throughout the competitive season in their chosen NCAA-sponsored sport(s) and used a season of competition. Former Gamecock Trent Simpson earned the OVC Medal of Honor distinction after posting a 4.0 grade point average for the academic year.

It marks the second time that the baseball program has claimed the OVC Team Academic Achievement Award. JSU was awarded the honor for the 2004-05 academic year, the school's first year in the conference.

Baseball was one of three programs on campus to win one of the 16 OVC Team Academic Achievement Award. The JSU football squad and the women's cross country team claimed its respective sports award.

FARMER LEADS NEW LOOK ROTATION

Jacksonville State redshirt junior Garrett Farmer will once again highlight the pitching rotation in 2019. After a solid return from an injury in 2017 with a 7-2 record on the mound last season, the right hander from Huntsville, Alabama, is one of the top returning pitchers in the league and viable candidate for OVC Pitcher of the Year. Farmer posted 107 strikeouts in 90 innings of work. He finished with an ERA of 3.80 after allowing 38 earned

runs in 15 appearances on the mound. He nearly tossed a complete game on three occasions with 8.0 innings of work against OVC foes Southeast Missouri (4/13/18), at Belmont (4/20/18) and vs. UT Martin (5/11/18). Farmer collected a career high 12 strikeouts in the UTM outing and fanned 10 in the SEMO and Belmont contests.

True freshman Isaiah Magwood is set to make his pitching debut on Saturday. Magwood, from Hazel Green, Alabama, brings credentials from the prep level as he helped the Trojans of Hazel Green to the Class 6A State Championship. He is listed by Perfect Game as the fifth-best right-handed pitcher prospect in the state of Alabama for the class of 2018 and the 13th ranked prospect in the state.

Redshirt freshman Trey Fortner will make his JSU debut as the Sunday starter. He prepped at Gloucester High School and was ranked by Perfect Game as top-60 players in the state of Virginia.

ALEXANDER LED ALL OVC ROOKIES IN RBI IN '18

Jacksonville State sophomore shortstop led all Ohio Valley Conference rookies in RBI with 48 in his first season on the collegiate level. The Muscle Shoals, Alabama native had 11 multiple RBI games, highlighted by a trio of three RBI games this season, including five three RBI OVC outings.

Alexander has recorded an RBI in 28 of the 55 games played. He has also registered a hit in 40 games this season, including a season-high four hits vs. Austin Peay on March 11. He reached base in 25 straight games during the season.

FREDERICK: A COLE OF ALL TRADES

Freshman Cole Frederick services were needed throughout the field for the Gamecocks in 2018. Frederick, from Tuscaloosa, Alabama, was pegged to be JSU's starting third baseman entering the season and has held the hot corner spot 24 times last season. He played five positions, including right field, left field and centerfield. Frederick, a two-sport athlete in high school, started in left field once and in right field on one occasion. Against Tennessee Tech, he was moved over to shortstop for the final two games of the series after Isaac Alexander became ill during the trip to Cookeville.

REPLACING A LEGEND

Clayton Daniel, referred to by his teammates as 'Spike', will be hard to replace after his departure. Daniel became the program's all-time hits leader with 330 career hits, surpassing former Gamecock Bert Smith. Daniel's career hits mark also makes him the all-time career hits leader in the Ohio Valley Conference. With Daniel taking over the top spot at JSU and the OVC, Jax State has the league's top-two all-time career hits leaders.

CLOSING TIME

Jacksonville State has been solid in the bullpen over the last eight years and has a record of 200-8 when leading after eight innings dating back to the 2011 season.

In 2018, the Gamecocks were 25-2 when leading after eight innings. The two losses this season were against Tennessee Tech on April 7 and at Alabama on May 8. This season JSU is 5-2 when taking a lead to the ninth inning.

WINNING SERIES

A key part of a successful season is the ability to win weekend series on a consistent basis. Since the 2014 season, the Gamecocks have done a solid job of claiming weekend series having won 48 of the last 68 weekend series (70%). JSU won 10 of the 13 Ohio Valley Conference series in back-to-back seasons (2016, 2017) and have claimed 30-of-47 league series dating back to the 2014 campaign.

With non-conference series wins over Florida International, Western Kentucky and Southern Illinois in 2017, along with back-to-back series wins over SIU and Radord to open 2018, JSU has won six of the last seven non-conference series.

The Gamecocks claimed series wins over Eastern Illinois, Murray State, Southeast Missouri, Belmont, UT Martin and SIU Edwardsville. JSU swept three OVC weekends this season - Murray State in Birmingham, at Belmont and at SIUE to wrap up the season.

In 2019, JSU has claimed series against North Alabama, Eastern Illinois, Purdue, Tennessee Tech and Southeast Missouri.

CASE: THE DEAN OF OVC COACHES

Jacksonville State Head Coach Jim Case is the dean of the Ohio Valley Conference baseball coaches as he is in his 18th season in a Gamecock uniform. Case, who moved in to the 500 career coaching wins club last season, has accumulated 547 career wins. His win total ranks fifth on the OVC's list of top-10 coaches.

Case has guided the Gamecocks to 262 wins in OVC games and a winning percentage of 63 percent. He has guided JSU to four OVC Tournament Championships and four NCAA Tournament appearances.

Another highlight of his career is that he has mentored the top-two hitters in OVC history in terms of total hits with Clayton Daniel (324) and Bert Smith (323). Daniel and Smith rank 1-2 on the league's career hits list.
